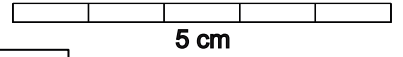

MATERIALS:

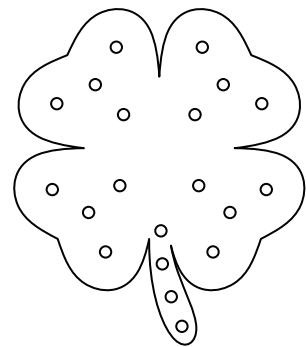
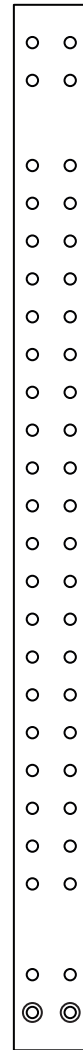
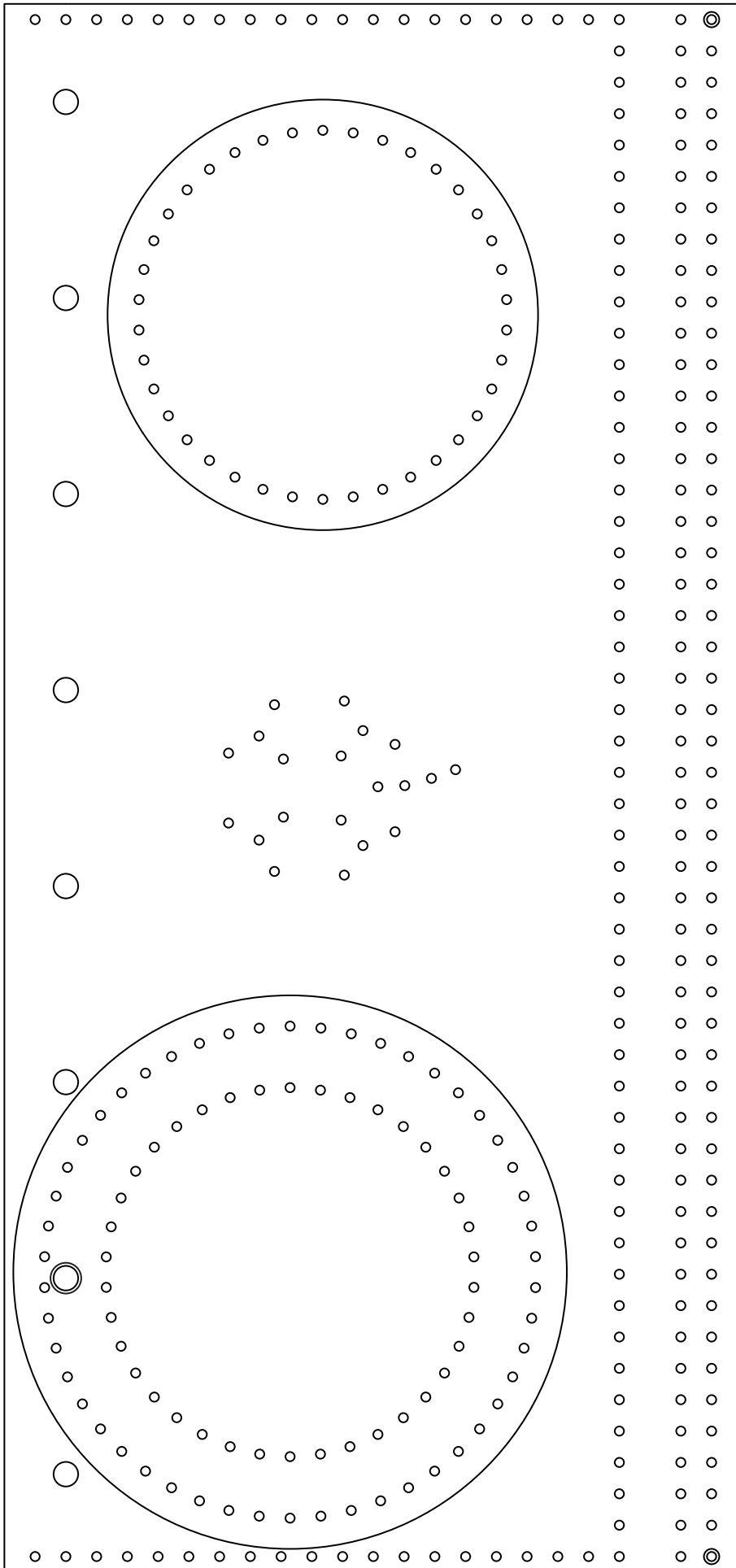
1. Leather: 1-1.5mm, veg or chrome
2. Waxed thread (0.8-1mm)
3. Leather dye, Tokonole (optional)
4. Paper tape

TOOLS:

1. Sharp knife
2. Plastic hammer or mallet
3. 1.2 or 1.5mm hole puncher
4. 3mm hole puncher
5. Needles
6. 600 grit sand paper, burnisher, edge beveler (optional)
