Adjustable with buckles

MATERIALS

Approximately 16 sqft (1.5 sqm) 9-10 oz (3.5-4 mm) leather

1 mm waxed polyester thread

edge dye

ACCESSORIES

4 x 35 mm buckle

4 x 30 mm buckle

3 x 25 mm swivel eye snap hooks (hook buckles)

3 x 25 mm D-rings

TOOLS

cutter

1.5 mm & 4 mm hollow punch

needles

mallet

cutting pad

paper masking tape

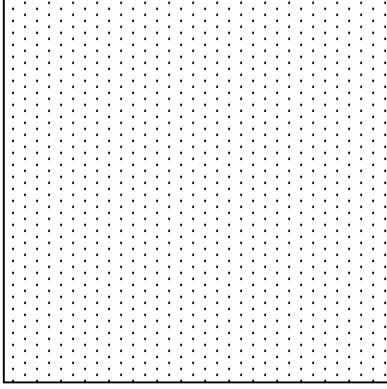
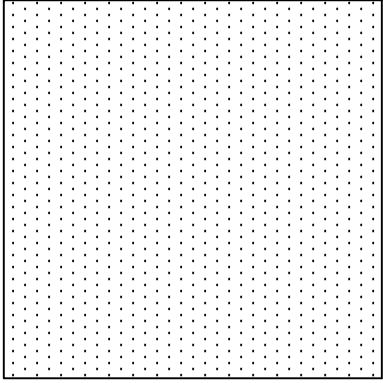

also edge line to compensate for the printer edge margin

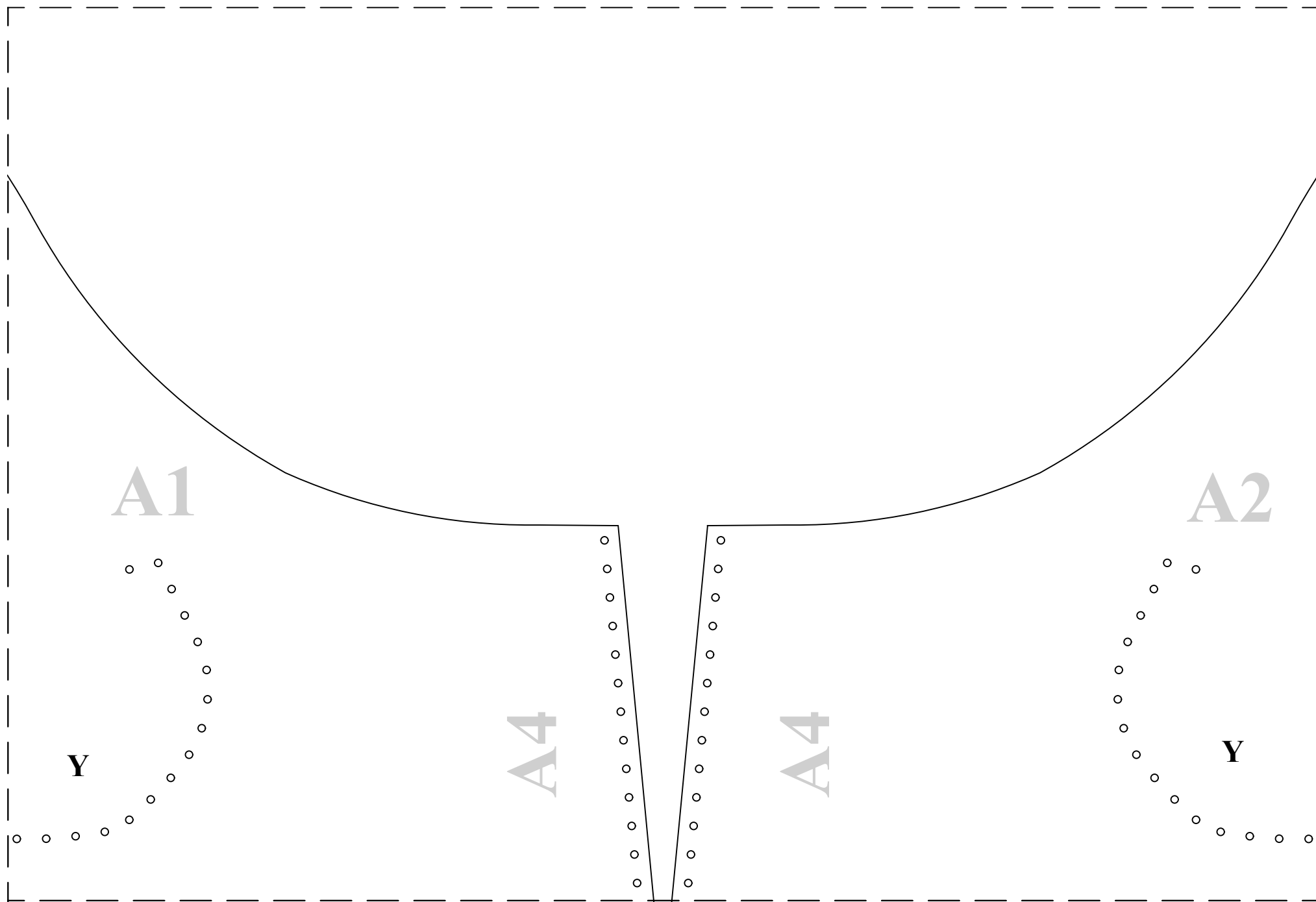
this is the contour of the parts

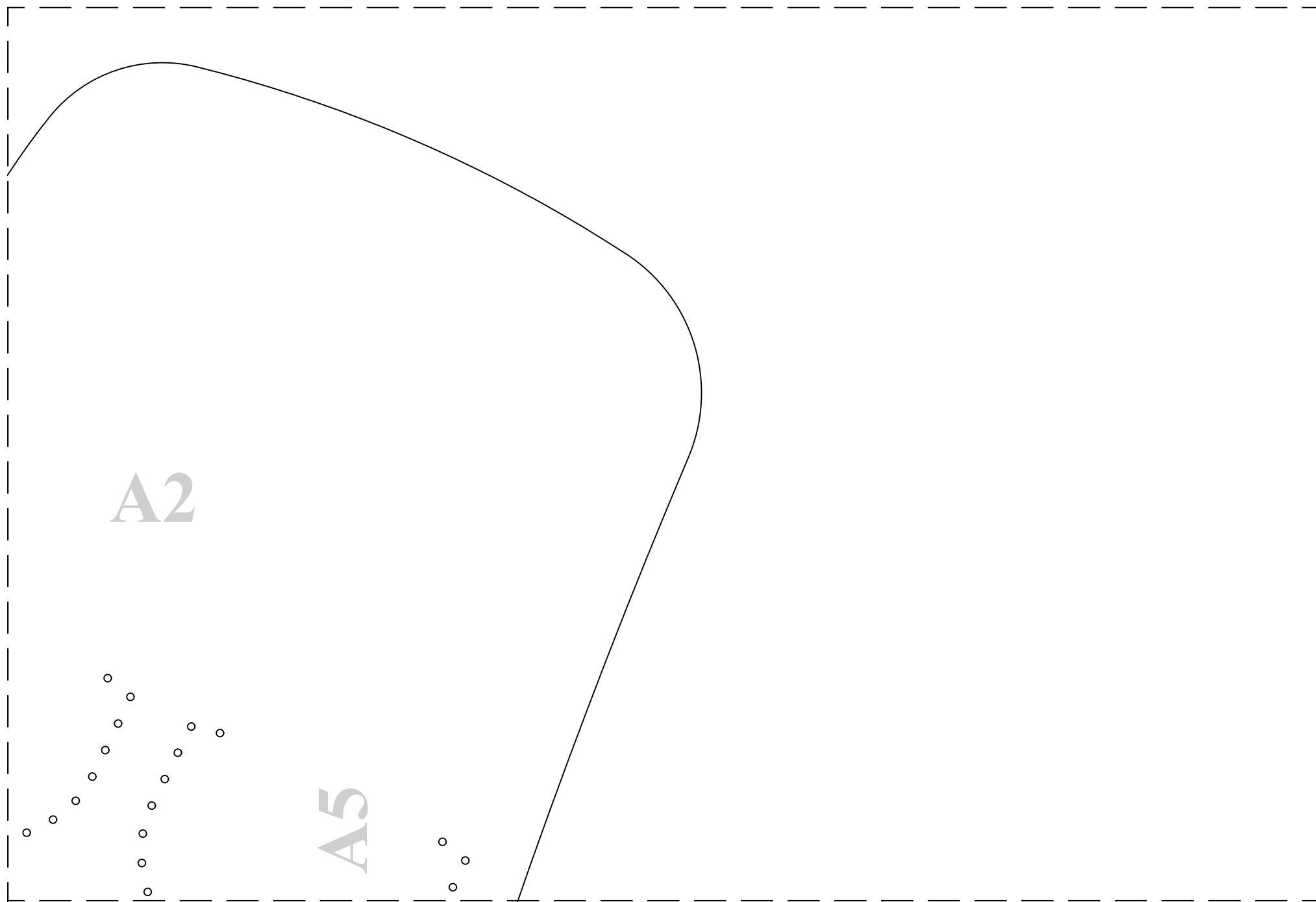
When putting the pattern together have in mind,

pieces to part "B" and so on.

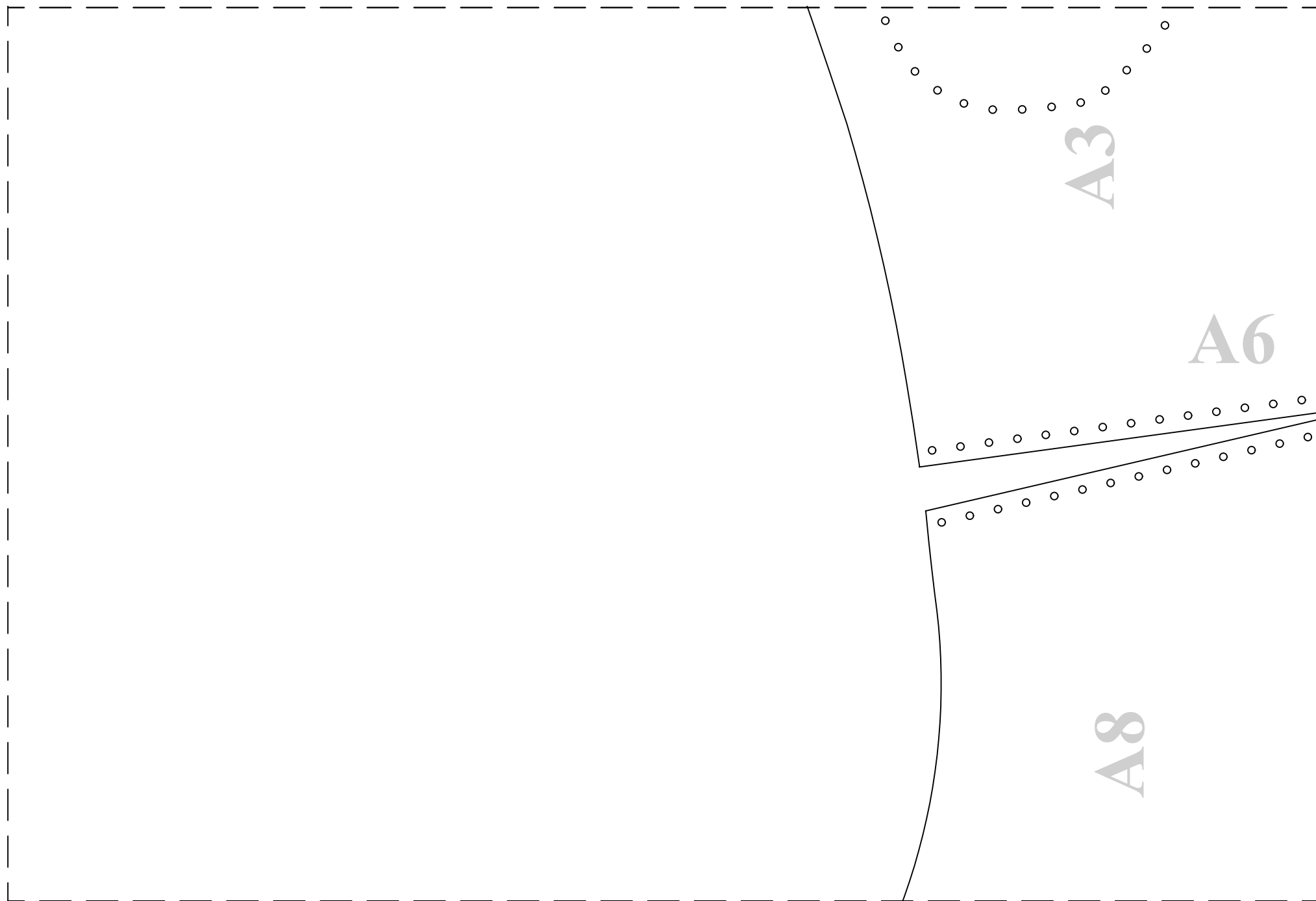
