

Additional Instructions to be used with video

Due to the complexity of some of the stitching that might not come across very well in the video, I've included some close-up shots of certain of how certain areas are meant to be stitched. Although I've seen different interpretations of the pattern, this was the way I intended it.

How to deal with the seams of the eye socket:

I still do the same reverse cross stitch, but when I get to the seam; I stitch into the hole across from the seam from the holes of both sides of the seam, into a V shape. This is going to be reoccurring stitch throughout this project. I've attached pictures from my mock-up to better illustrate my description.





That same V stitch formation is used for the center of the nasal passage piece.

Here is a closeup of what the stitching looks like up close in this area.



The V stitch is used again here to secure the corners of the mouth.



The V stitch is also applied on the side of the skull cap
