



THE MPR LEATHER WALLET



Do-It-Yourself
Easy to follow PDF Patterns

Welcome and thank you for purchasing the MPR Leather Wallet pdf pattern.

The Size of the Wallet is, 172mm (L) X 95mm (H) X 17mm (W).

The pattern pages are,

- 1) Parts A1 A2 (remember to do part A2 mirror image)
- 2) Part B
- 3) Part C
- 4) Parts A3 D
- 5) Parts Summary

The tools required for this build are:

- a) Printer to print Black & white pdf files onto A4 sized paper.
- b) Stanley knife with new blades.
- c) Waxed thread 1.2mm and 2 matching harness needles (it does not require sharp points)
- d) Top Grain Leather – 2.2 to 2.4mm for all parts.
- e) Hole Punches – 1 x 1.8mm
- f) Press Studs – 2 X 15mm
- g) Press Stud tool
- h) Zip – 1 X 16mm (cut length to size)
- i) Contact Glue – (strong glue for leather)

IMPORTANT TIPS:

Take your time and prepare all the parts for this project before you start the assembly process.

Place Parts A1 & A2 on top of each other and ensure that the top sides are on the inside and stitch the 2 inside rows to join these parts.

Cut the zip to size and glue to the inside of Part B. Mark the punch line, punch the holes and stitch the zip.

Stitch Part D onto Part A3.

Now place parts B (with zip already stitched) on the outside (the top side of the leather) of Part C, and Parts A1 & A2 (already stitched) on the inside of Part C.

Now start stitching from the top on the one side downwards around the corner up to hole 16.

Now add Part A3 (with Part D already attached) onto Parts A1 & A2, and stitch through all holes until you get to hole 16 on the other side,(determine hole 16 on the other side and mark beforehand), and then lift Part A3 so that you only stitch Parts B ,C, A1 & A2 together until the end.

Once completed, stitch the 16 holes on both sides of part A2 and A3 together.

Once you have done this you only need to add your LOGO and the project is done.

Well done!

Printing the pattern:

Check out the pictures explaining the boxes to be ticked to ensure **A4 actual size** is selected to print correct sized patterns. (This is very important).

Measure both blocks vertically and horizontally once you have printed the "Test Page".

Well, good luck and enjoy this project, it's over to you!

Don't forget to post a picture so we can see your version of the Wallet!

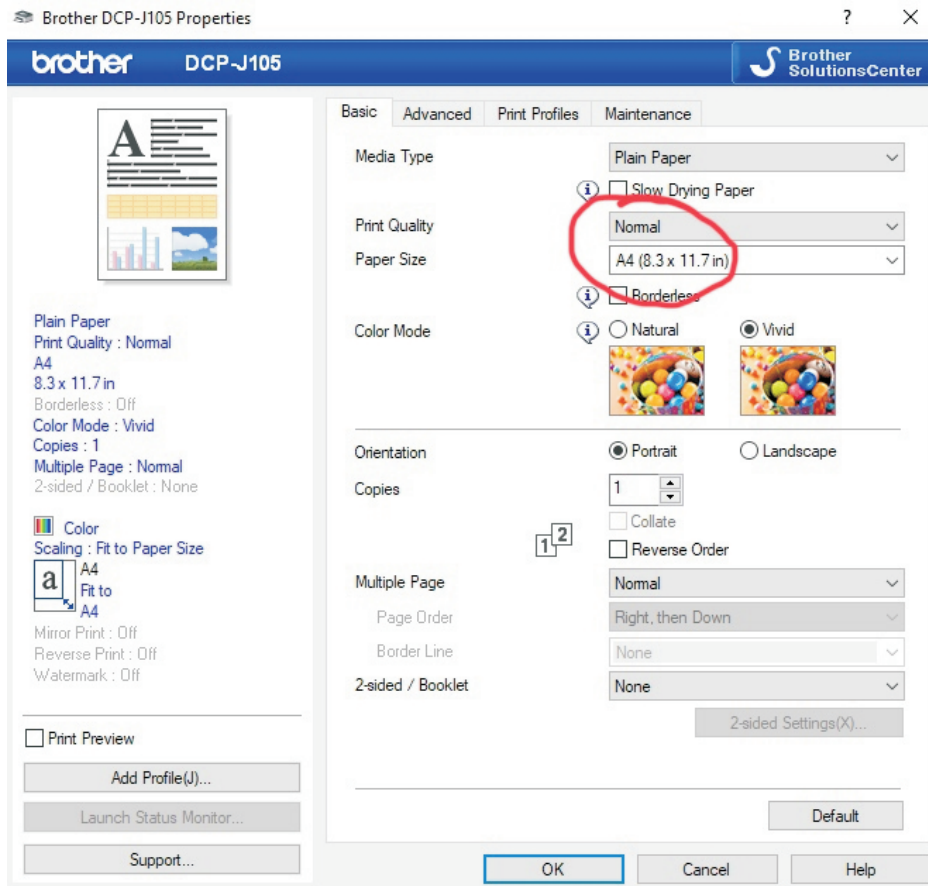
Test Page

4. If so, you are ready to go..Congratulations!

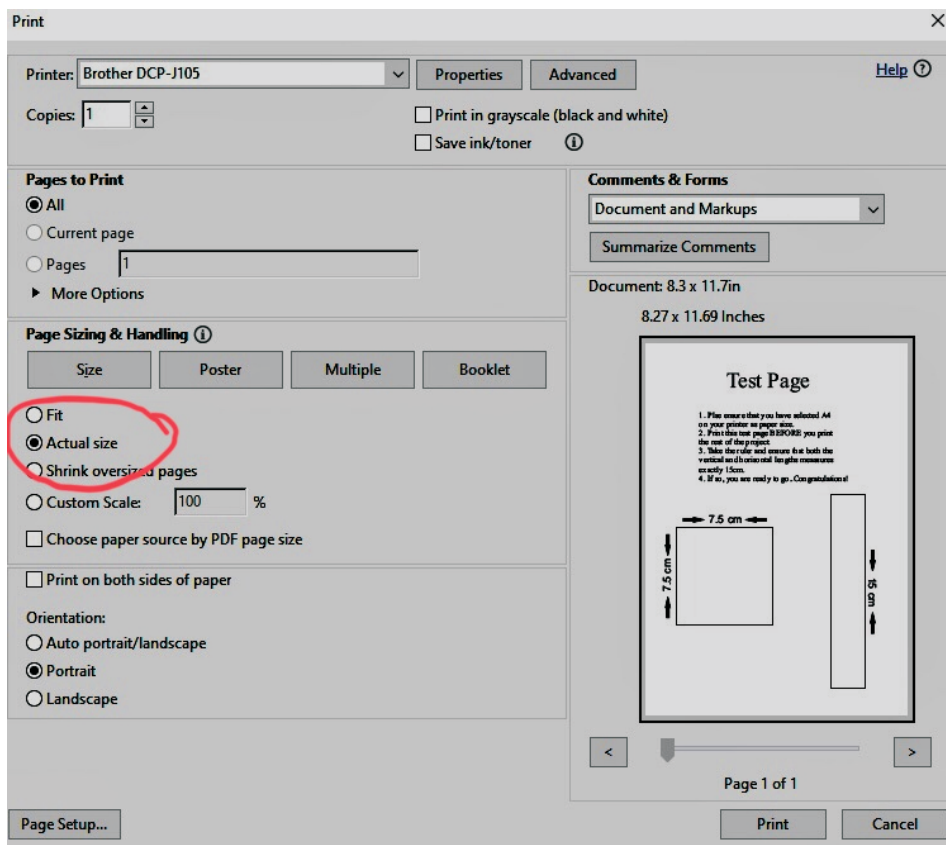

Printing the pattern

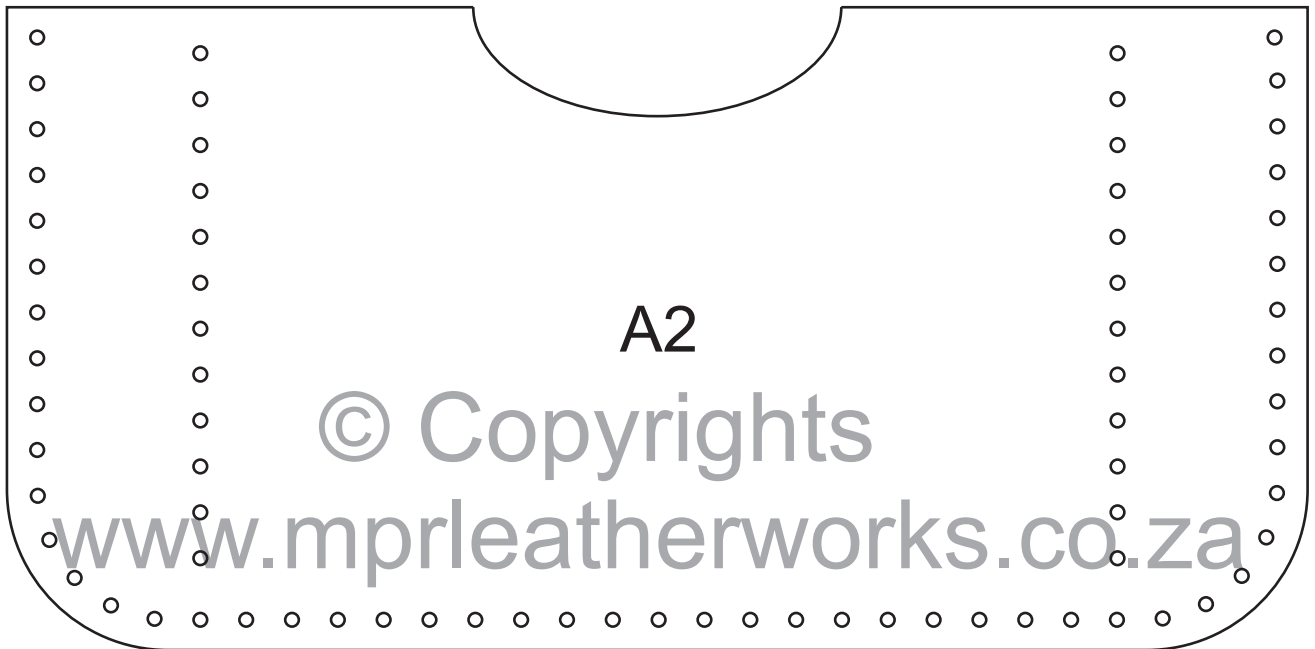
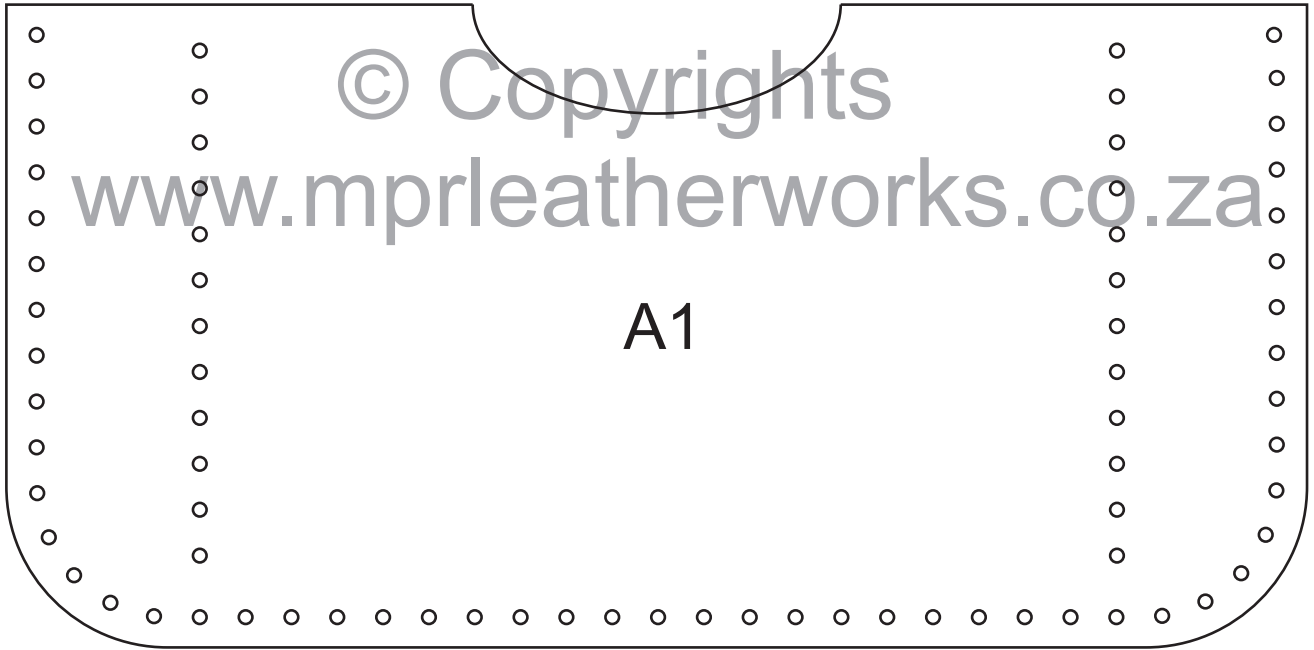
Ensure the paper size is setup as A4

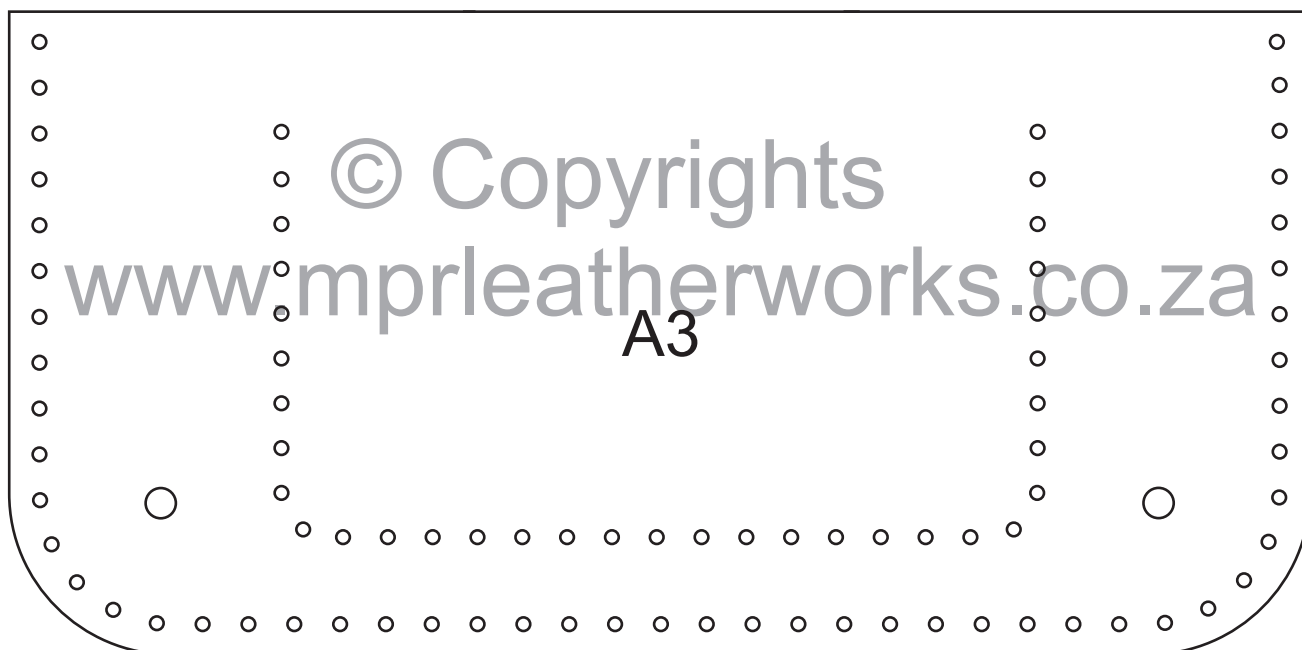
