Welcome and thank you for purchasing the Route 62 Weekender leather bag pdf pattern set.

CONGRATULATIONS!! You are about to make a weekender bag that most probably will last the next 100 years. Everybody will love it, so be ready to answer many questions.

The size of the Adventure Bag is 500mm (l) X 250mm (h) X 225mm (w)

The tools required for this build are:

- a) Printer to print Black & white pdf files onto A4 sized paper.
- b) Stanley knife with new blades.
- c) Waxed thread 1.2mm and 2 matching harness needles (it does not require sharp points)
- d) Copper Rivets – Head size 12 mm – stem length 17mm
- e) Top Grain Leather – 3mm for parts F1 to F9 (body of bag) , parts F10 & F11 (straps) & parts H1 & H2 (handles).

- f) Top Grain Leather – 2.4mm for the rest of the parts of the bag)
- g) Hole Punches – 1 x 1.8mm, 1 x 3mm & 1 X 4mm.
- h) Buckles –2 X 19mm
- i) 2 x Copper pipes, each (15mm diameter x 500mm)
- j) 4 X end caps for copper pipes, each 10mm(I) X 15mm diameter)
- k) ALCOLIN'S Rapid EPOXY – to glue end caps to copper pipes.

IMPORTANT TIPS:

Take your time and prepare all the parts for the bag to match the parts on page 26 before you start assembly of the bag.

Printing the pattern:

Check out the pictures explaining the boxes to be ticked to ensure **A4 actual size** is selected to print correct sized patterns. (This is very important).

Measure both blocks vertically and horizontally once you have printed the "Test Page".

Well, good luck and enjoy this project, it's over to you!

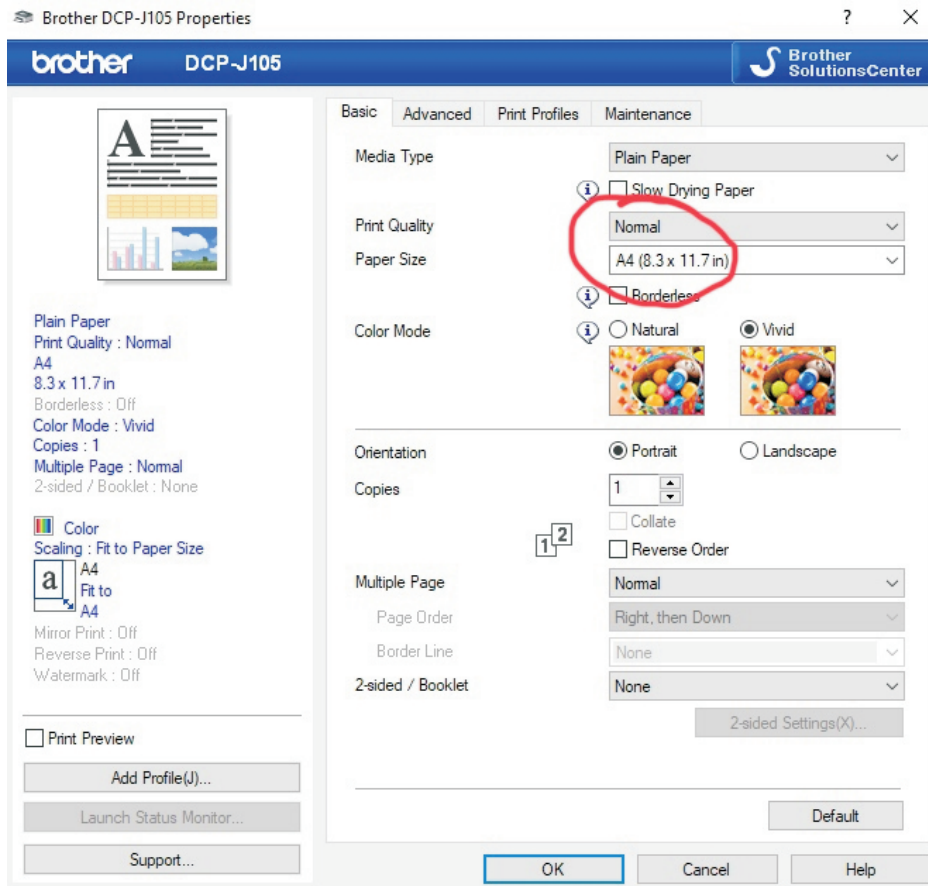
Test Page

4. If so, you are ready to go..Congratulations!

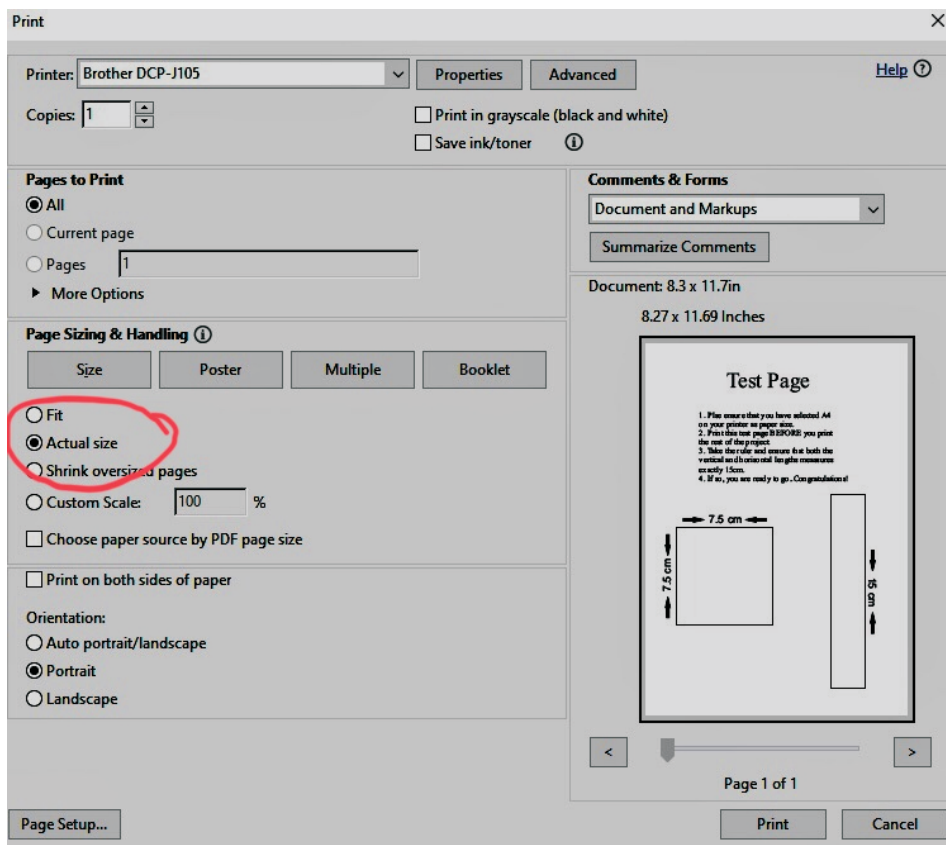
