LEATHER HIP BAG INSPIRED BY NARUTO

This contains a pattern and written instructions for the process of making a hip bag.

DIMENSIONS (INSIDE)

Height: 17 cm (6.7")

Length: 12/16cm (4.7-6.3")

Width: 3/5 cm (1.2-2")

Pocket width: 1.5 cm (0.6")

MATERIALS

BODY: 2 mm (5 oz) vegetable tanned leather

POCKET, STRAP, ACCENTS: 2.5+ mm (6-7 oz) vegetable tanned leather

1 mm waxed polyester thread

edge dye

ACCESSORIES

7 Sam Browne stud

4 x 20 mm D-rings

1 x 20 mm roller buckle

TOOLS

cutter

1.5 mm hollow punch

needles

mallet

cutting pad



1.CUT THE LEATHER

Use 2 mm (5 oz) leather for the body of the bag and 2.5+ mm (6-7 oz) for the straps, pocket, accents.



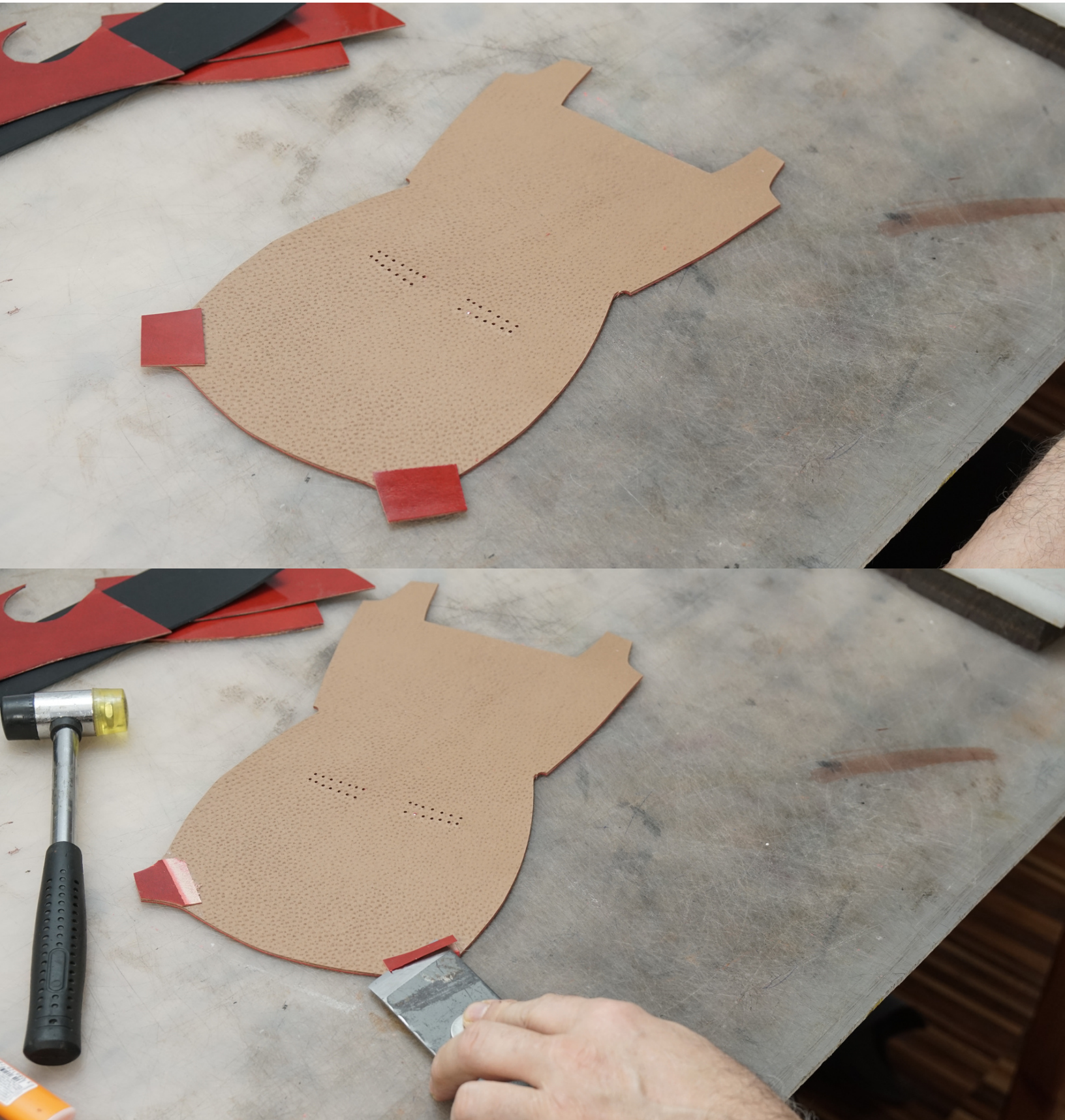
2. PUNCH THE HOLES

I use a 1.5 mm hollow punch.



3. GLUE A PIECE OF LEATHER IN THE CORNERS

I put the pieces of leather so it will look good on the front. Skive the leather in the inner part.



4. FINISH THE EDGES

Finish all the edges before stitching. I use Uniters edge dye but you can burnish or use the dye you prefer.



5. MAKE THE POCKET

Glue it and punch the holes.





6. STITCH THE POCKET ON THE FRONT OF THE BAG



7. STITCH THE BACK PIECE

Stitch first the D-rings on the contrast leather and then stitch it on the back of the hip bag.



8. ASSEMBLE THE BAG

I use a plier to bend the edges for an easier stitching.
I use 1 mm polyester waxed thread.



10. STITCH THE D-RINGS



11. INSERT THE SAM BROWNE STUDS

I use a drop of Lock Bond Bison to lock the stud in place.
