B&W Printer



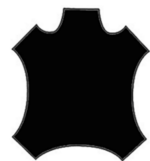
Scissors or a cutter

15 square feet of leather

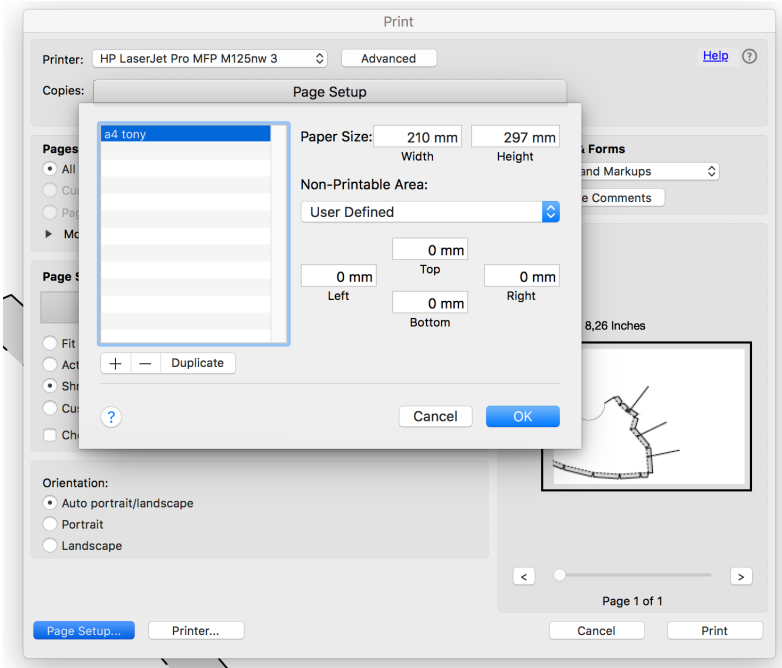


Thread and needles



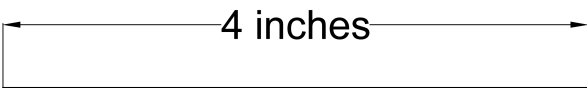
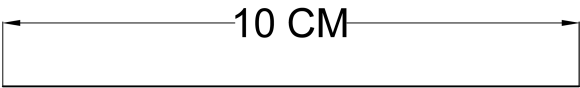
PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your printer to A4 paper with no margins on landscape mode.



After you print the first page make sure you have the correct size by measuring the real size scale with a ruler.

22	56	7	S



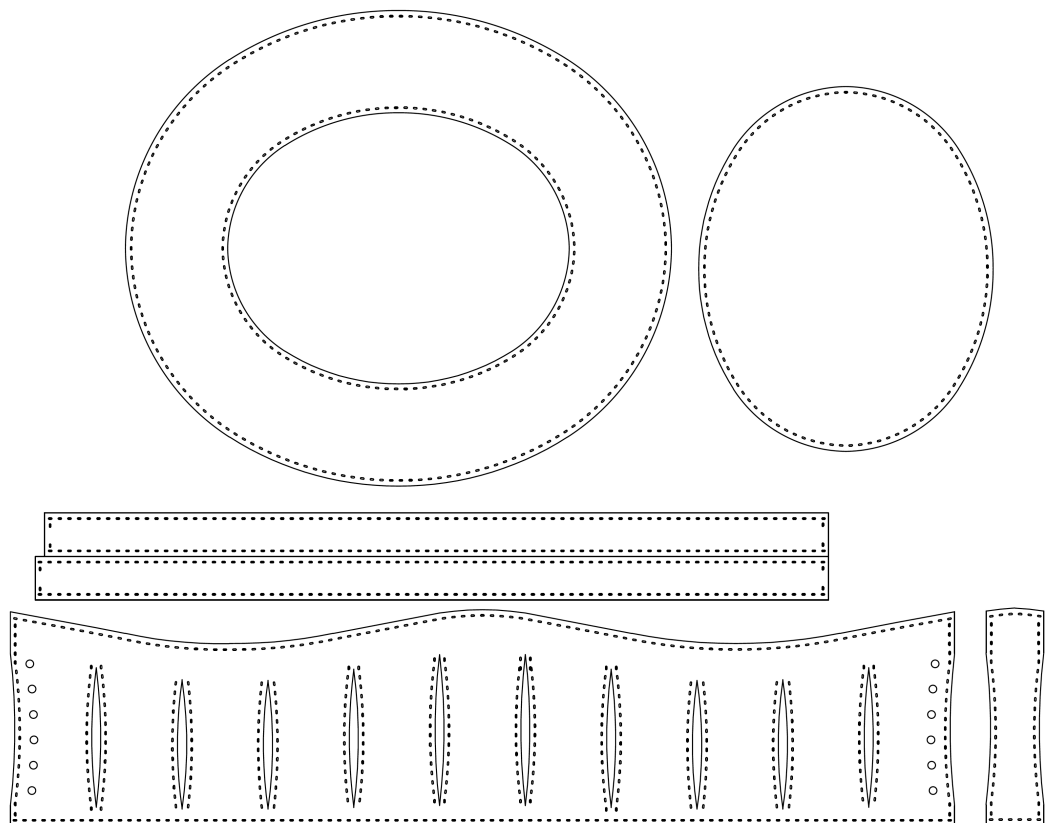
LETS START!

You need to paste together some of the pieces as they are spread out over multiple pages

Attach all the pattern pages and when done you should get something like this.

Now cut all the pattern pieces carefully to construct your hat
