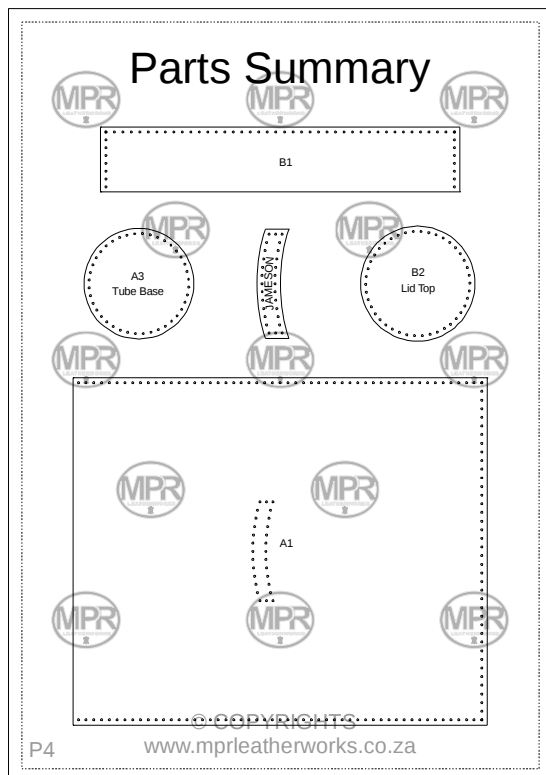
The Wine & Spirits Bottle Leather Cover – Standard – 85mm x 320mm

Bottle cover was made of vegetable tanned leather, +-2.4mm (5-6oz) thickness.

See diagram 1 below to get an overview look of the pattern parts required for this build.

It makes for a very unique present, a quality gift to someone special.

This PDF Pattern is spread over 3 (three) A4 pages and all the parts are numbered individually. By printing page 4, you will be able to see all the parts required to make this build on one sheet as a guide.

The tools required for this build are:

- a) Printer to print Black & White PDF files onto A4 sized paper
- b) Stanley knife with new blades
- c) Waxed thread 1mm and 2 (two) matching harness needles (it does not require sharp points)
- d) Vegetable tanned Leather with thickness of +-2.4mm (5-6oz) was used.
- e) Hole punch required 1mm or 1.5mm or smaller depending on your taste.

Tips:

- 1) Take your time and prepare all the parts for this project before you start the assembly process.
- 2) Now carefully look at the pictures for this project on the Etsy Shop, to see where every part must go. It is actually very easy to build, and I cannot wait to see what your project looks like.

Printing the pattern:

Check out the – **Printer Setting Page**. The (yellow coloured circles) indicates which boxes must be checked to ensure that the correct printing size is selected, before you print the – **Test Page** - . **(This is very important)**

Once the – **Test Page** – is printed, measure both the vertical and horizontal sides with a ruler to ensure it is correct, before you print the actual pattern pages.

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I rely 100% on your discretion in this regard, and will be humbled to receive any repurchases.

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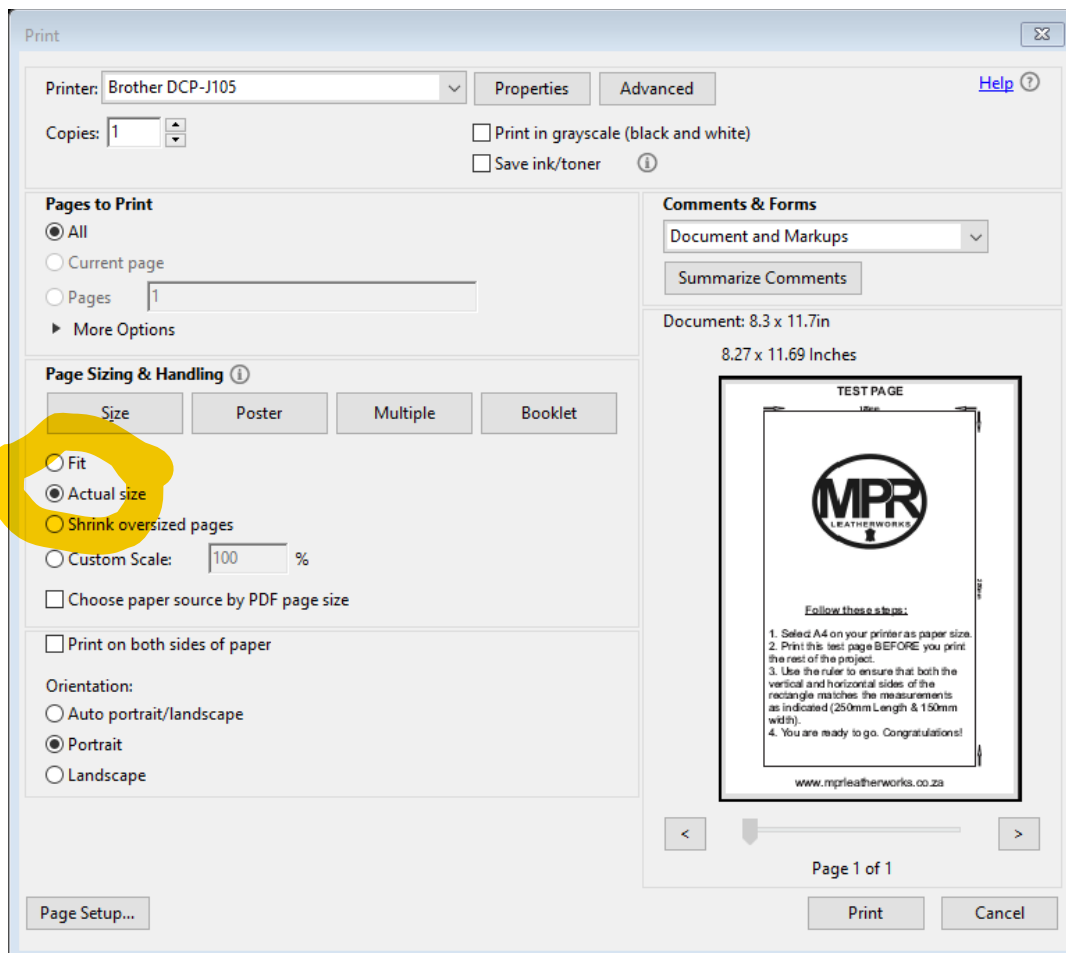
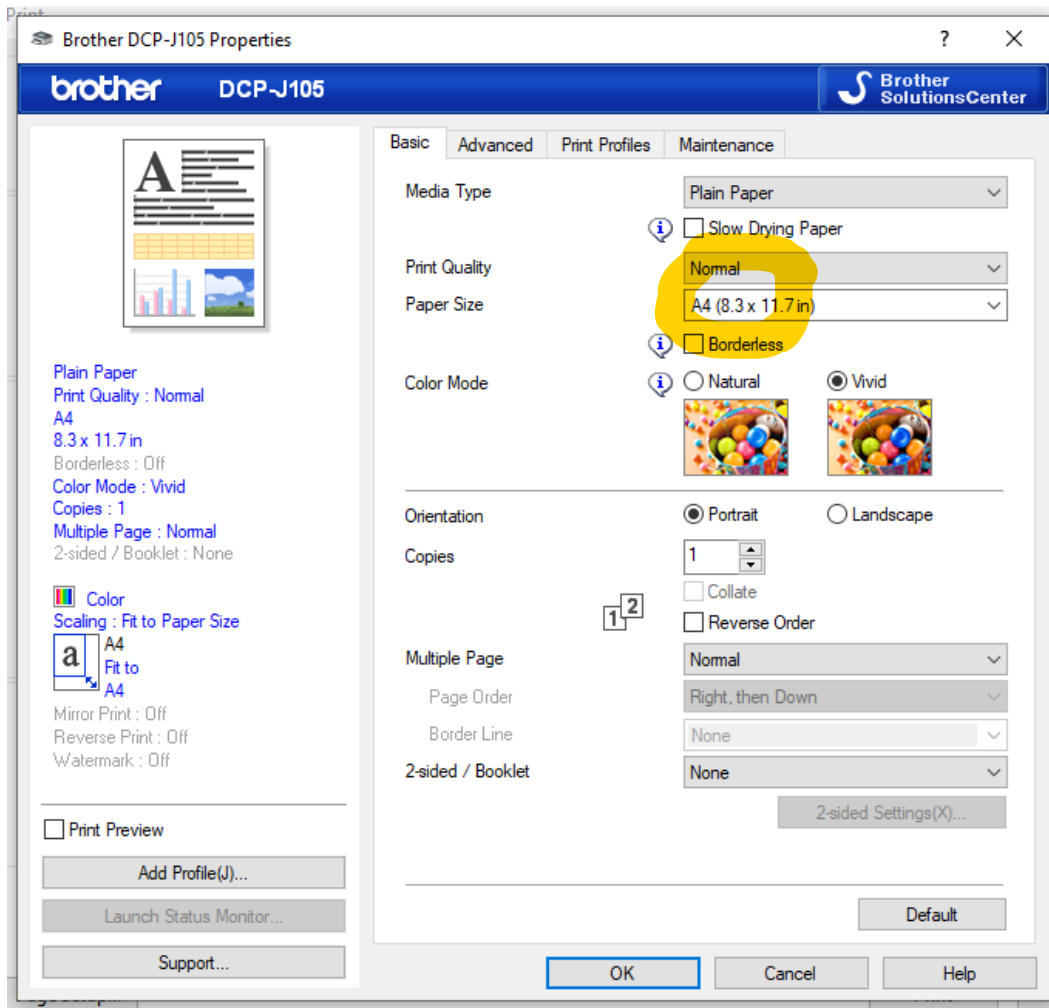

3. Use the ruler to ensure that both the vertical and horizontal sides of the rectangle matches the measurements as indicated (250mm Length & 150mm width).
