

CAPTAIN JACKSON'S BUCKET



Materials:

Here is what I used: a 6 oz veg tan for the body, a 3-4oz bridle veg tan for the stripes, and 3-4 oz veg tan for the bottom rim. The holes are 3/8" and you will need a piece of rope that would fit this diameter. Of course you can adjust this according to what you have. If you have 1/4" rope make smaller holes.

Tools:

Scissors, knife (paper knife or rotary cutter would also work).
Stitching irons: my pattern is made for 5mm stitching irons (5 stitches per inch). If you are willing to use any other size please make sure that the hole count is the same where it has to be the same.
Needles - according to your thread size, a pair of harness needles.
Mallet, hole punch, small hook (to get the rope through the holes).

Instructions:

Print the pattern at actual size (100%). Use the reference on top of each page to make sure everything is printed correctly. Join the pages together. Cut the pieces.

Sew the bottom rim to the bottom, grain sides together.
Then prepare the body sewing the stripes onto it. I didn't include the logo label as the size may vary but feel free to insert yours. It is simply sewn under the top stripe in the middle.
Pull the rope through the holes. Measure the right length depending on how long you want the handles to be. It is better to adjust this after you finish the assembly.



Time to stitch the bottom on. Take the bottom and line up the end of the rim to the edge of the body and complete the seam. Make sure to tighten the thread well. I dampened the bottom before stitching so it would accommodate easier.

Start sewing the body together. I used parallel stitch there, you can use cross stitch or baseball stitch. Make sure to include both holes on the ends of the rim into that stitch.

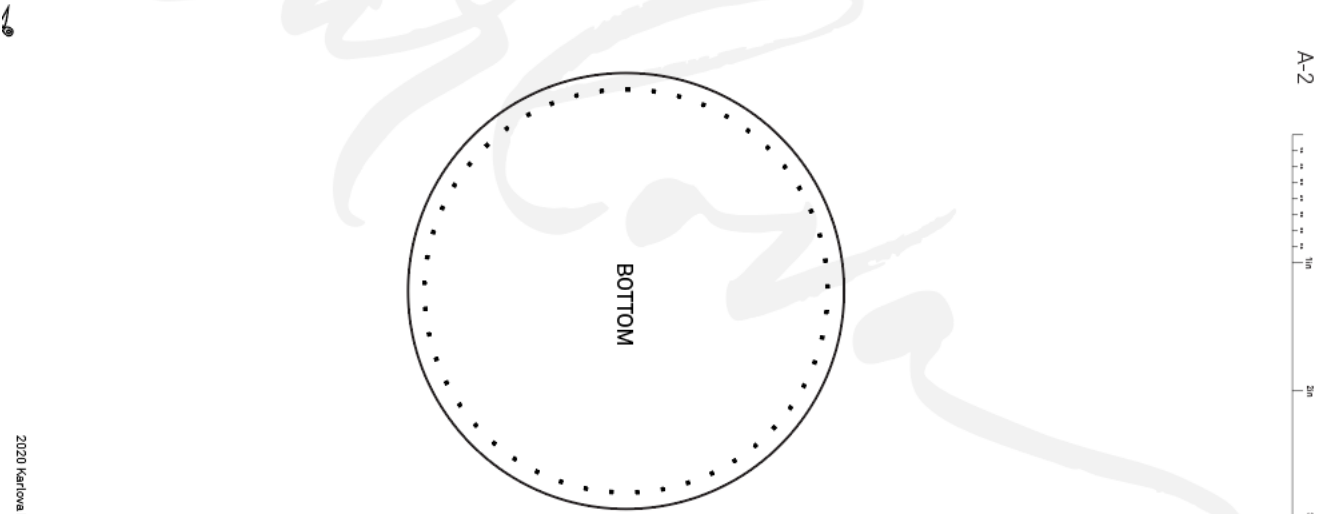
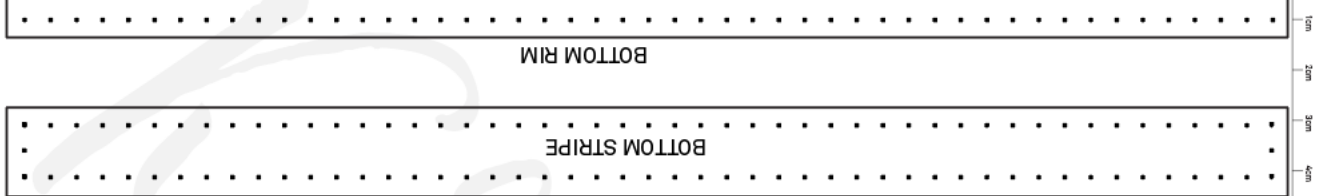
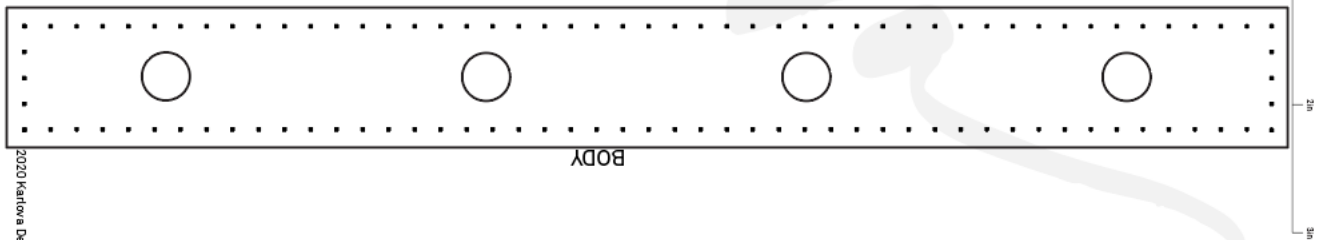
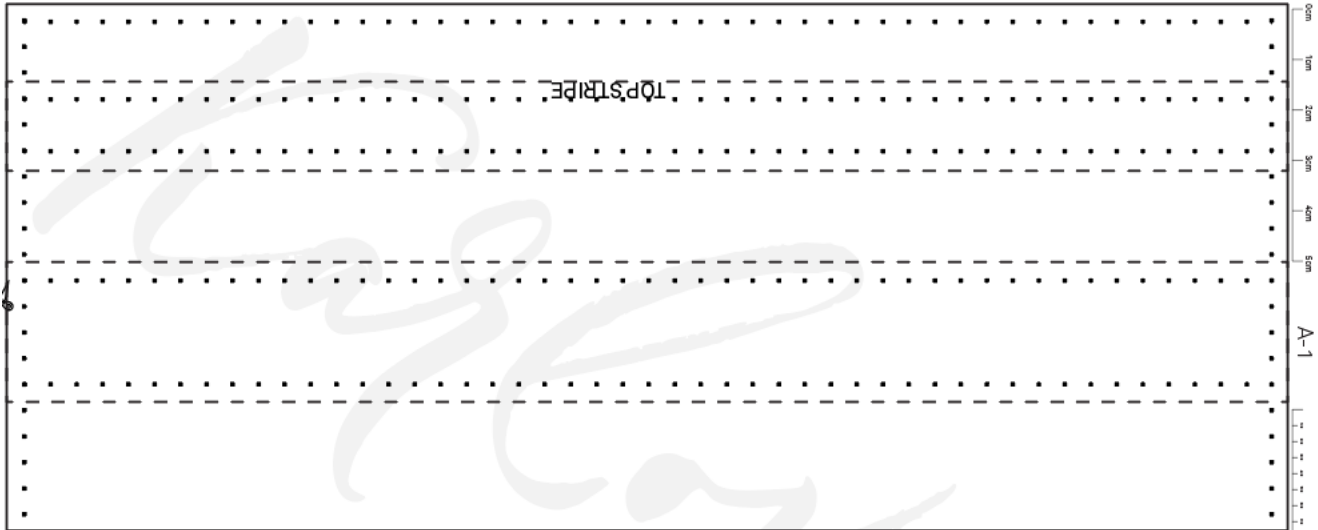


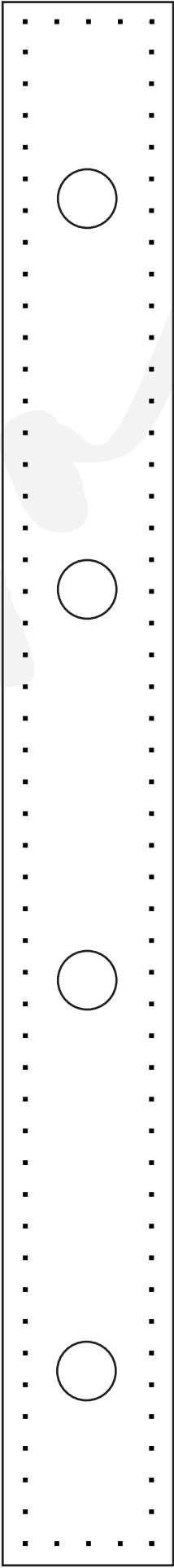
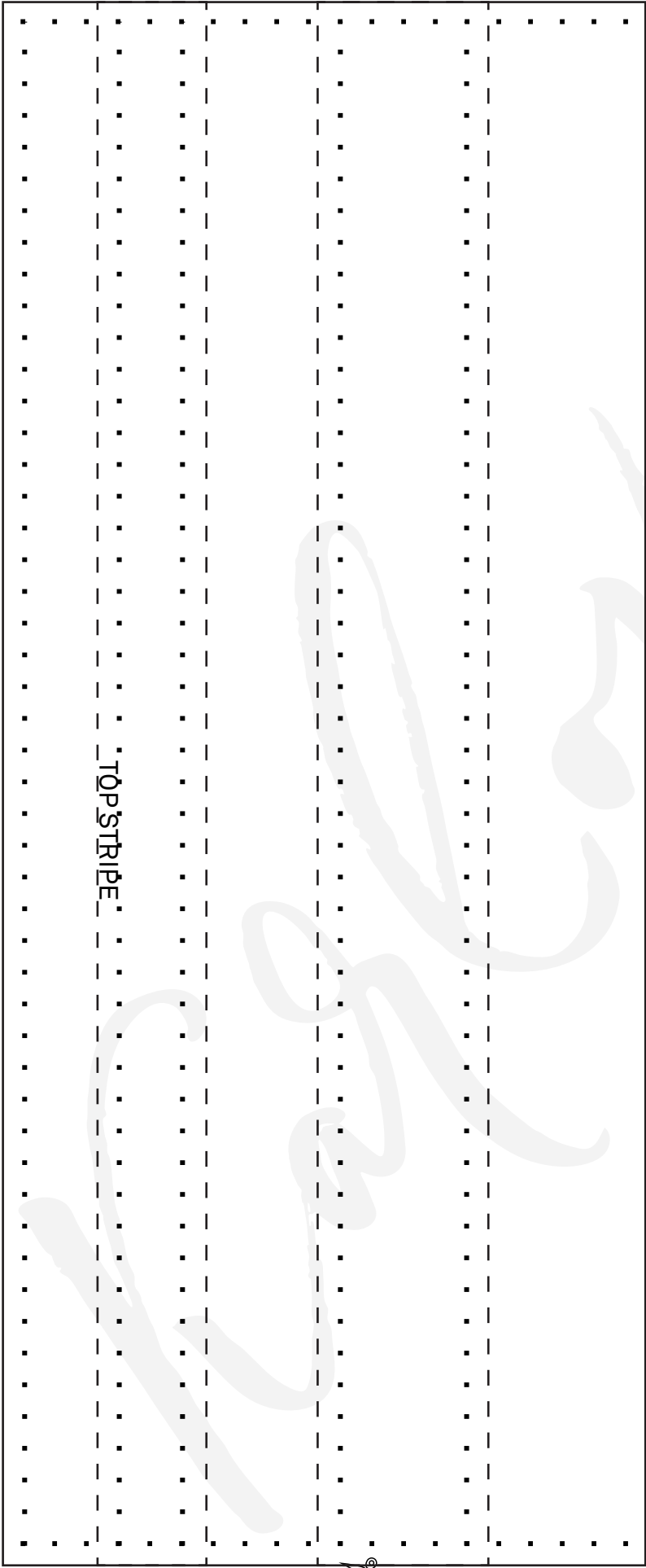
Join the rope ends together. If you know how to splice, you can do it, I just overlapped the ends and wrapped some thread around it. After that, pull the rope so this part would be hidden inside the top stripe between the holes.
