The Medieval Leather Dice – 50mm x 50mm

The Medieval Leather Dice is made of vegetable tanned leather, +-2.4mm (5-6oz).

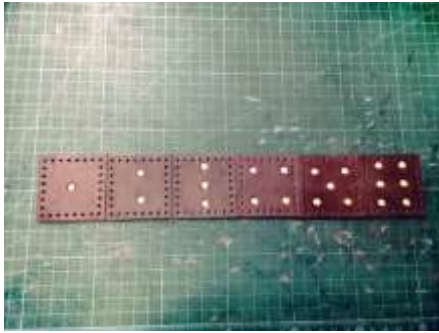
Picture 1:

Take a scrap piece of leather and glue to the back of the part to enable support of the numbering pieces.



Picture 2:

Find another colour of scrap leather and punch a few 5mm pieces with the round punch, and glue and insert as per this picture.



Picture 3:

Continue the above process until you have this result.

Now you are ready for stitching.

NB: You can cut high density sponge to fit inside the dice, or you can fill it with river sand to use as a paper weight.

The tools required for this build are:

- a) Printer to print Black & White PDF files onto A4 sized paper
- b) Stanley knife with new blades
- c) Waxed thread 1mm and 2 (two) matching harness needles (it does not require sharp points)
- d) Vegetable tanned 2.4mm (5-6oz).
- e) Hole punches both 1.0mm & 5mm.
- f) Contact glue - to glue round pieces and scrap leather to the back of parts.

Important Tips:

- 1) Take your time and prepare all the parts for this project before you start the assembly process.
- 2) Now carefully look at the pictures to see where every part must go. It is actually very easy to build, and I cannot wait to see what your project looks like.

Printing the pattern:

Check out the – **Printer Setting Page**. The (yellow coloured circles) indicates which boxes must be checked to ensure that the correct printing size is selected, before you print the – **Test Page** - . **(This is very important)**

Once the – **Test Page** – is printed, measure both the vertical and horizontal sides with a ruler to ensure it is correct, before you print the actual pattern pages.
