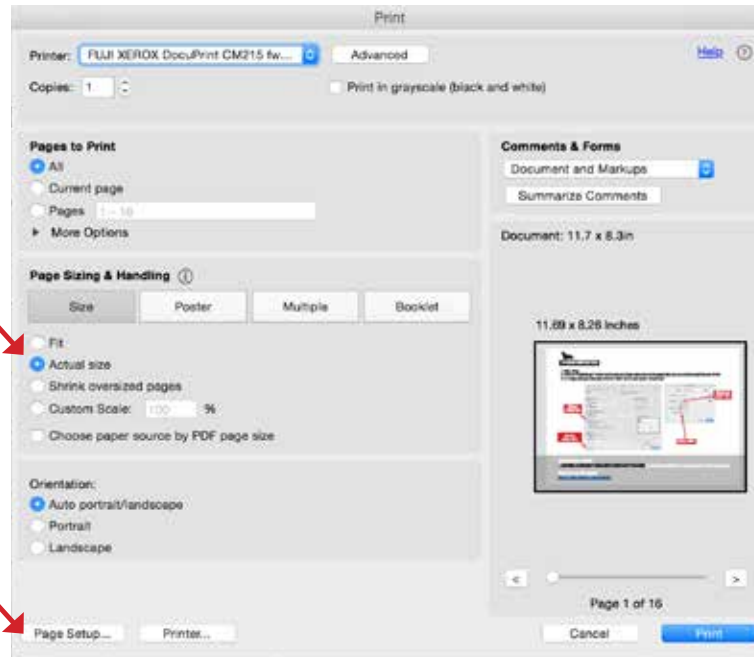


PRINTING INSTRUCTION

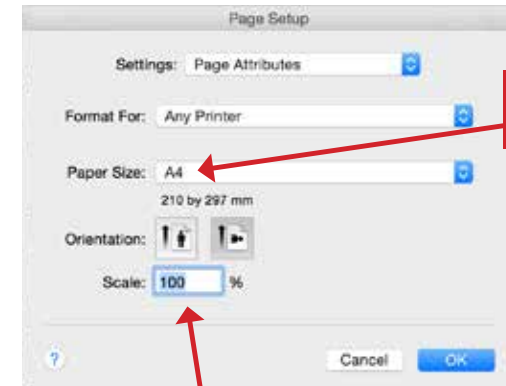
1. File > Print
