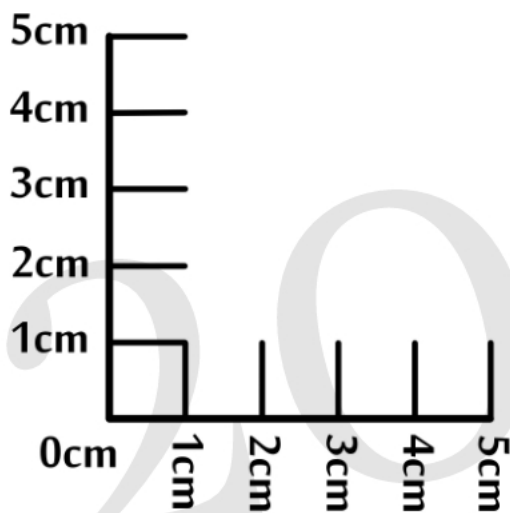
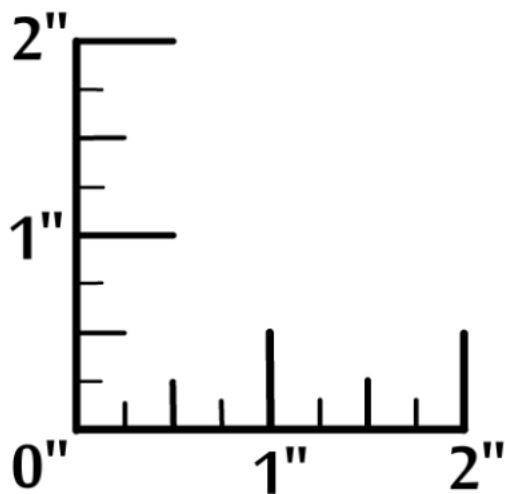


Pattern Assembly Template

To print on a home printer select 100% or true to scale (depending on your printer/software). Another setting that sometimes gets overlooked is the poster setting. For some printers/software you'll need to select that as well so that all the pages get printed. You may also need to select "separate pages to multiple sheets" before you are allowed to select print at 100%.

Medium Sided Tray/Liner, Use a 5oz to 6oz Leather (2mm-2.4mm)

1. Start by measuring the space you want the tray to sit in. It can be a drawer, a basket, or an open section of counter space. It can also be square or rectangle. If the bottom of a drawer you measure is 10"x 10" that will be your base measurement.
2. Add 3" (7.62cm) to each measurement. So for instance if you're base measurement is 10"x 10", you'll have a final measurement of 13"x 13".
3. Cut out your square or rectangle piece with your altered size.
4. Cut the corner templates out right on the black lines. I suggest putting clear box tape over the front and back before hand to stiffen the paper up. Punch out the holes using a hole punch that matches the size of rivets you'll be using. Use a 1/4" hole punch or similar to punch out the bottom of the groove (A). The zigzag line doesn't need to be followed. Just trim off the excess paper along that line however you want.
5. Place the templates up to the corner of the leather using the two straight sides to square up the template on the leather. You'll notice the template is mirrored to make a more uniform looking tray. If you don't want to use the left corner and right corner template you can use just one or the other to have all the folds going in one direction.
6. Trace the pattern onto the leather. Including the holes. Don't trace the back of the template where the zigzag line is.
7. Remove the template, punch the holes with the right size punch for the rivets you'll be using. Punch the bottom of the groove marked with an A using a 1/4" hole punch or something close.
8. Cut the pattern out of your leather just inside your marked lines.
9. Dye and finish your leather however you wish. It may be helpful to bend it into shape while it's got some moisture in it.
10. Once it's dry rivet each corner together. If you're trying to have it fit a drawer, basket, or something with sides. You may want to work it into shape a bit for a cleaner fit.
