The Leather Cap to fit sizes - 61.5cm down to 59.5cm

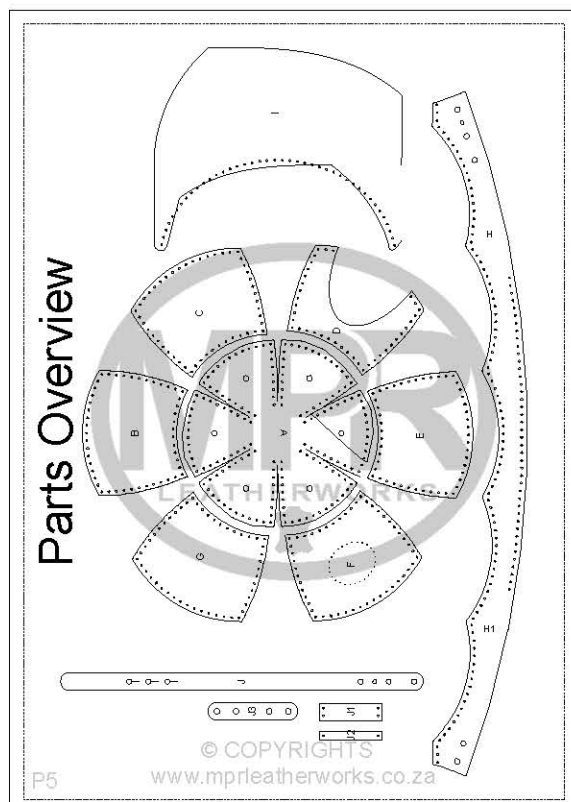
The Leather Cap was made with vegetable tanned top grain leather +-2.0mm (5-6oz) thickness.

NB: YOU can obviously resize and add the holes precisely as required.

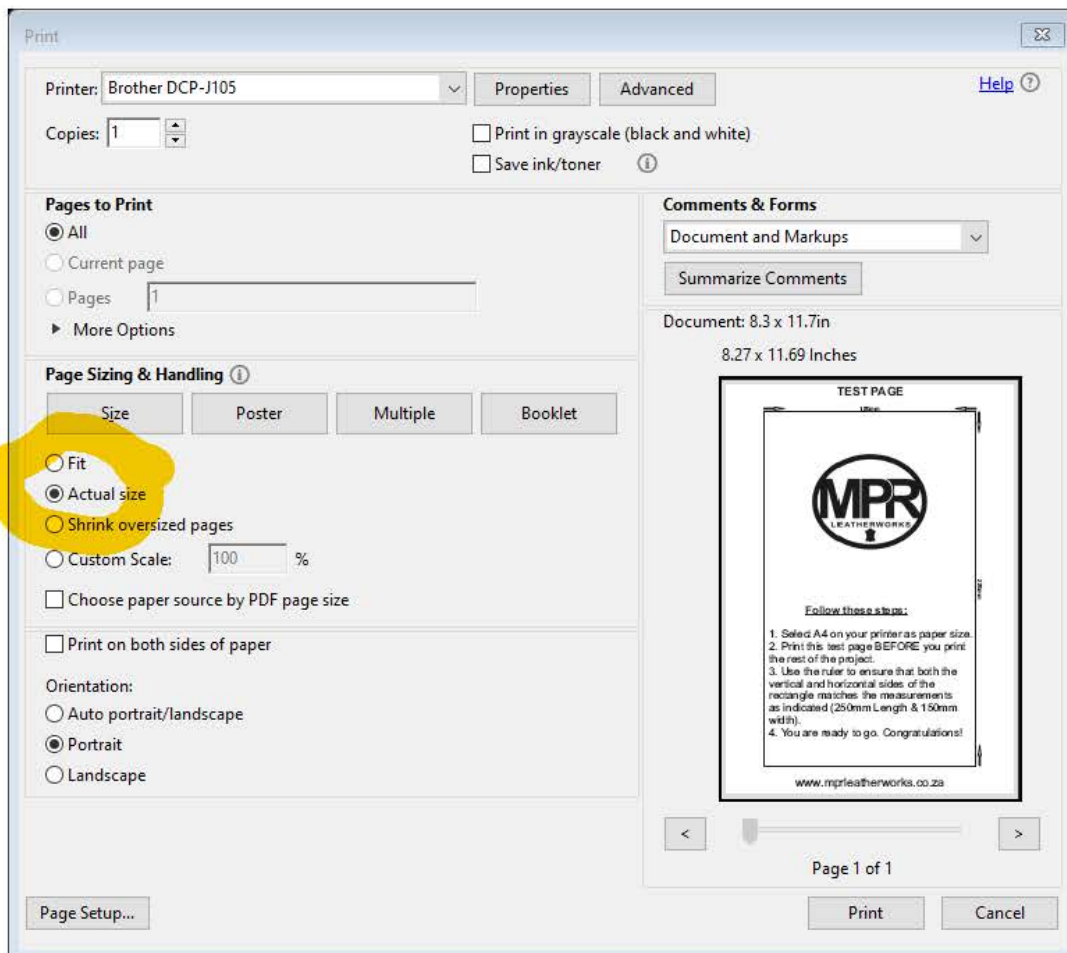
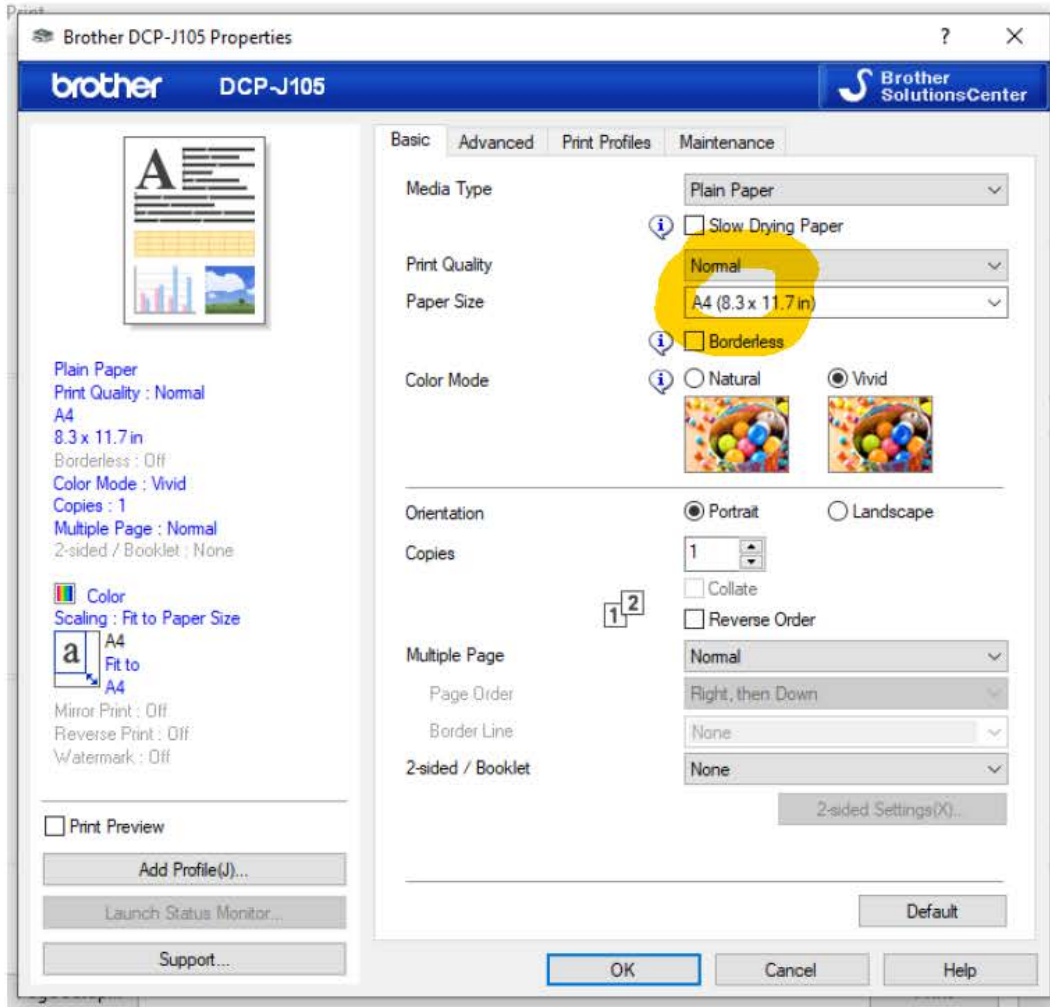


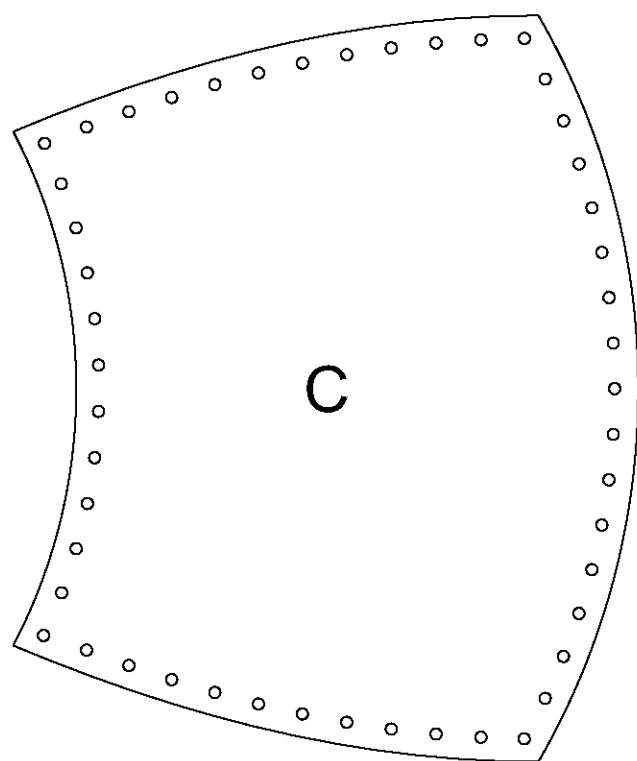
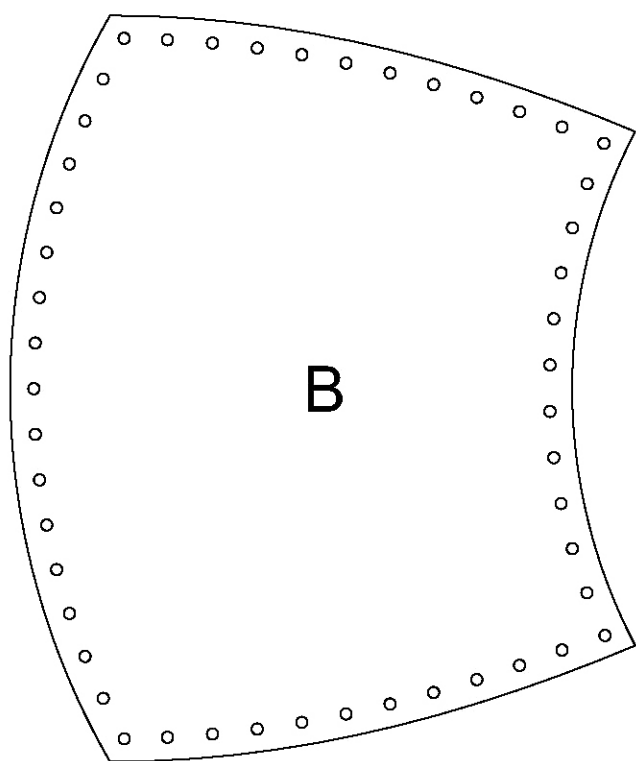
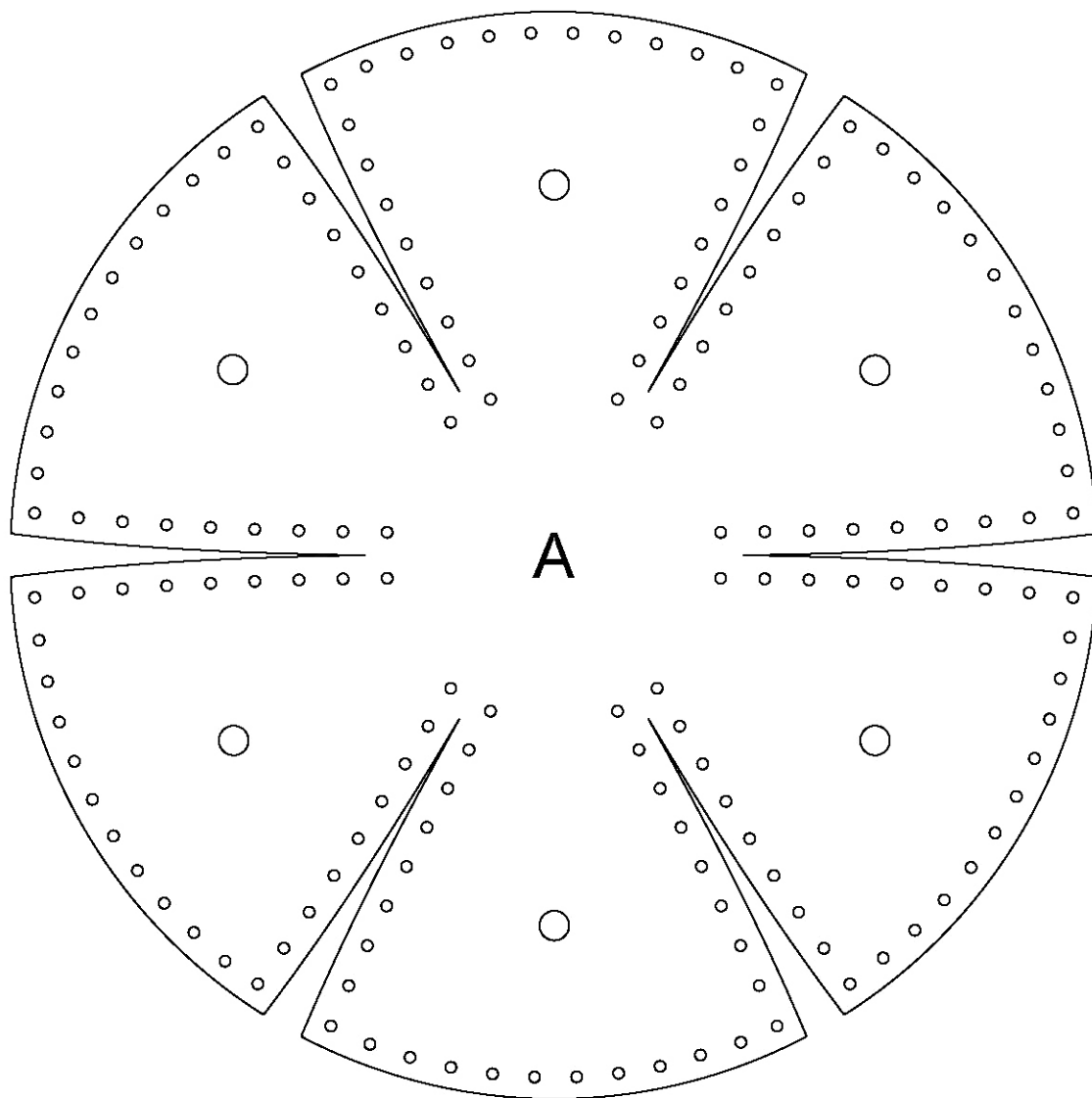


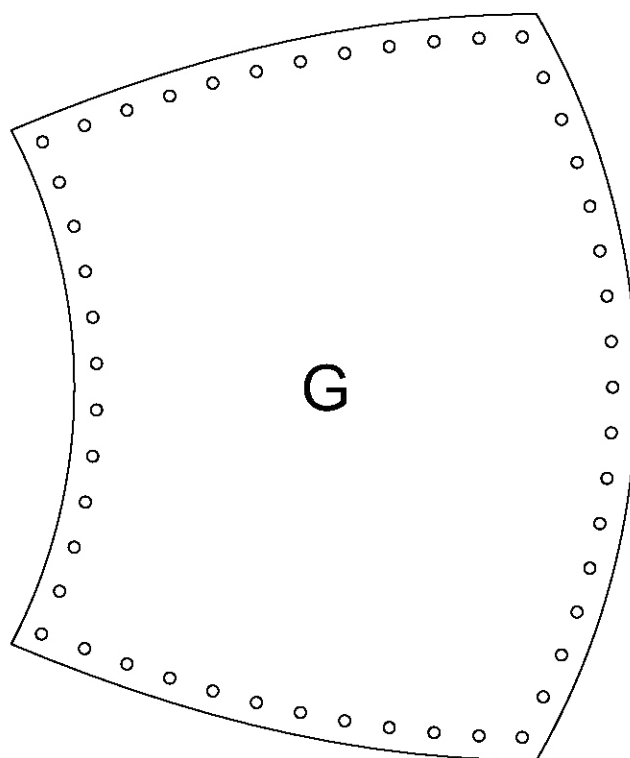
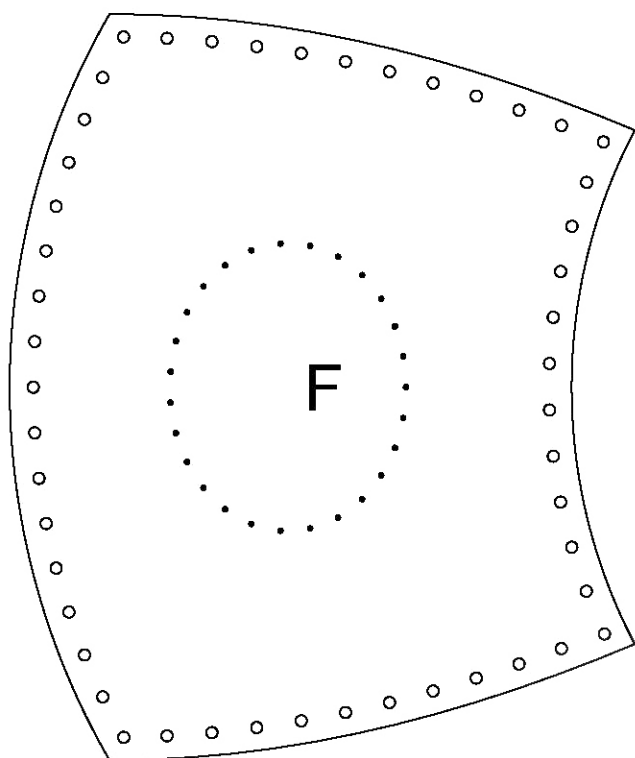
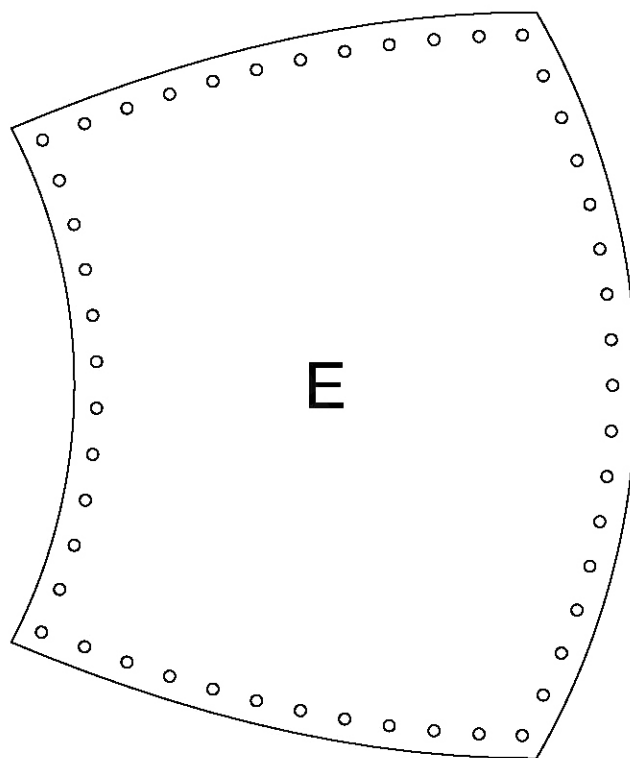
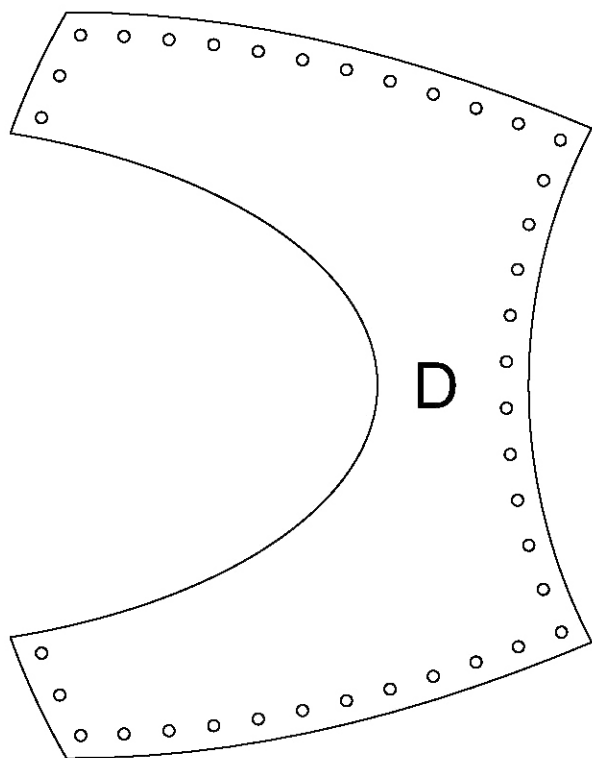
The tools required for this build are:

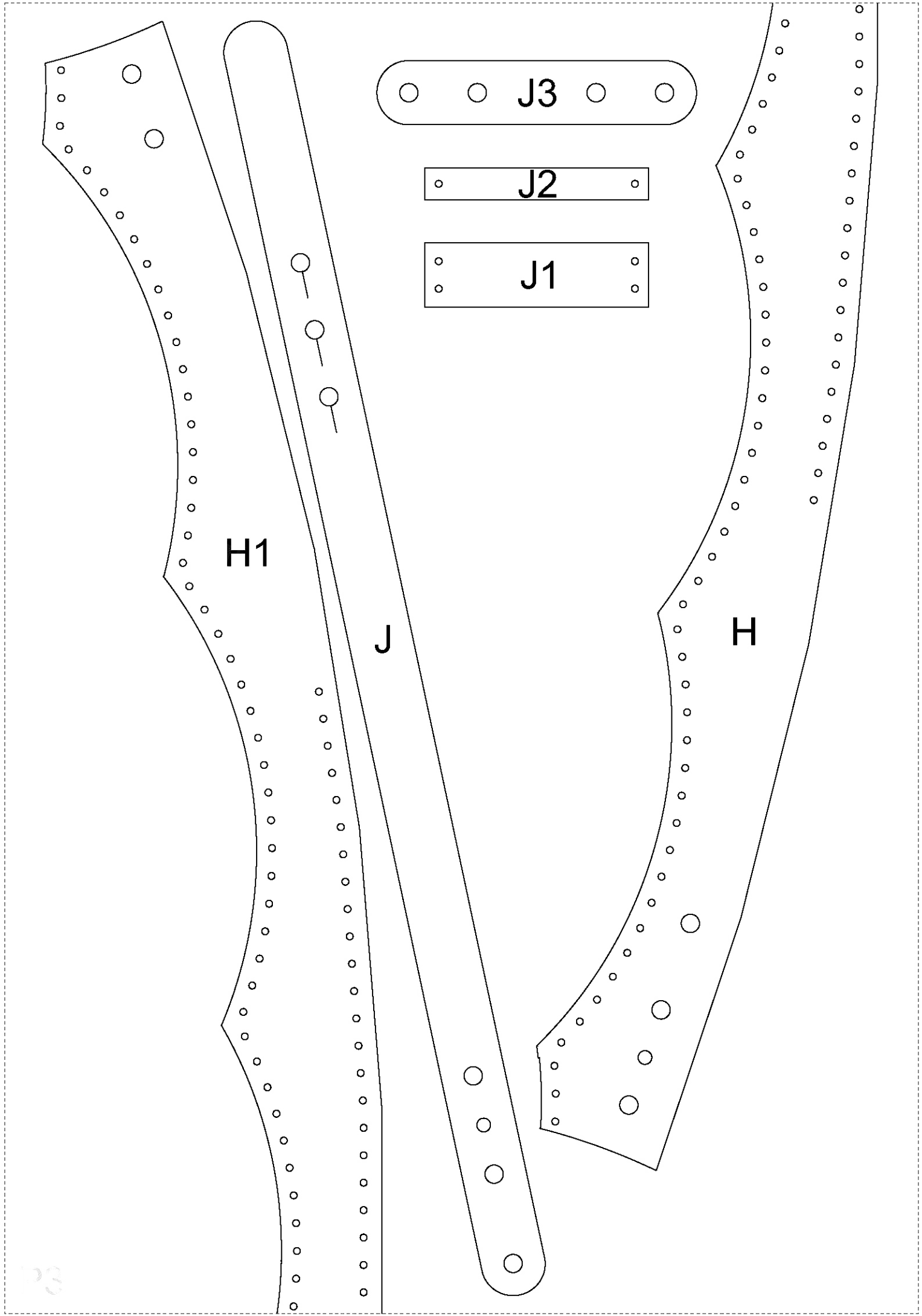
- a) Printer to print Black & White PDF files onto A4 sized paper
- b) Stanley knife with sharp new blades

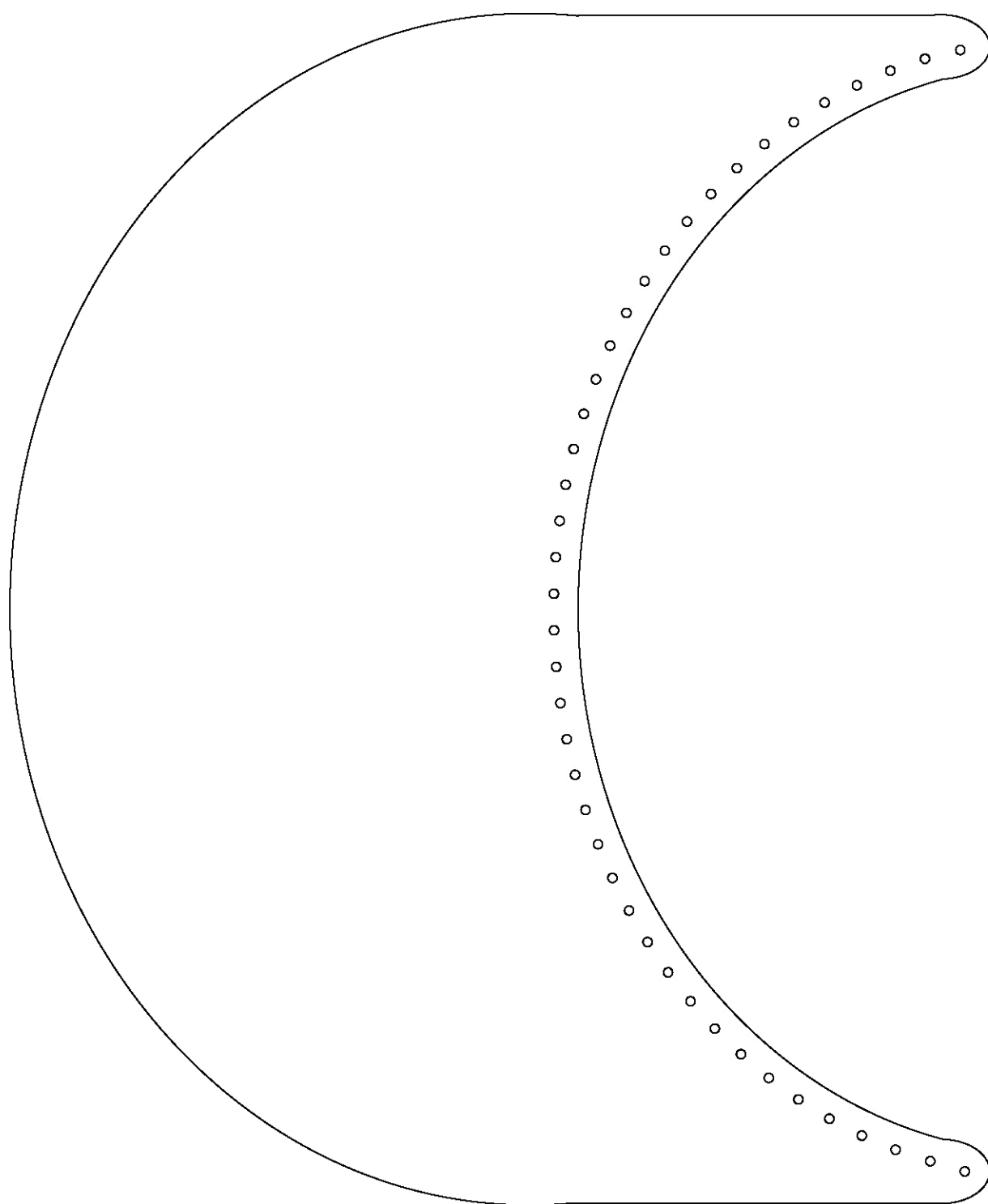
