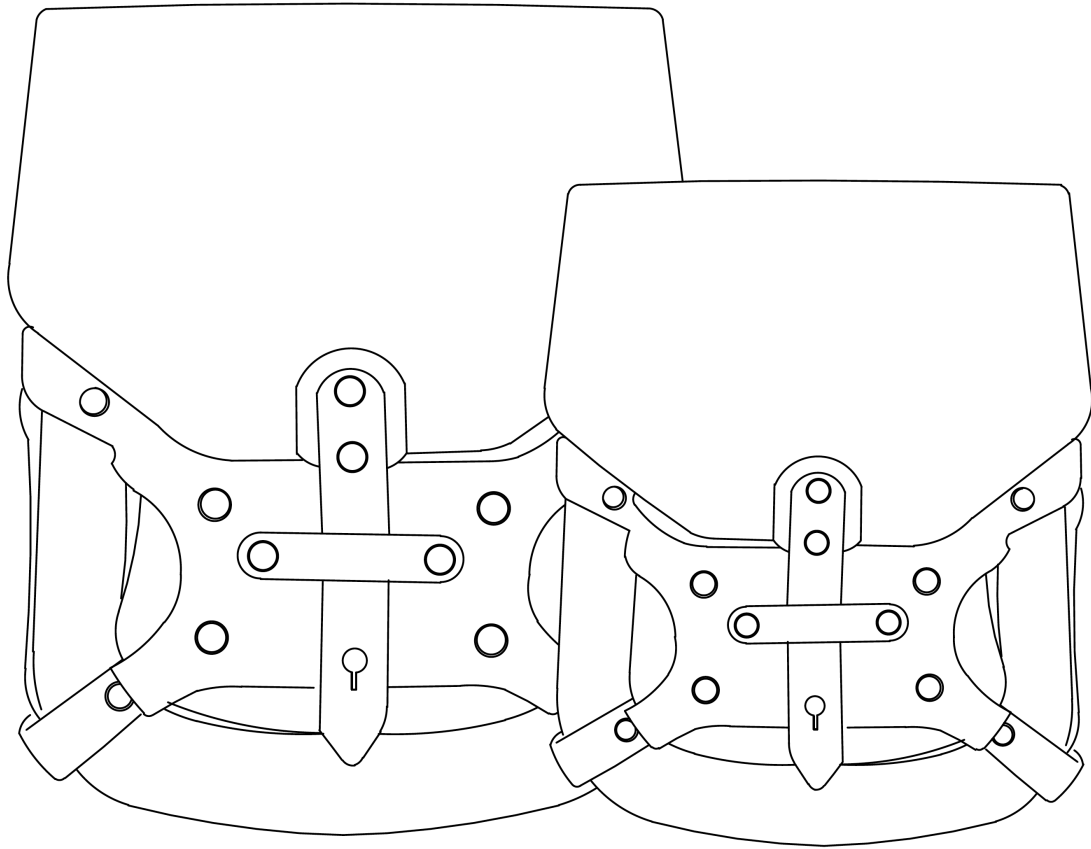

LEATHER BACKPACK



Assembly instructions

Completion Time	14-18 hours

NECESSARY TOOLS

B&W Printer



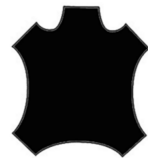
Scissors or a cutter



Hole Puncher



10-13 square feet of leather, 6 oz



Thread and needles

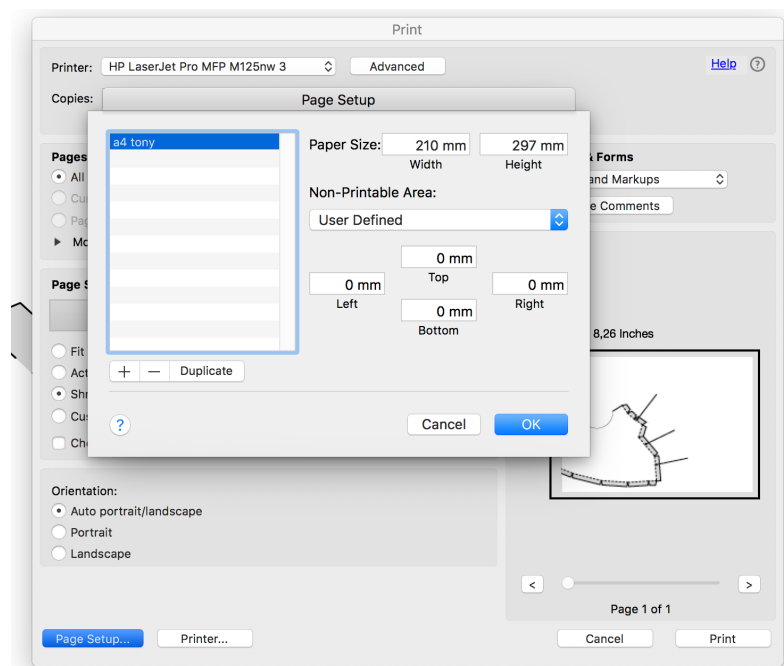


8 Buckles and a few rivets

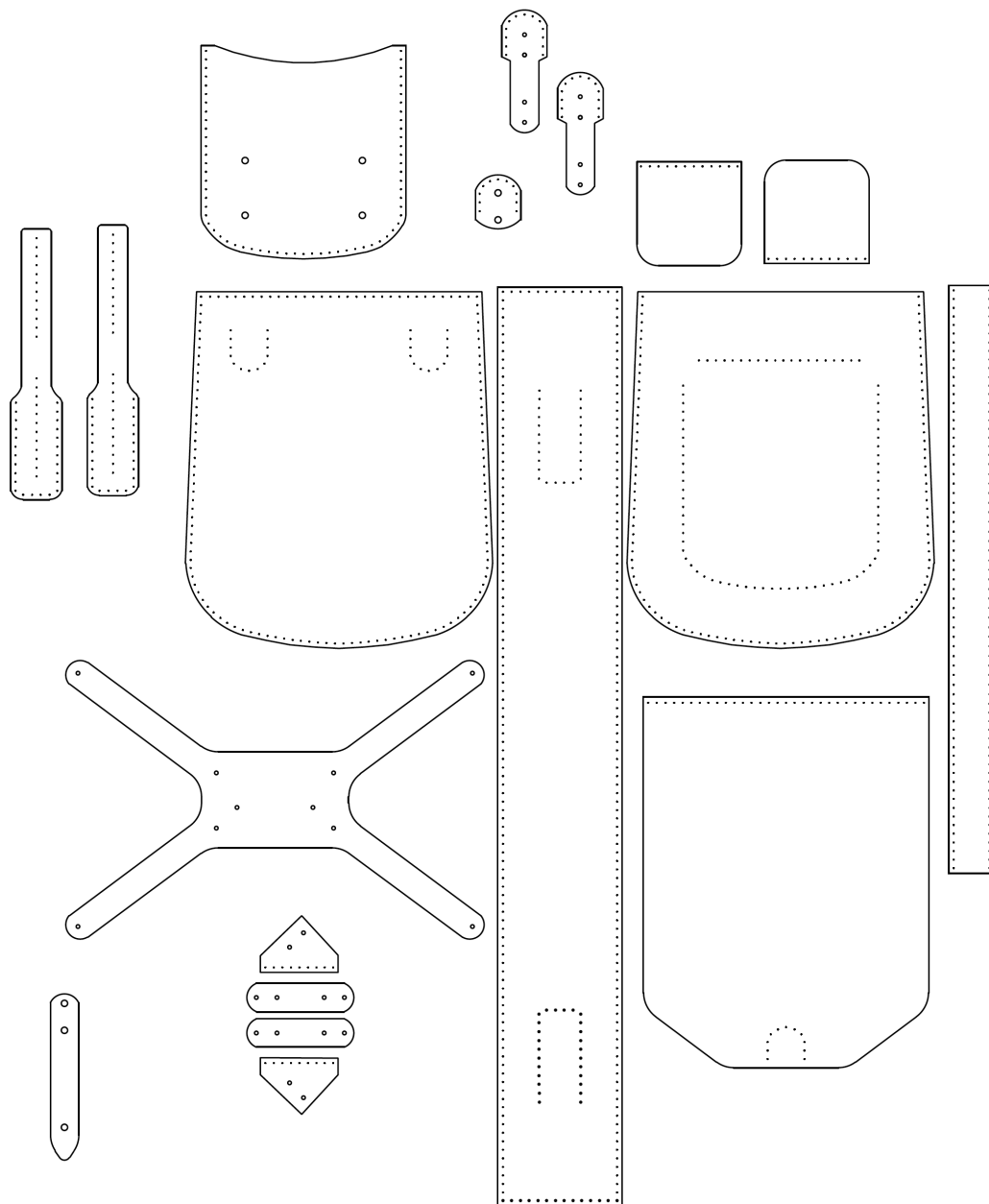
PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your printer to A4 paper with no margins on landscape mode.

Alternatively you can use “letter” format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product



Print your patterns. Cut out all the parts and paste them as shown in the picture below.
I recommend using 6 oz leather(2,4 mm) for best results



Use these templates to cut the leather and make the stitching holes. As always with any of my patterns EVERY STITCHING HOLE is precisely placed and necessary. The more accurate you mark them and make them the better the stitching will be
