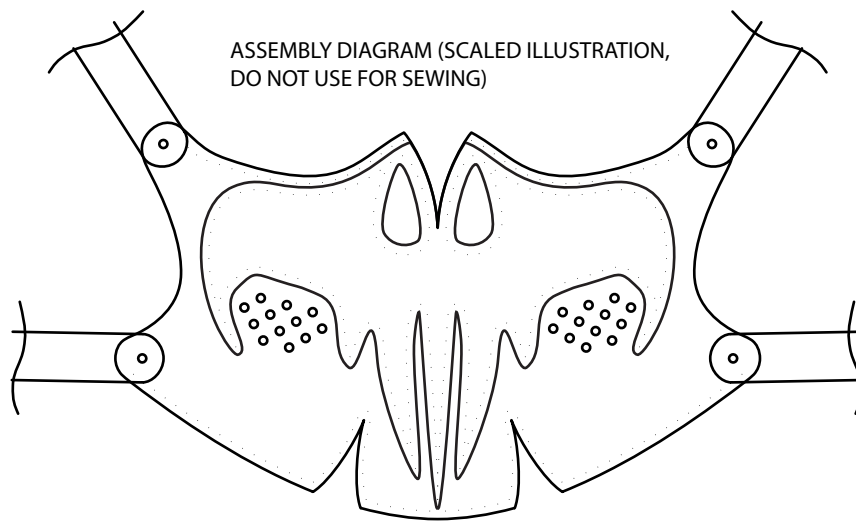
Мы с вами коллеги, поэтому давайте уважать друг друга.

Skull Biker Mask





Materials:

You will need around 1-1.5 sq.ft of leather, plus straps. Something around 2-3 oz for the appliqué, 2 oz for filter flaps, mask itself can be made of anything from 3 to 5 oz.

Hardware:

2 x 3/4 buckles

Rivets

Tools:

Scissors, knife.

Mallet, rivet setter, hole punchers (round for rivets and oblong for buckles).

Instructions:

Print the pattern at actual size (100%). Use the reference on top of each page to make sure everything is printed correctly. Join the pages A1 and B1 together.

This project is all about precision and accuracy. Use the diagram for the reference.

The last holes in teeth and cheeks are tricky, I use an awl to make them.

First, sew the skull onto the mask. This is a loooong stitching line (like 35-40" long) but it is possible to sew it all with one thread, see assembly file. Join the upper notch.

Second, attach the flaps, upper is straightforward, the lower goes in one seam together with the notches. If you want to make the notches first, that's ok too.

Attach the straps.

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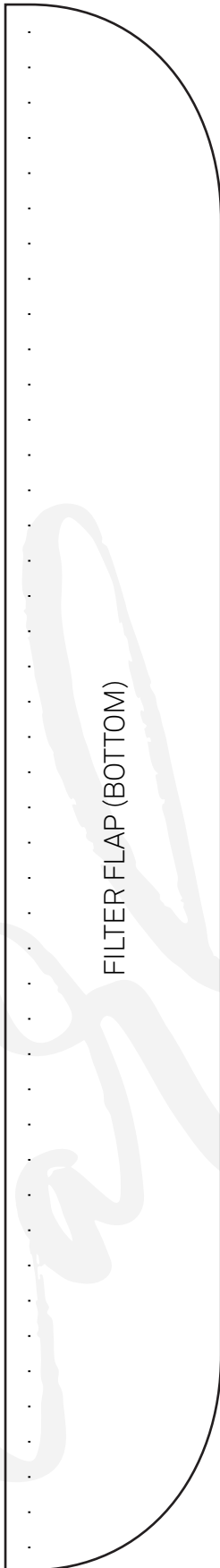

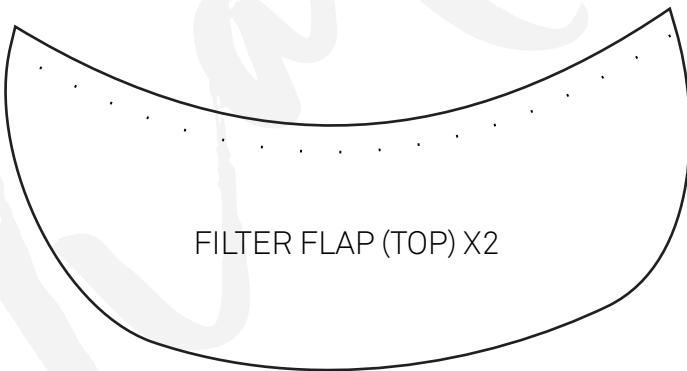
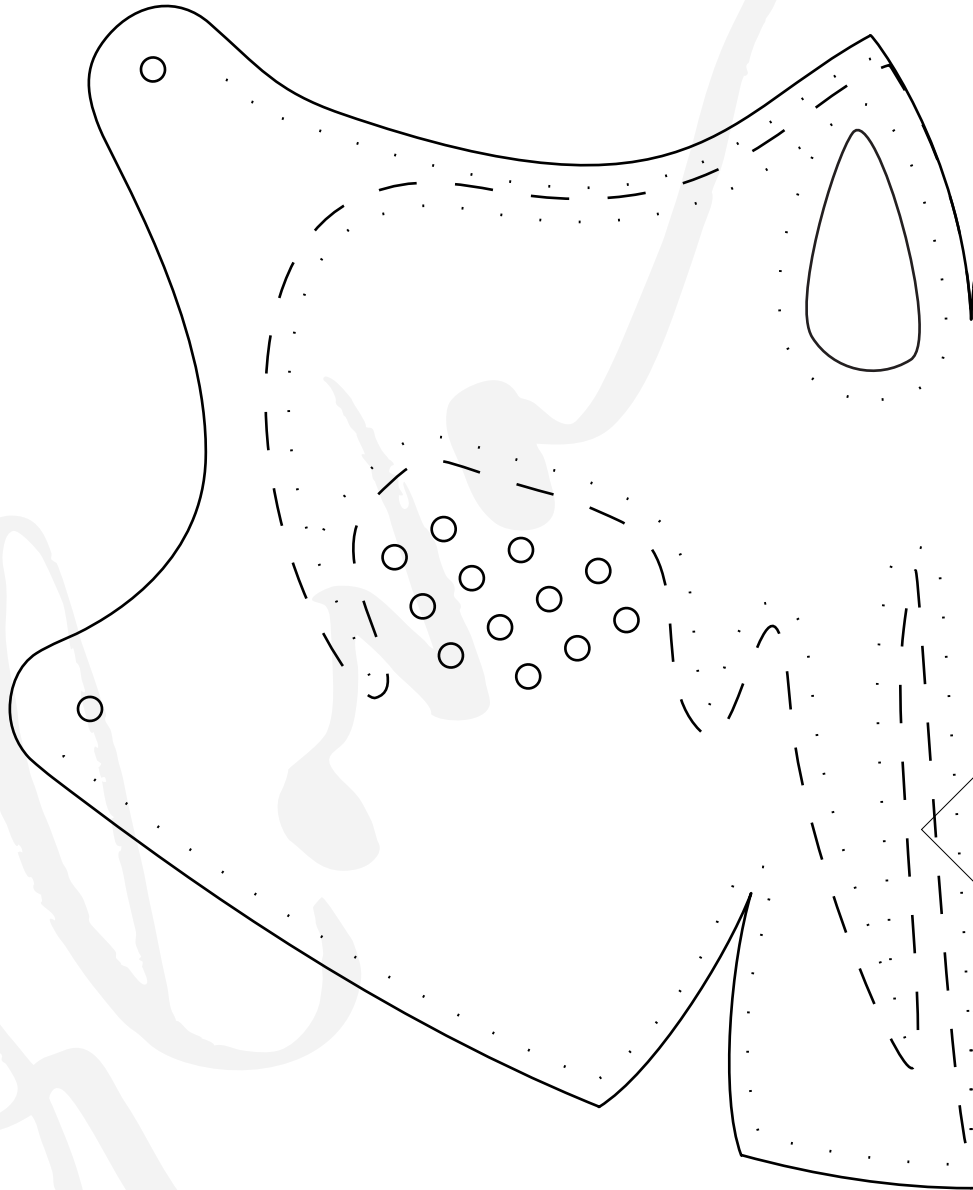

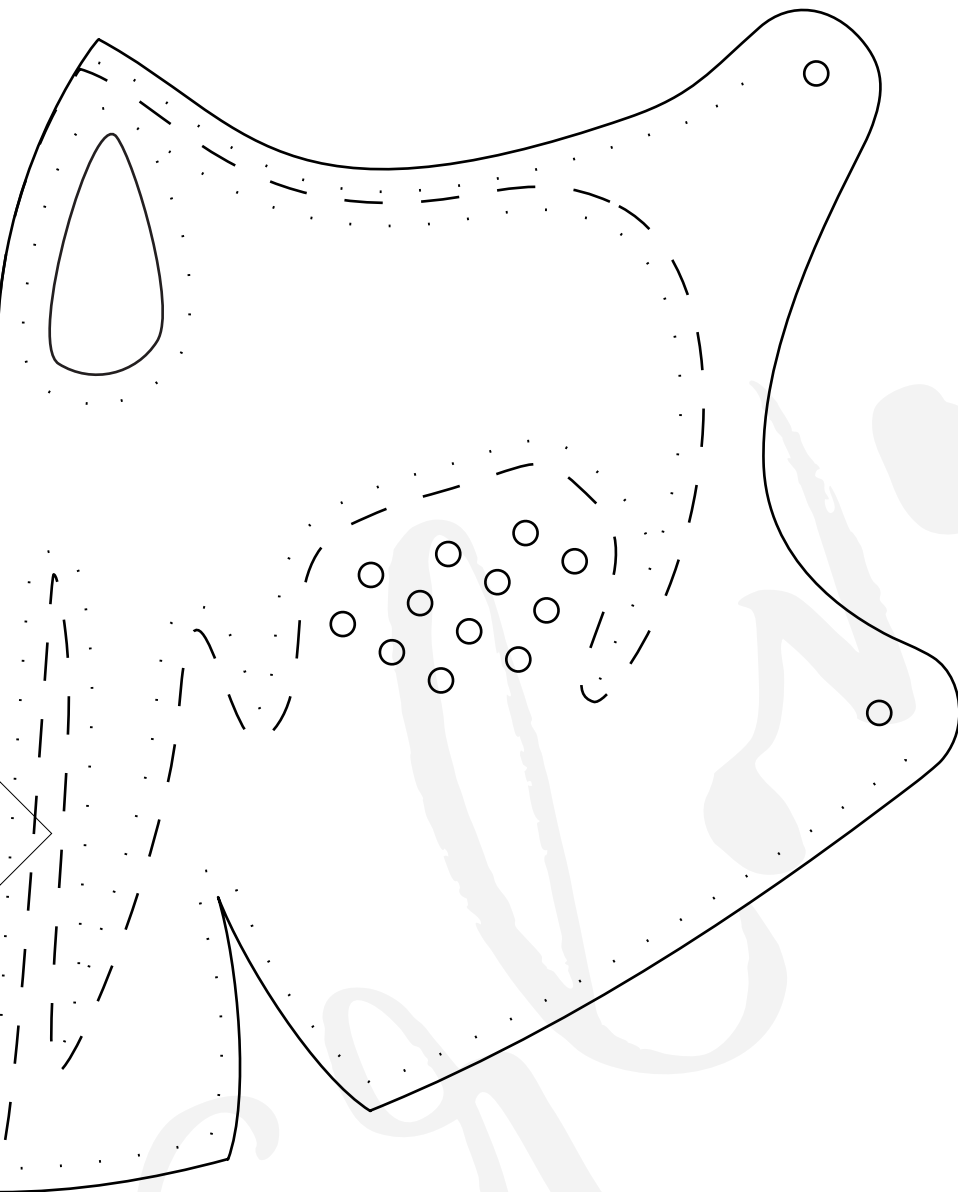


FILTER FLAP (TOP) X2
