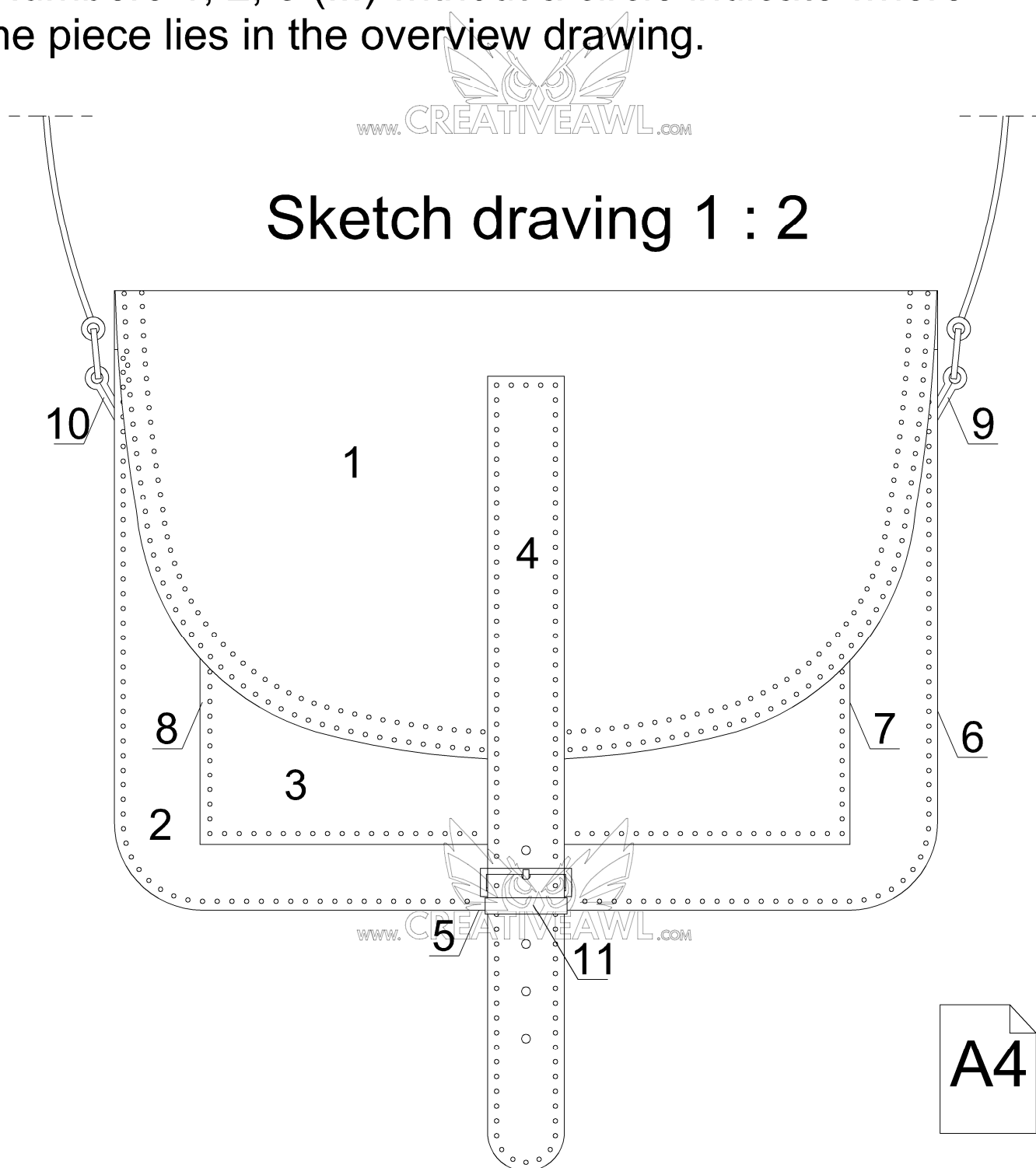

-Numbers 1, 2, 3 (...) without a circle indicate where the piece lies in the overview drawing.

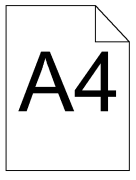
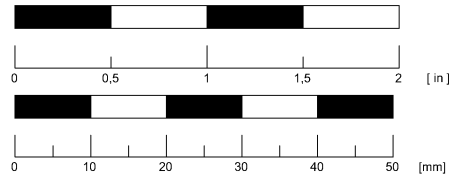
