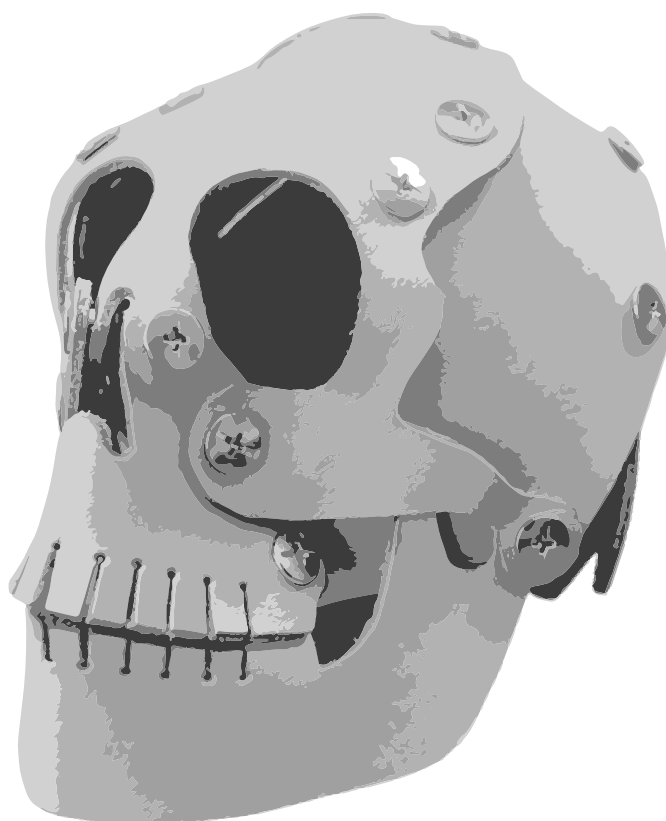


Riveted Skull Decoration (Child size)

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Bill of Materials

- | | |
|--|-----------------------------------|
| [] 6oz leather (about 0.2m ²) | [] 7.5, 5mm and 0.5 hole punches |
| [] 22x chicago screws or rivets | [] X-acto and/or Scissors |

Instructions

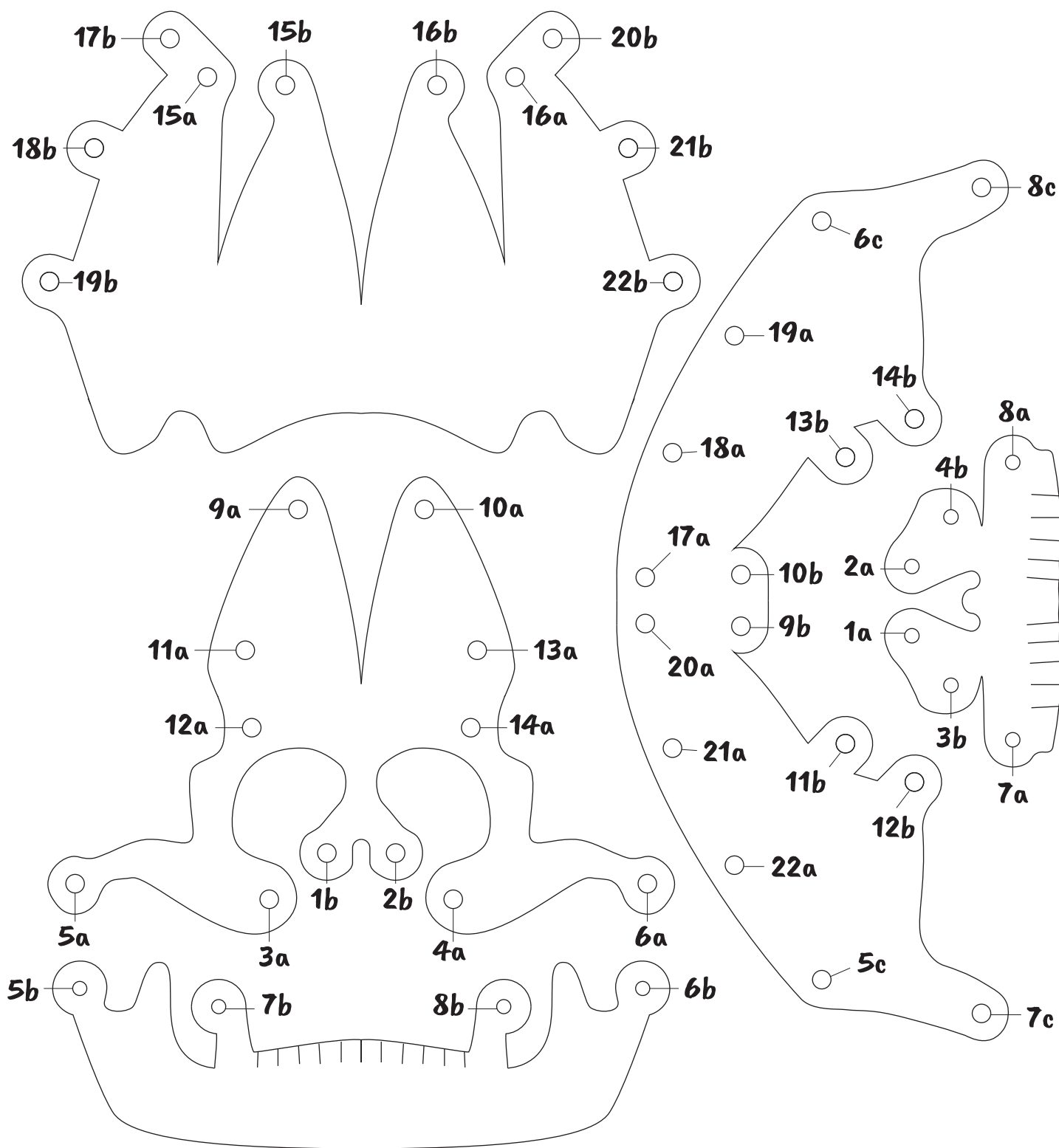
1. Print the pattern on A4 paper.
2. Roughly cut-out around the 5 different elements of the skull's pattern.
3. Secure the different elements of the pattern on your piece of leather with masking tape.
4. Punch-out the 22 rivet holes with a 5mm hole punch (or else depending on the rivets that you used). Punch a 0.5mm hole at the roots of each tooth.
5. Cut-out the individual teeth.
6. Cut-out the different elements of the skull from the leather using the pattern as a guide.
7. Assemble the skull with chicago screws or rivets. Use the **Pattern Assembly Diagram** as a guide in order to do so.
The **number** associated with each hole reflects the order according to which the skull should be assembled.
The following **letter** indicates the position of the piece in relation to the other pieces sharing the same rivet - "a" goes on top of "b" which goes on top of "c".
