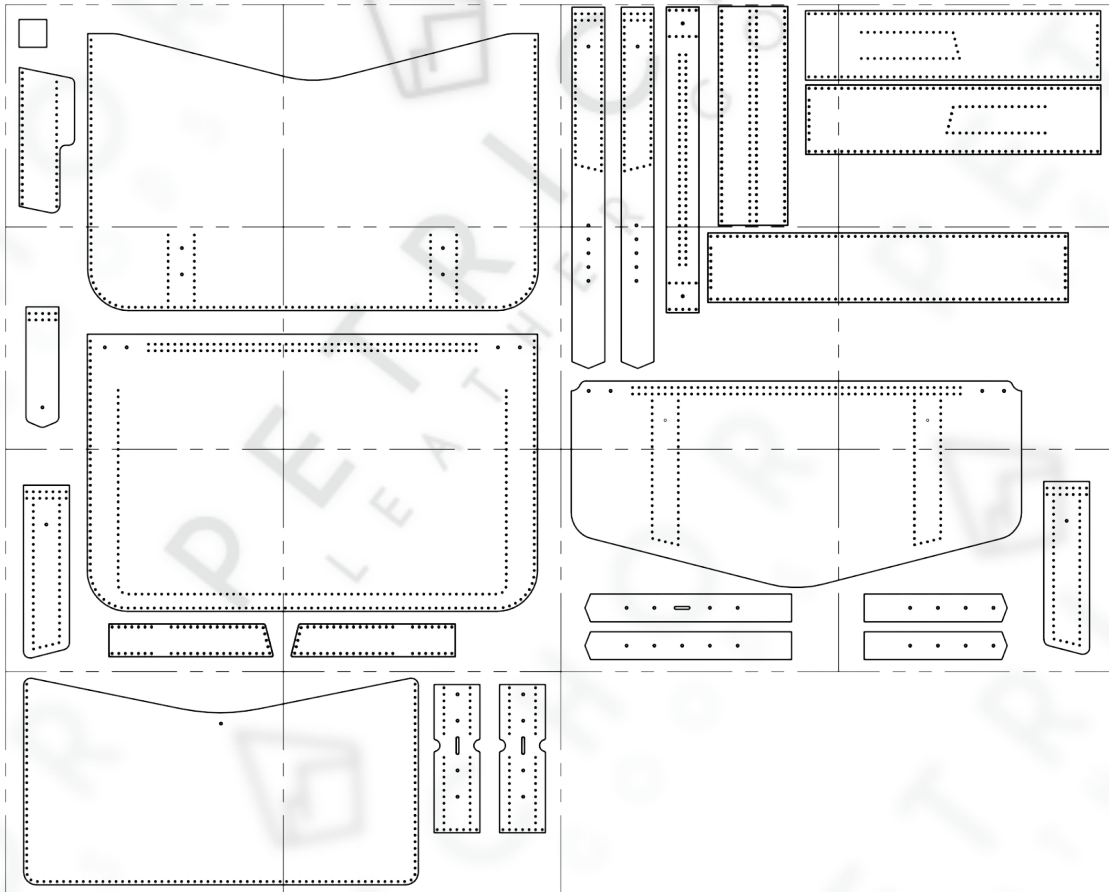

PROJECT LAYOUT

ASSEMBLED PATTERN

When printing the pattern, ensure you are able to clearly see the initial cut lines (dashed lines).

If pattern spans across multiple pages, you will need to first **cut along the 8"x10" DASHED cut line** in order to get a perfect fit. (it will seem like you are cutting off parts of the pattern, but do not worry, these are outside the overlapped cut line and have been accounted for.



Once EACH 8"x10" dashed square is cut from each sheet, assemble the pattern as shown above. Cut the solid lines from the pattern, place onto your leather and cut/punch your holes.

TOOLS & MATERIALS

5-6 square feet of leather (4.6-6 ounces for best results)

Thread

2 - 1 inch D-Rings

16 rivets

2 - 1.25 inch buckles

1 - 1 inch Strap Stay (Rectangle Strap Stay)

1 button

2 - Strap Clasps (Lobster Clasps)

TIPS WHEN BUILDING

- Cut out all pattern pieces along the 8"x10" dashed line and assemble pieces as shown in the Project Layout. Tape to your leather. Punch holes and cut each piece along the solid lines.
- Apply any preferred leather treatments such as dye, mink oil, leather liners, and/or Tokonole (Tokonole to the flesh side) and paint any edges as you see fit.
- Affix Back pocket and ONE SIDE of the pen holder to the Back Body piece
 - Attach button to back pocket and pocket strap
- Affix the Buckle Straps and buckles to the Main body by thread, then by rivets
- Assemble Main Flap by attaching decorative strap and main straps to the flap
- Assemble Gusset sections and attach the strap holders with D-Rings
- Assemble Handle and attach to Main Flap
- Begin stitching together the assembled Back Body piece to the Main Flap, then rivet
- Attach Gusset to Main Body
- Attach Assembled Gusset/Main Body to Back Body/Flap
- Assemble the straps and attach to Gusset D-rings

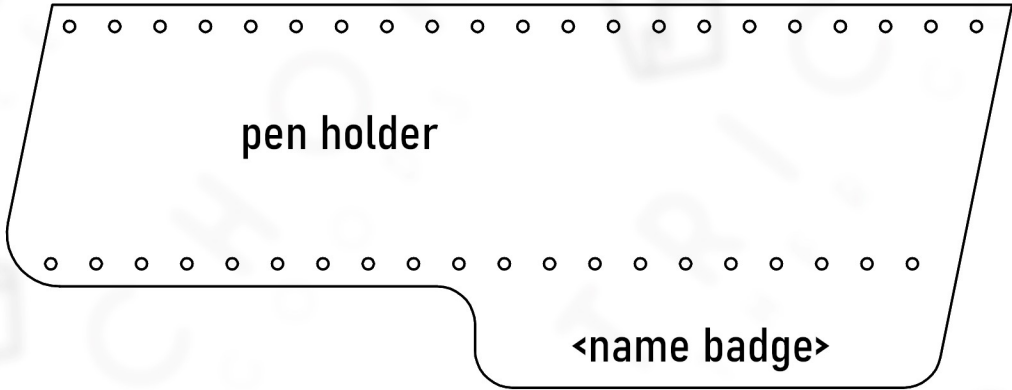
