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Two Ways of Making a Bag

INTRODUCTION

- In this video I will show you how to make the same bag in two different ways: I will use different materials and different decorative elements, but the bags are essentially the same.
- The first one is from vegetable tanned leather.
- The second one is from a thin leather lined with leather and shoe stiffener (PITEX).
- First you should cut the longest piece: the shoulder strap.
- You should leave a margin of 0.15-0.2" (4-5 mm) around the pattern line of the lined bag because after lining, you will have to recut on the patterns lines for obtaining a sharp edge.

DIMENSIONS

- Height: 12" (31 cm)
- Length: 6.3-7" (16-18 cm)
- Width: 2.8" (7 cm)



MATERIALS-Vegtan Bag

- BODY: around 5.4 sq ft (0.5 sqm) of 5-4.5 oz (2-2.2 mm) vegetable tanned leather.
- CONTRAST LEATHER: 6.5-7 oz (2.6-2.8 mm) leather
- SHOULDER STRAP: the longest piece is around 49" (125 cm).
- leather glue
- 1 mm waxed polyester thread

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MATERIALS-Red Lined Bag

- BODY: around 5.4 sq ft (0.5 sqm) of 2.5-3 oz (1-1.2 mm) leather.
- LINING: around 5.4 sq ft (0.5 sqm) of 2.5 oz (1 mm) leather
- CONTRAST LEATHER: 6-7 oz (2.4-2.8 mm) leather
- SHOULDER STRAP: the longest piece is around 49" (125 cm).
- leather glue
- 1 mm waxed polyester thread
- edge dye



HARDWARE

Vegtan Bag

- 1 x 1.18" (30 mm) buckles
- 3 x 0.79" (20 mm) D rings
- 1 x magnetic clasp

Red Lined Bag

- 1 x 1.18" (30 mm) buckles
- 2 x 0.79" (20 mm) D rings
- 1 x magnetic clasp



TOOLS & EQUIPMENT

- cutter
- needles
- 1.5 mm hole punch
- cutting mat
- mallet
