

Miniature Tote



Materials:

Use your scraps! About 3 oz for the body and pocket and 4-5 oz for handles.

Hardware:

2 x rivets

1 x closure snap

Tools:

Scissors, knife (paper knife or rotary cutter would also work).

Stitching irons: my pattern is made for 5mm stitching irons (5 stitches per inch). If you are willing to use any other size please make sure that the hole count is the same where it has to be the same.

Needles - according to your thread size, a pair of harness needles.

Mallet, rivet setter.

Instructions:

Print the pattern at actual size (100%). Use the reference on top of each page to make sure everything is printed correctly. Cut the pieces.

Stitch the pocket onto the body - note that body has 2 more holes in that seam, those are used to secure the pocket edge.

Install the handles - rivet each handle end to the corresponding spot on the body.

Install the closure snap.

Stitch the body: it is a turned bag, so fold it in the middle flesh side out and stitch each side starting from the top of the bag. I used the same thread to stitch the bottom T-parts, just because I didn't want to re-thread the needles. Align the side seam with the central hole on the T-part and stitch one side, then stitch back and stitch the other side of the T-part. Repeat on the other side of the bag.

Turn the bag right side out and admire your work! :-)
