TOOLS

Tools you need:

- sharp knife
- 1,2-1,5mm hole puncher or pricking irons or awl
- hammer
- 2 needles
- paper tape
- a home printer

MATERIALS

- Leather (preferable 2-3oz and 4-5oz for outside panel)
- Waxed thread (preferable 0,8-1 mm)
- Few rivets
- snap
