B&W Printer



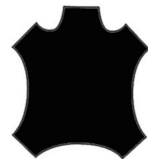
Scissors or a cutter



Hole Puncher



A few scraps of leather



Thread and needles



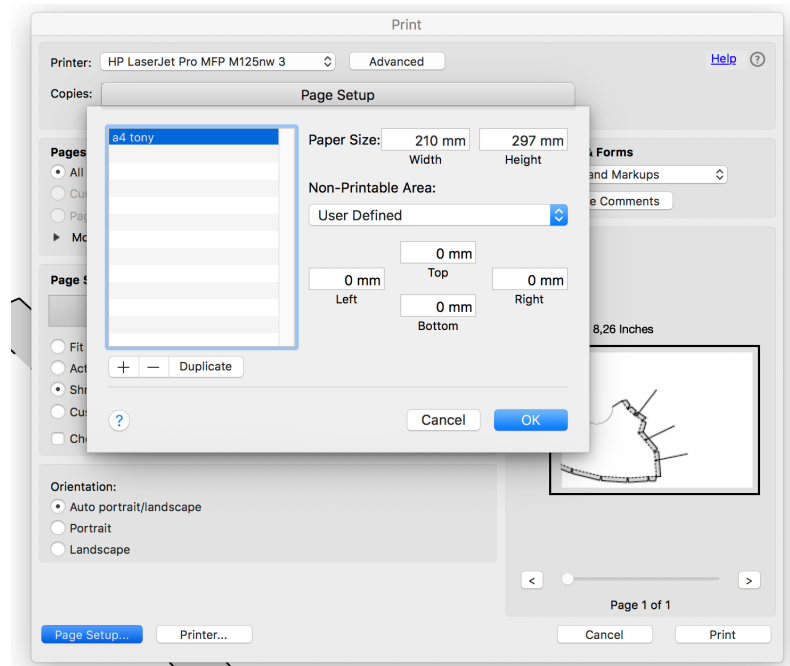
3 x 20 mm Buckles and a few rivets

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PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your printer to A4 paper with no margins on landscape mode.

Alternatively you can use “letter” format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product significantly

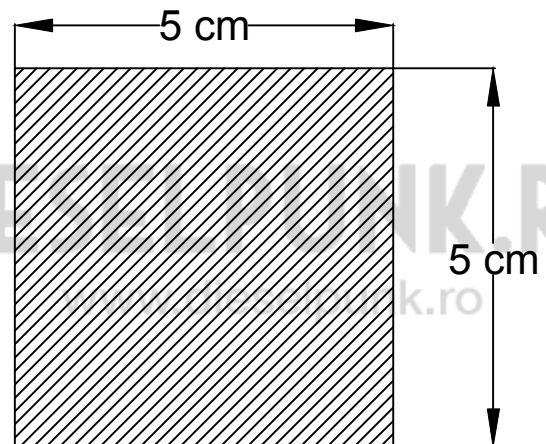
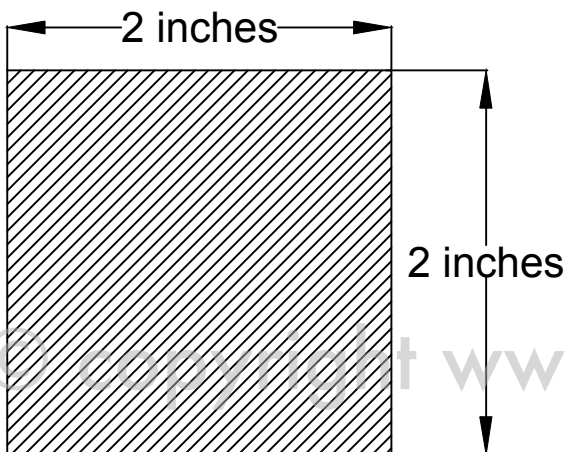




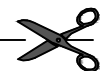

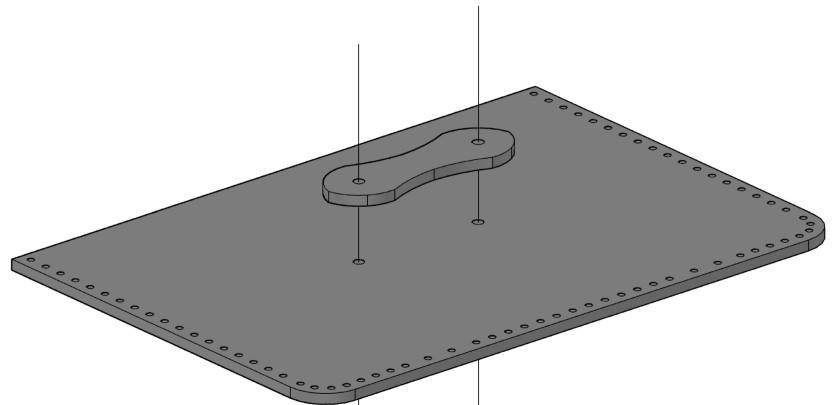




Print all the patterns and cut them in leather. After you punch the holes you should have every piece ready as shown in the picture shown below:



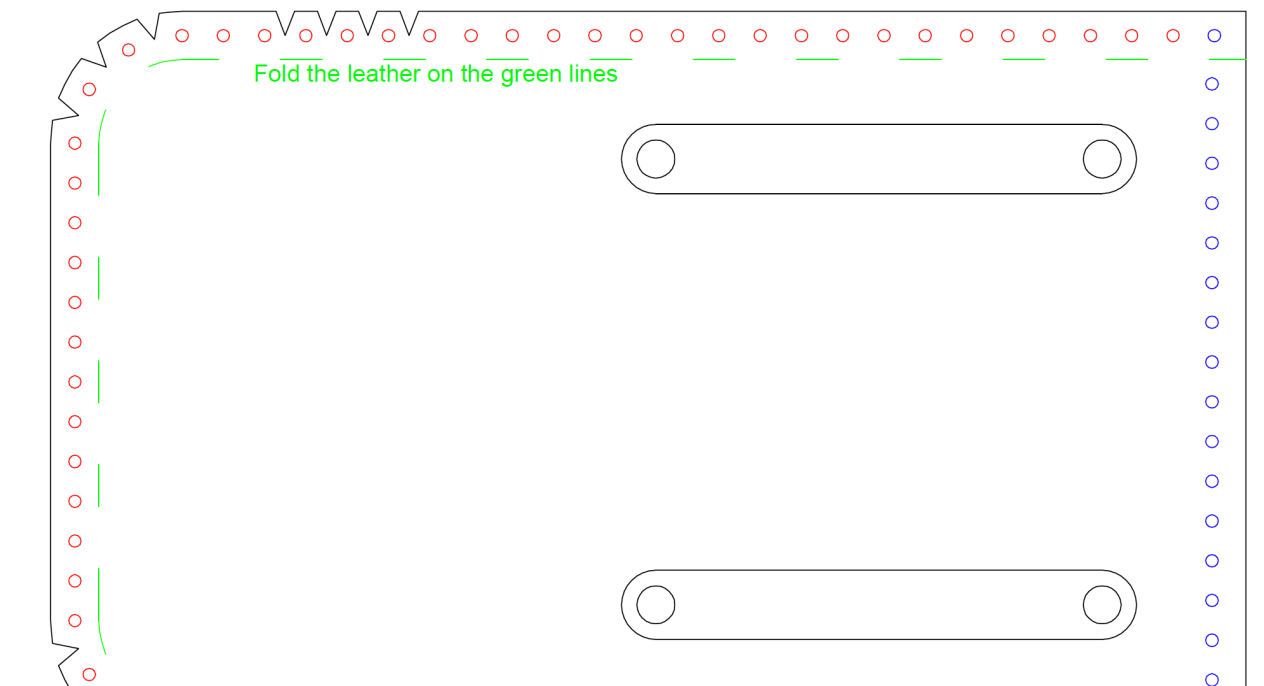
First thing you should do is attach the straps and the other small pieces by rivets. Use the number codes to make sure you attach everything where it should be, eg 1 to 1, 2 to 2 and so forth



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After all the small pieces are attached and before you start stitching it is a good idea to fold the leather along the green lines

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Use the saddle stitching technique and use the color codes to help you match the right holes. Be careful with the spacing as it is carefully calculated so it matches the shape of the leather when it bends. There are only 4 stitching lines so take your time to make sure your pouch comes out nicely

After you are done with all the stitching you should have something like this:
