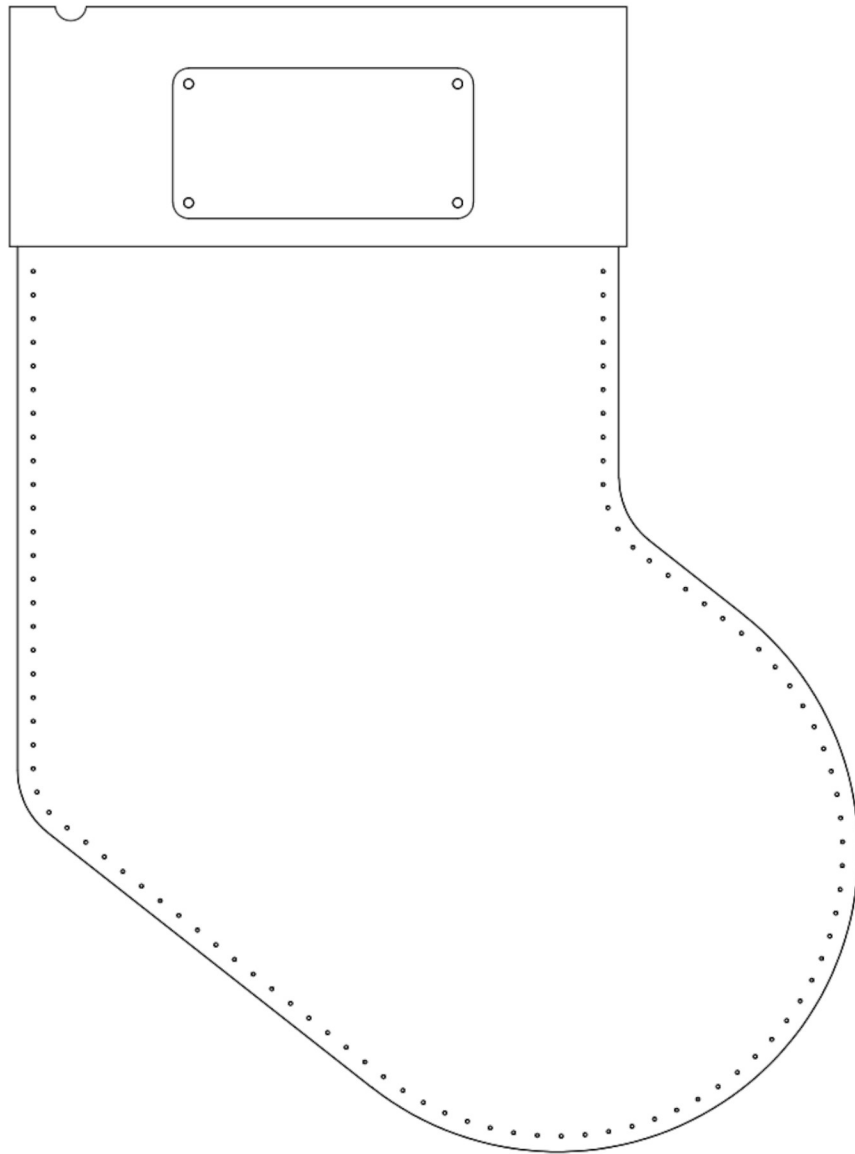
PDF PATTERN AND INSTRUCTIONS

PROJECT OVERVIEW

(expected build result)

The Holiday Stocking

Dimensions: 12" x 8"



This pattern comes with pre-defined holes to attach a name badge using rivets. Alternatively, if you lack rivets, instead of punching the four holes for the name badge, you can also punch additional 1mm holes and stitch around the badge instead.

INSTRUCTIONS & TIPS

Tools/Materials Needed:

2 square feet of Leather (between 3-6 ounces)

1 - 1.5mm hole punch (6mm between holes)

Approximately **1 meter of thread**

4 rivets in length dependent on your leather thickness (I used 6mm posts)

Tips when building:

1. Cut out all pattern pieces along the dotted lines, assemble, and tape to your leather. Punch then Cut each piece

2. Apply your preferred leather treatments (dye, mink oil, tokonole (to the flesh side)

3. Install rivets and name badge onto the stocking cuff. If you prefer to stitch, be sure to forego the 4 rivet holes in the pattern. Following the below, photos attach the cuff to the stocking. The "face" of the leather should be facing opposite directions when attaching, with the cuff on the "inside" of the stocking.



4. Fold the stocking so both faces are on the outside (you can fold down the cuff now or at the end of the stitch line).

5. Finish the edges in your preferred method (sand with 320g sandpaper, edge dye, tokonole, beeswax)

6. Apply any leather protectants/balms to finished piece
