

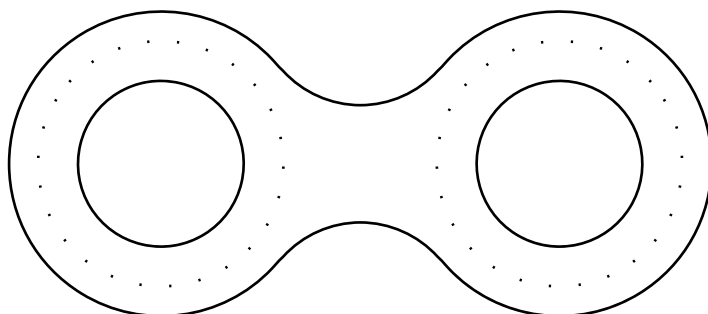
Coin Keyring

Instructions:

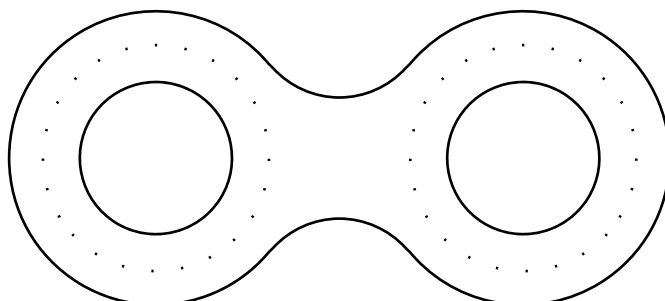
I recommend using vegetable tanned leather. You will need a ring or a swivel hook. The holes are marked for 3.85mm stitching irons.

Sometimes, it is not easy to make a perfect round hole in leather without a proper punch. What I do: after sewing the keyring I case the whole thing (dampen the leather), and place a smaller coin in the holes on both sides, one that is same diameter, and let it dry. This shapes the hole perfectly.

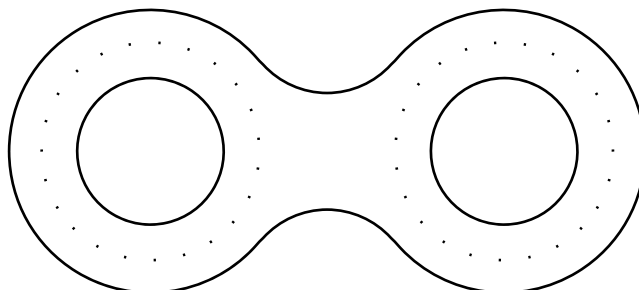
29mm coin
