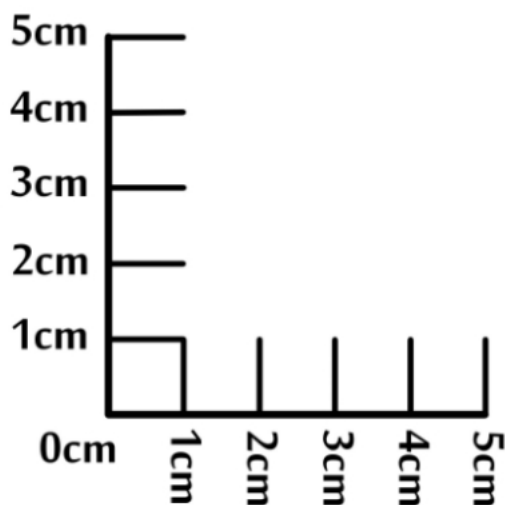
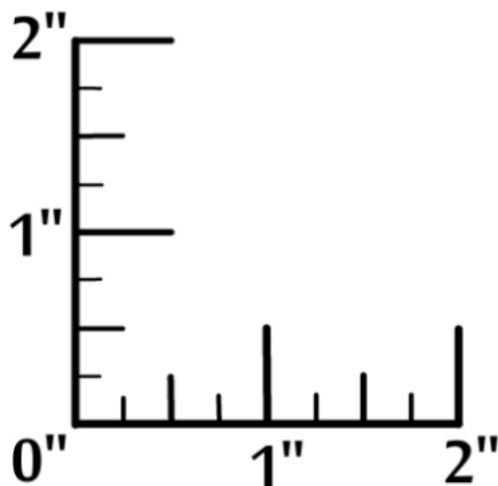


Pattern Assembly Template

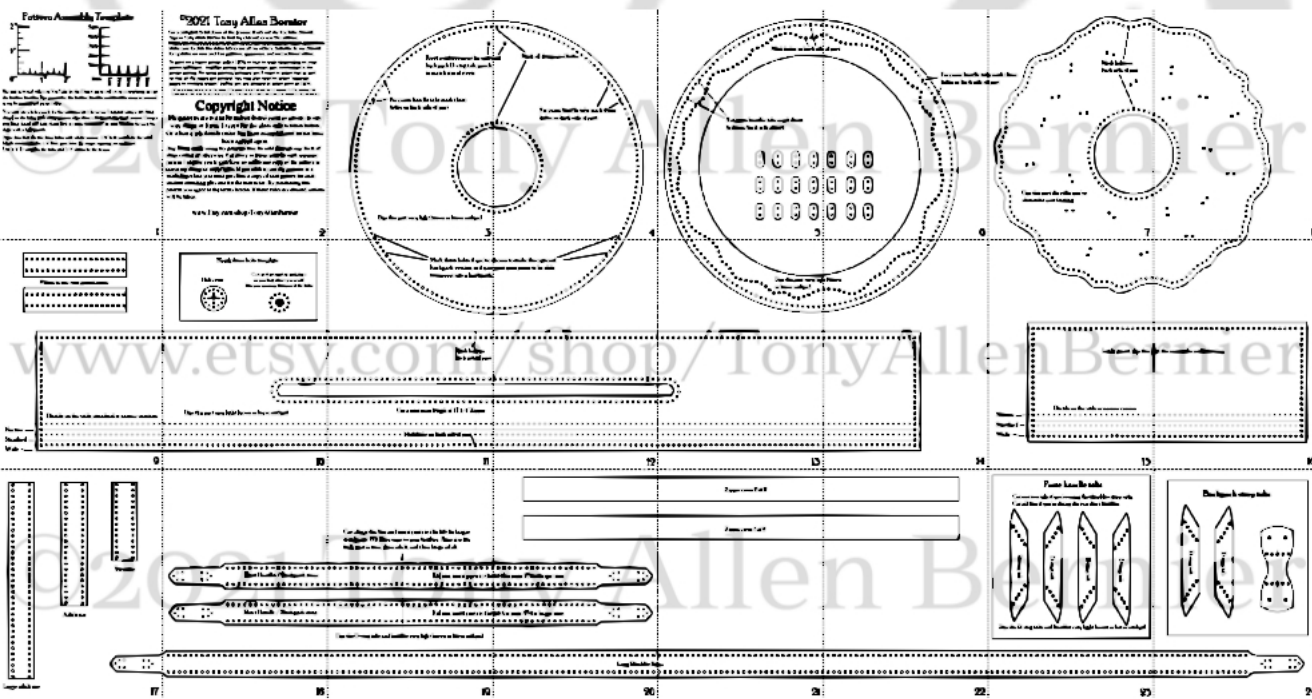


You may use a hole punch for the entire project, however I suggest using a stitching chisel on the holes with white centers since they will show in the final project. Using a stitching chisel will help them look more professional. The solid black holes may be done with a hole punch.

2mm chisel for the stitching holes with white centers. 1/16" hole punch for the solid black stitching holes. 1/2" hole punch for the zipper opening on each end.

Use 3/4" D-rings for the tabs, and 3/4" clasps for the straps.

Use a 6oz veg tan for everything except the zipper cover, for that use a floppy veg tan or chrome tan. When sealing your parts leave the backside of the main panels, and gussets unsealed.

To print on a home printer select 100% or true to scale (depending on your printer/software). Another setting that sometimes gets overlooked is the poster setting. For some printers/software you'll need to select that as well so that all the pages get printed. You may also need to select "separate pages to multiple sheets" before you are allowed to select print at 100%.

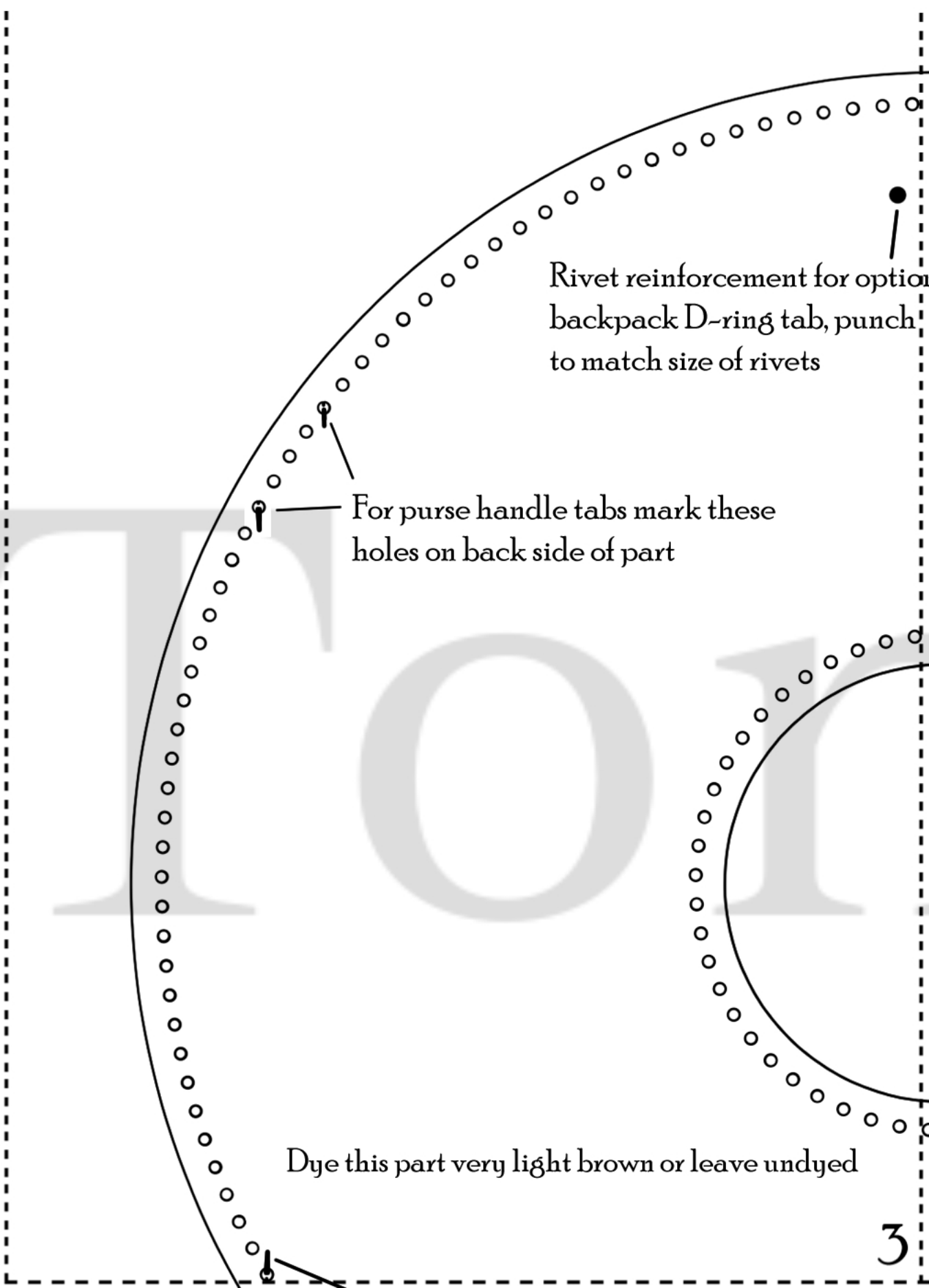
(When printing patterns on an A4 printer, if the pattern doesn't already have a separate A4 file, printing with landscape at 100% may fix any issues you have. You may also want to decrease your margins to the minimum.)

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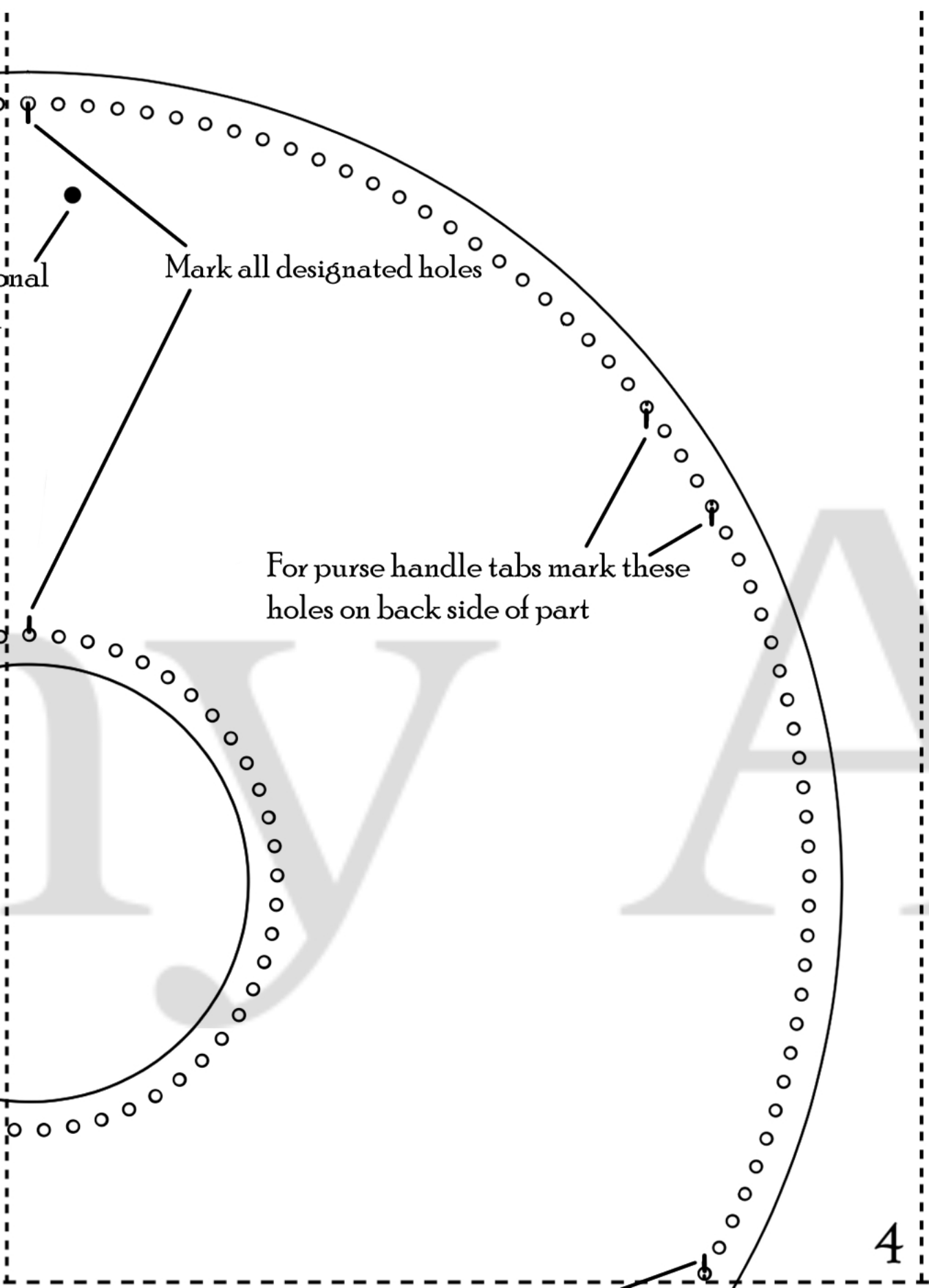
