## NECESSARY TOOLS

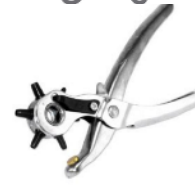
**B&W Printer**



**Scissors or a cutter**



**Hole Puncher** (We recommend 2 - 2.4 mm sized holes for this build)



**Approx 4 square feet of leather.** (We recommend 6-7oz leather for this build)



**Thread and needles** (We recommend 1.2 mm waxed thread for this build)



**5 x 20 mm buckles** — — —> <https://goo.gl/tVJhEo>

About 50 rivets few rivets

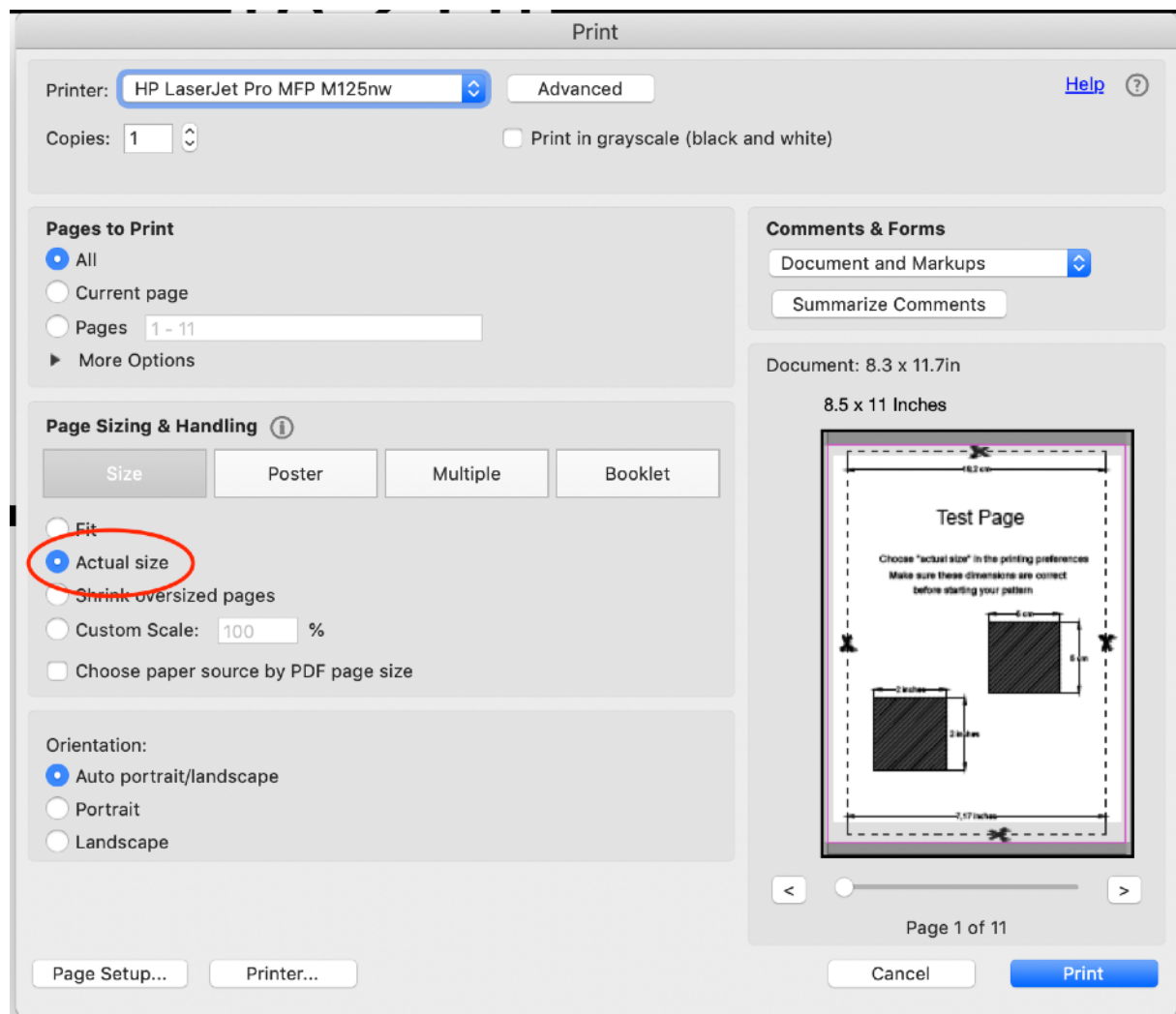


3 x Metal loops and 2 D rings



# PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your paper size to A4 and choose actual size in the printer settings

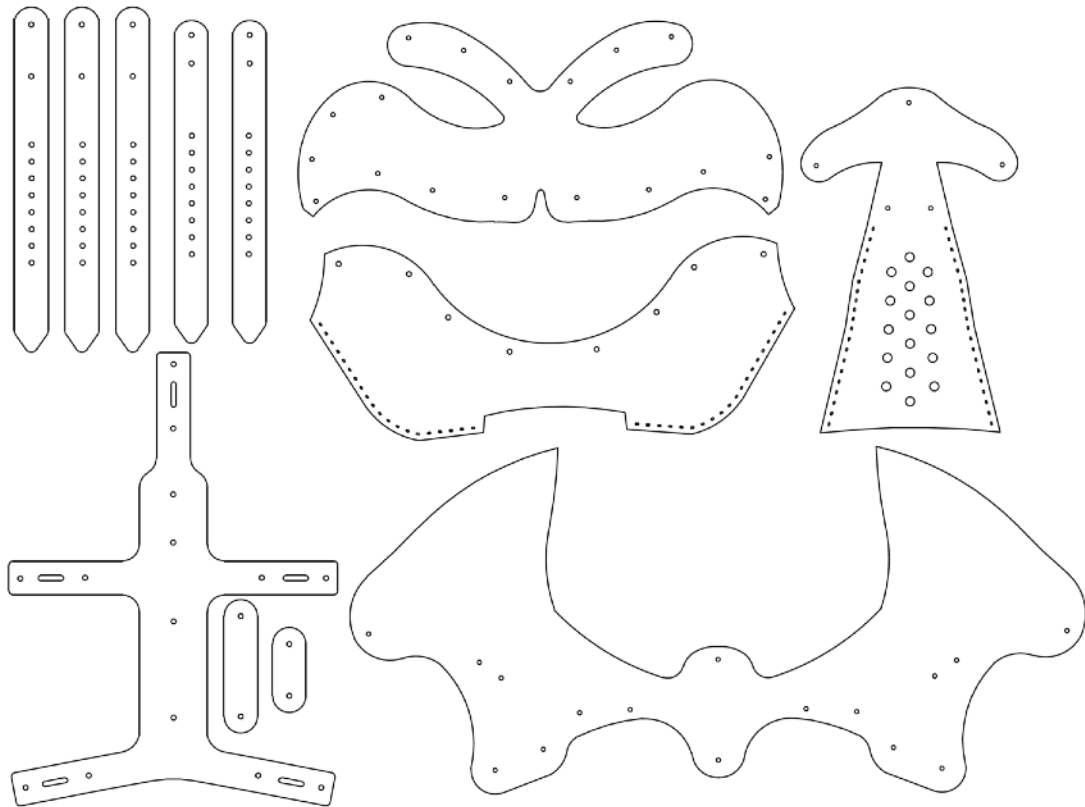


Alternatively you can use “letter” format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product significantly

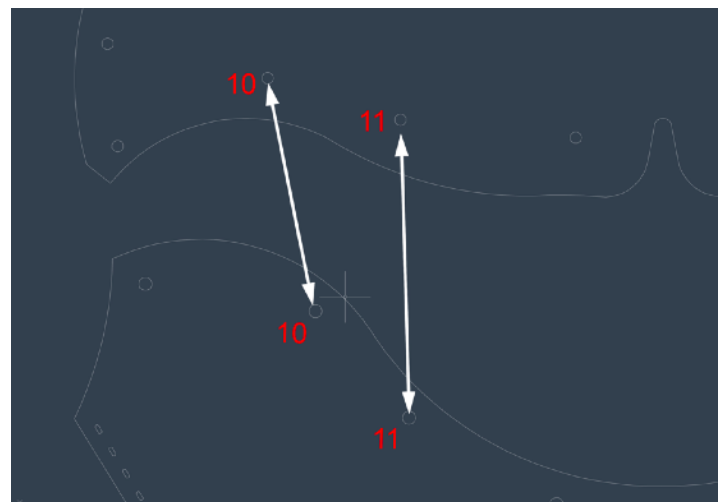

Print all the patterns. Take note that some of the larger parts are spread over two or three pages. Connect these parts along the dotted lines that have a scissors symbol.

Once done you should have everything shown in the picture below



Use rivets to attach the holes numbered the same, for example hole 10 will connect with hole 10 just like in the picture to the right.





Note that some of the rivets need to go through three holes. Make sure your rivets are long enough to go through all three pieces of leather like I shown in this picture:

Also, it is very important to construct the mask in the correct order:

1. Start with piece A, rivets 1 to 1 and 2 to 2 then 3 to 3 on piece B



2. Stitch the sides of piece A on top of piece B

3. Attach the piece B on top of piece C with the rivets from 4 to 11
4. Attach piece C to piece D starting with rivets 12, 13 and 14, 15
5. Next connect the eyebrows from piece to piece D with rivets 16 through 22

6. Time to attach the straps. Attach the 3 metal loops using holes 23, 24 and 25
  7. Next attach the 3 straps that go through the loops. These straps will have the holes numbered 26, 27 and 28



8. Next flip the right ear on hole 30 and attach the straps with the holes 30 and 29
9. Do the same for the left ear



10. Move to the buckle straps at the back. You can add D ring holders if you like using the holes 33, 34 and 35, 36. Afterwards attach the buckles using the holes from 37 to 41
