TOOLS

- sharp knife
- 1,2-1,5mm hole puncher or pricking irons or awl
- hammer
- 2 needles
- paper tape
- a home printer

MATERIALS

- about 0,2 (bigger), 0,1 small of 4-5oz(1,5-2mm) square meter of leather of vegetable tanned leather
- and some of 3oz (1mm)
- Waxed thread (preferable 0,8-1 mm)
- white / black paint
- 15mm buckle



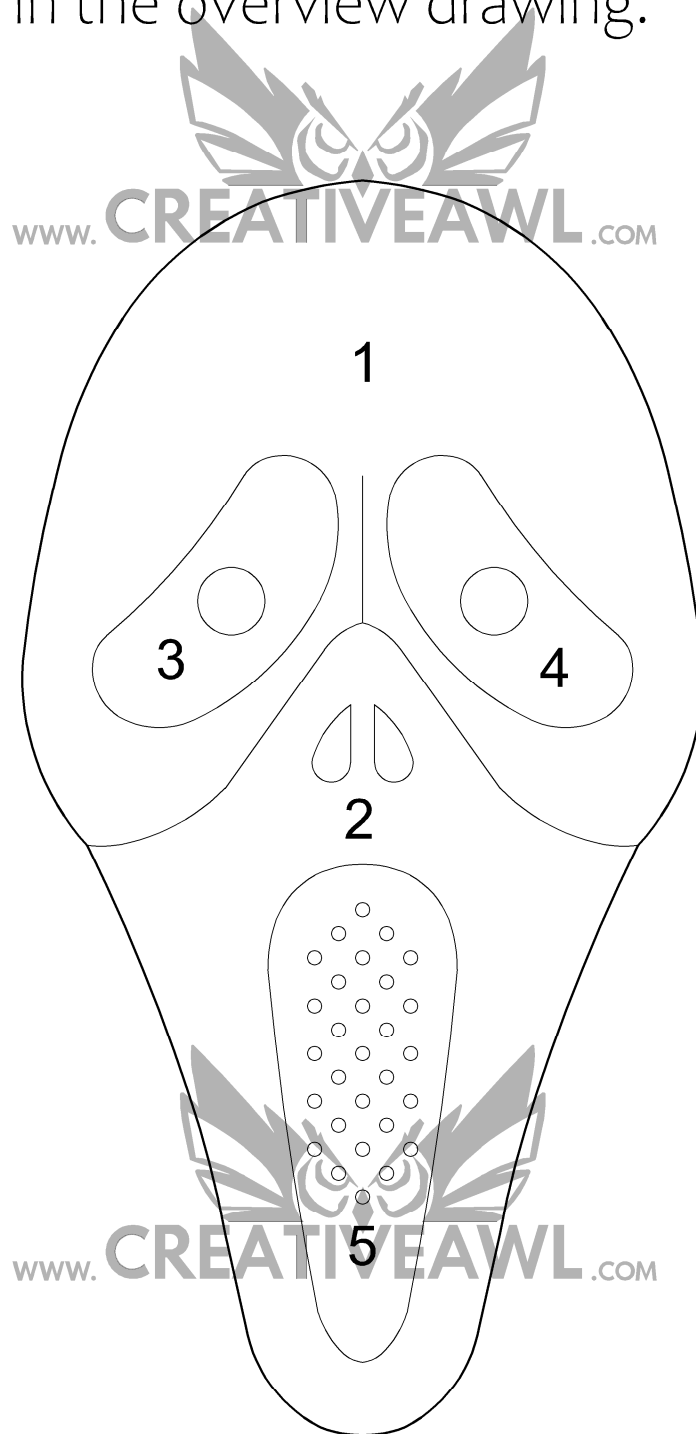

Small leather "Scream" mask: pages 7 - 11

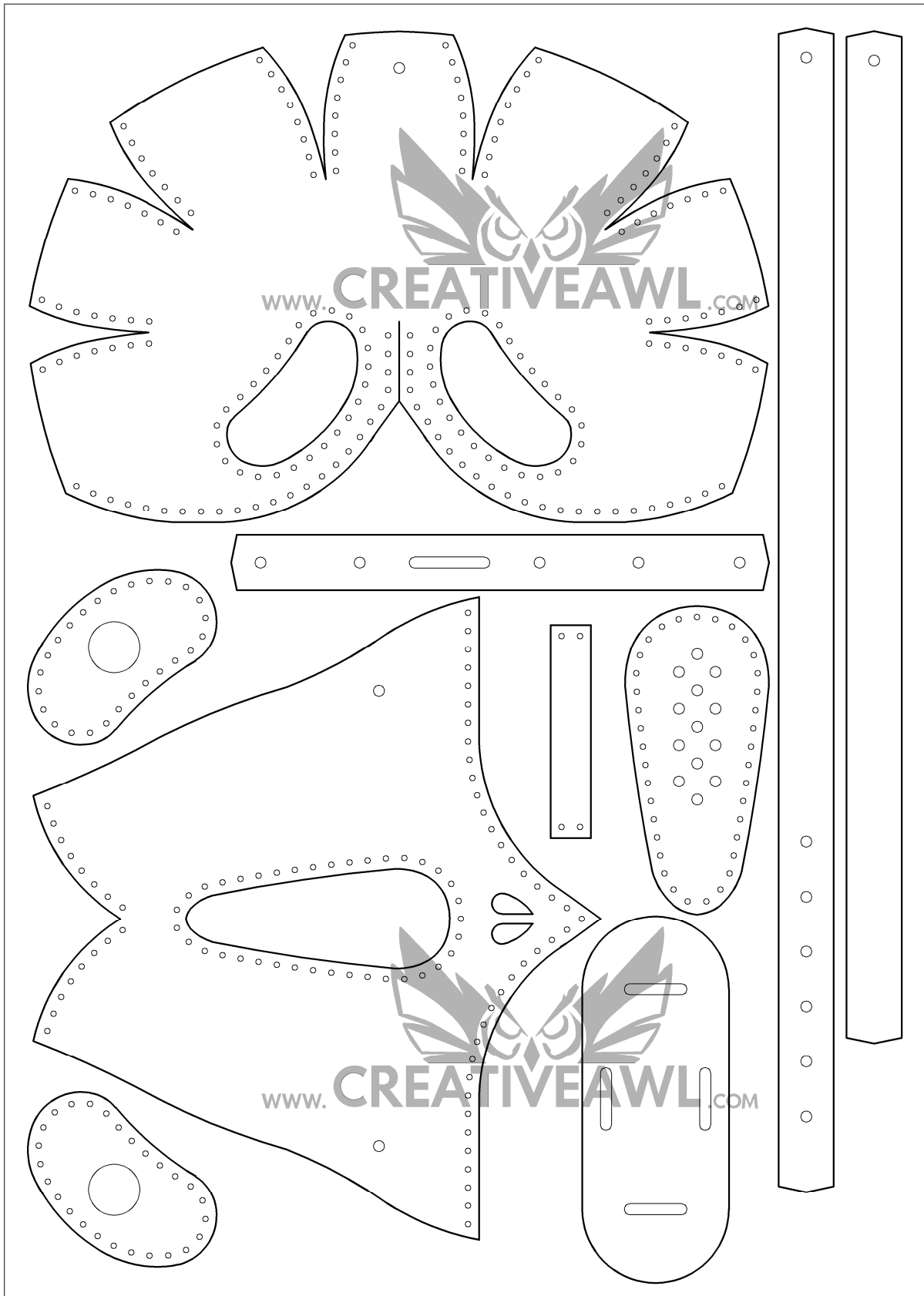
- The number in the circle shows which holes are to be connected. Example: ①
