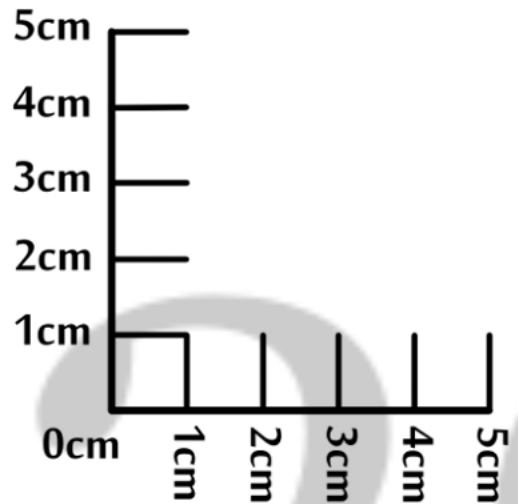
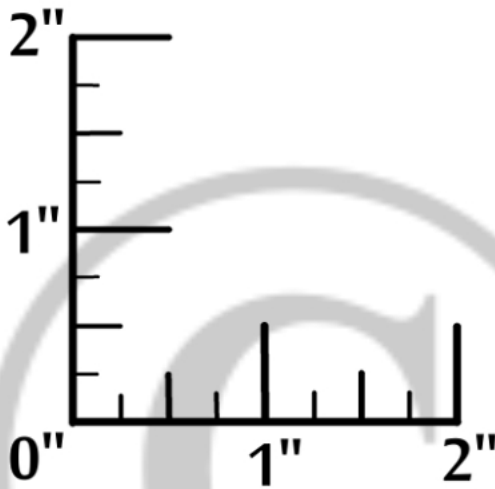


Pattern Assembly Template

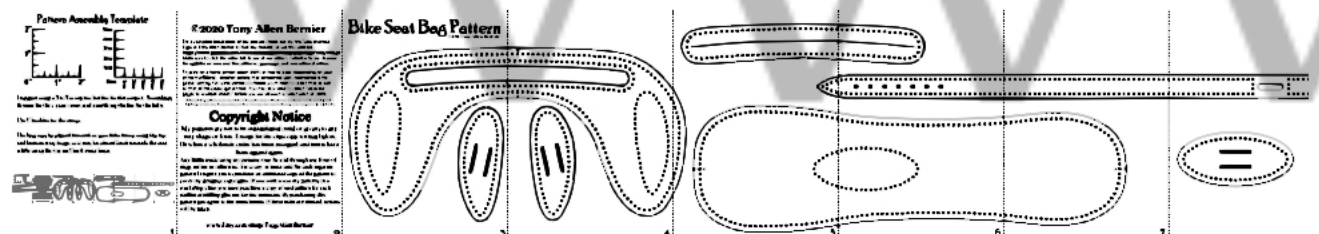


I suggest using a 5 to 7oz veg tan leather. The panels and gusset can be on the thinner side, and the straps should be on the thicker side. The optional zipper cover should be a floppy 2 to 3 oz chrome tan.

Use a 1" buckle for the large strap, and a 1/2" buckle for the small strap.

The bag may be placed forward on your bike frame using the top and bottom strap loops, or it may be placed back towards the seat while using the top and back strap loops.

Holes with white centers should be punched with a stitching chesel, and solid black holes should be punched with a hole punch.

To print on a home printer select 100% or true to scale (depending on your printer/software). Another setting that sometimes gets overlooked is the poster setting. For some printers/software you'll need to select that as well so that all the pages get printed. You may also need to select "separate pages to multiple sheets" before you are allowed to select print at 100%.

(When printing patterns on an A4 printer, if the pattern doesn't already have a separate A4 file, printing with landscape at 100% may fix any issues you have. You may also want to decrease your margins to the minimum.)

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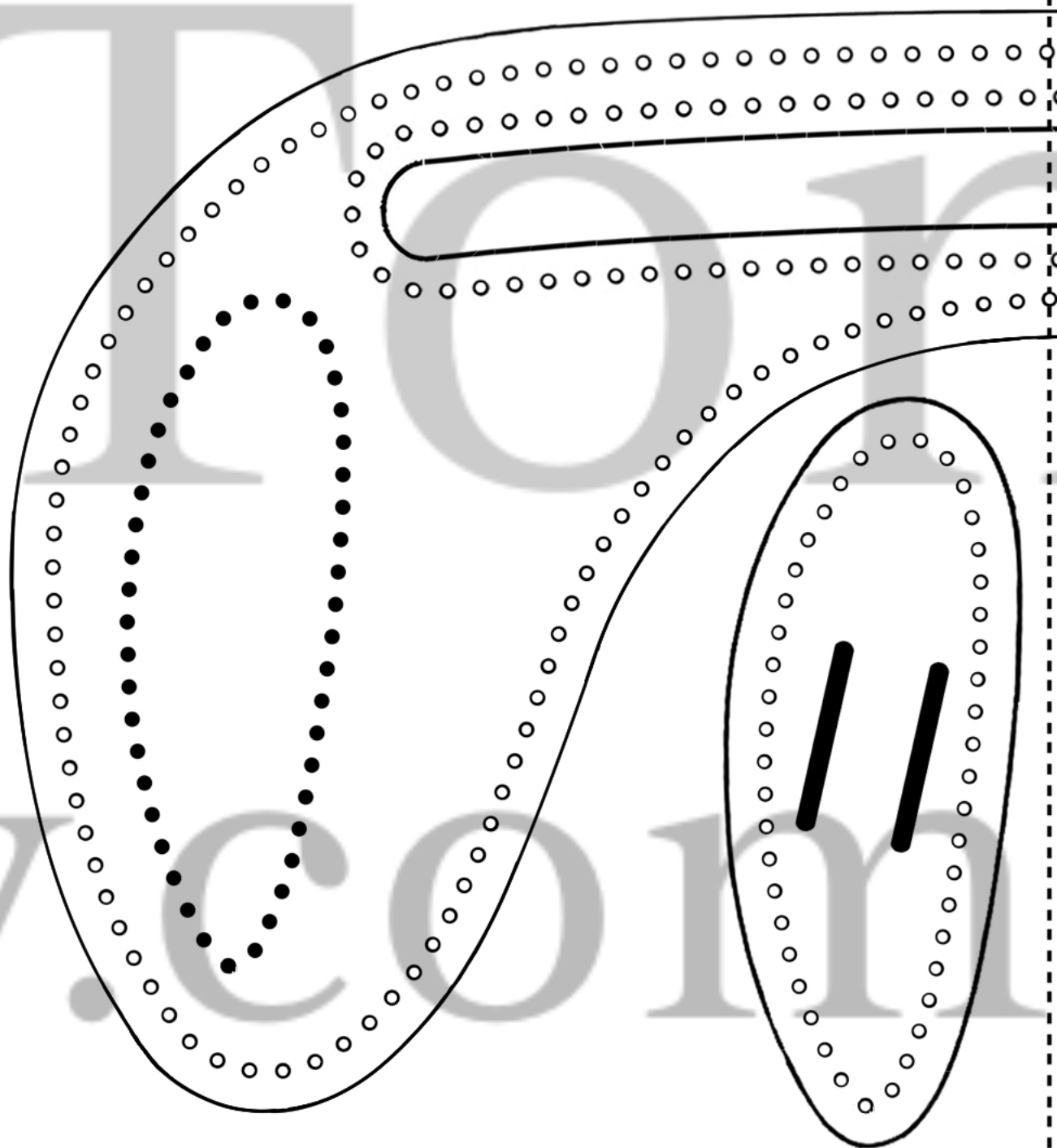
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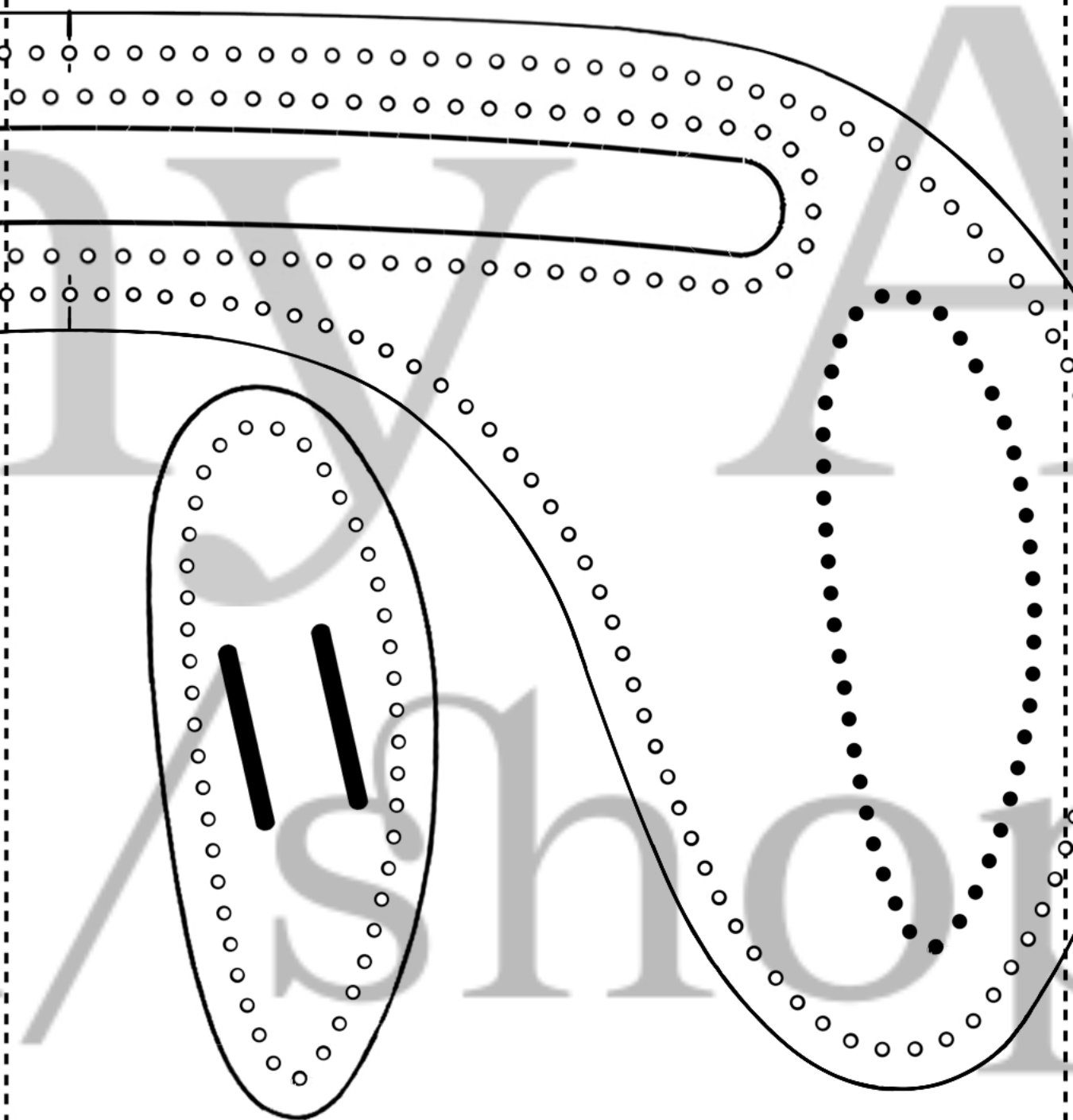
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Bike Seat Bag Pattern

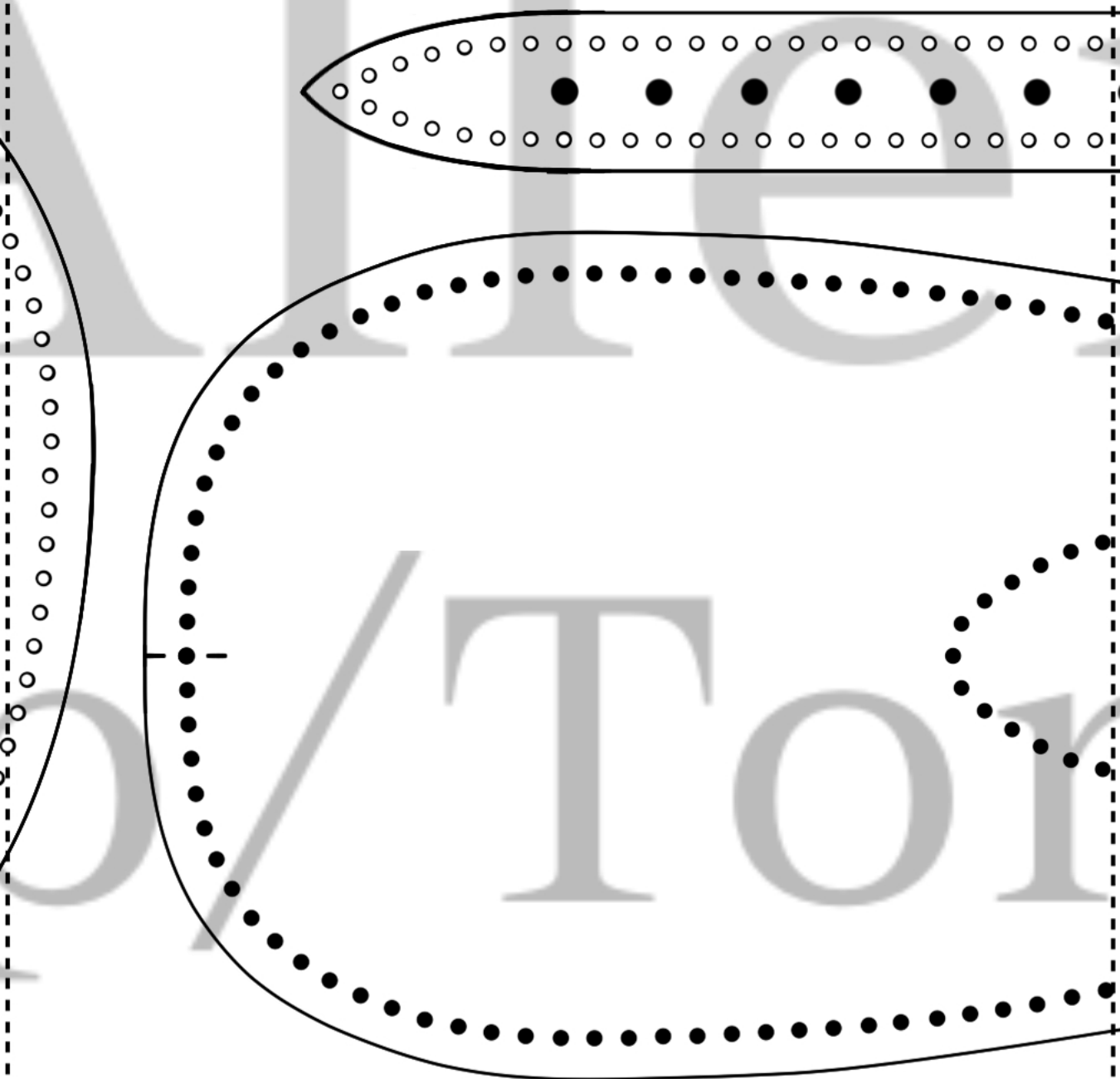
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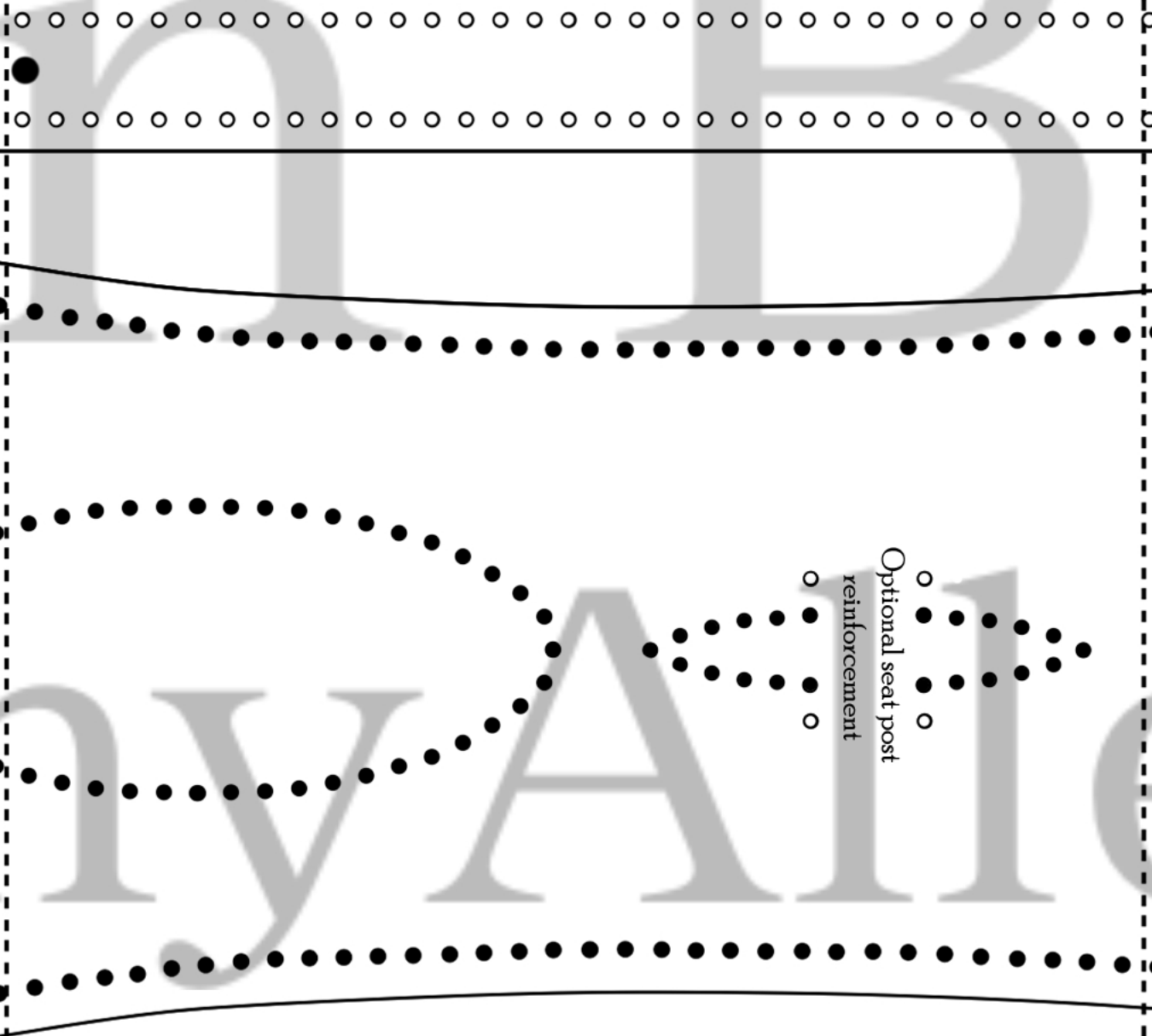


Cut two of these if you're making the zipper cover shown in the video for this project. If you're doing the version shown in my Hummingbird purse video cut only one of these out.

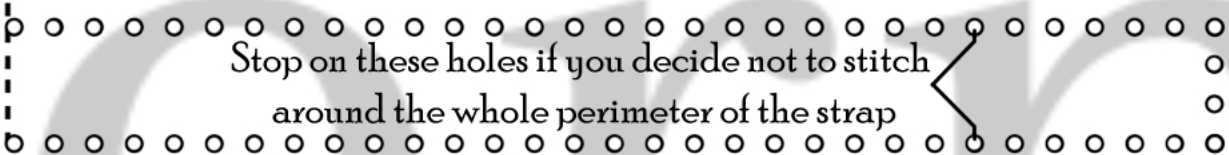
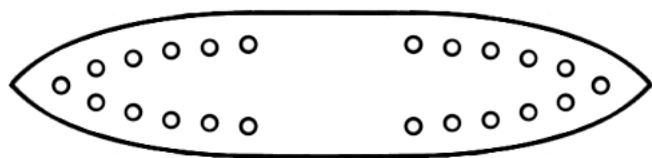

Cut the short strap if you have a narrow/standard seat post width. If you have a thick seatpost cut the longer strap.
