Materials:

I recommend using a 3 to 4 oz leather (veg or chrome). With thicker leather the backpack would come out too heavy.

Waxed thread around 0.8mm thick, that's more of your own choice, that is what I use.

Hardware:

1 x 1" snap hook (I use trigger snap)

2 x 1" buckles

2 x 3/4" buckles

8 x 3/8" grommets (size may vary slightly but you have to adjust the holes)

2 x 1" D-rings

Rivets

Tools:

Scissors, knife (paper knife or rotary cutter would also work).

Stitching irons: my pattern is made for 5mm stitching irons (5 stitches per inch). If you are willing to use any other size please make sure that the hole count is the same where it has to be the same: pocket front and pocket gusset, the vertical seams, the bottom and both front and back panels.

Needles - according to your thread size, a pair of saddle needles.

Mallet, grommet setter, rivet setter, hole puncher.

Instructions:

Print the pattern at actual size (100%). Use the reference on top of each page to make sure everything is printed correctly. Join the pages together, you will find further instructions on the pattern itself.

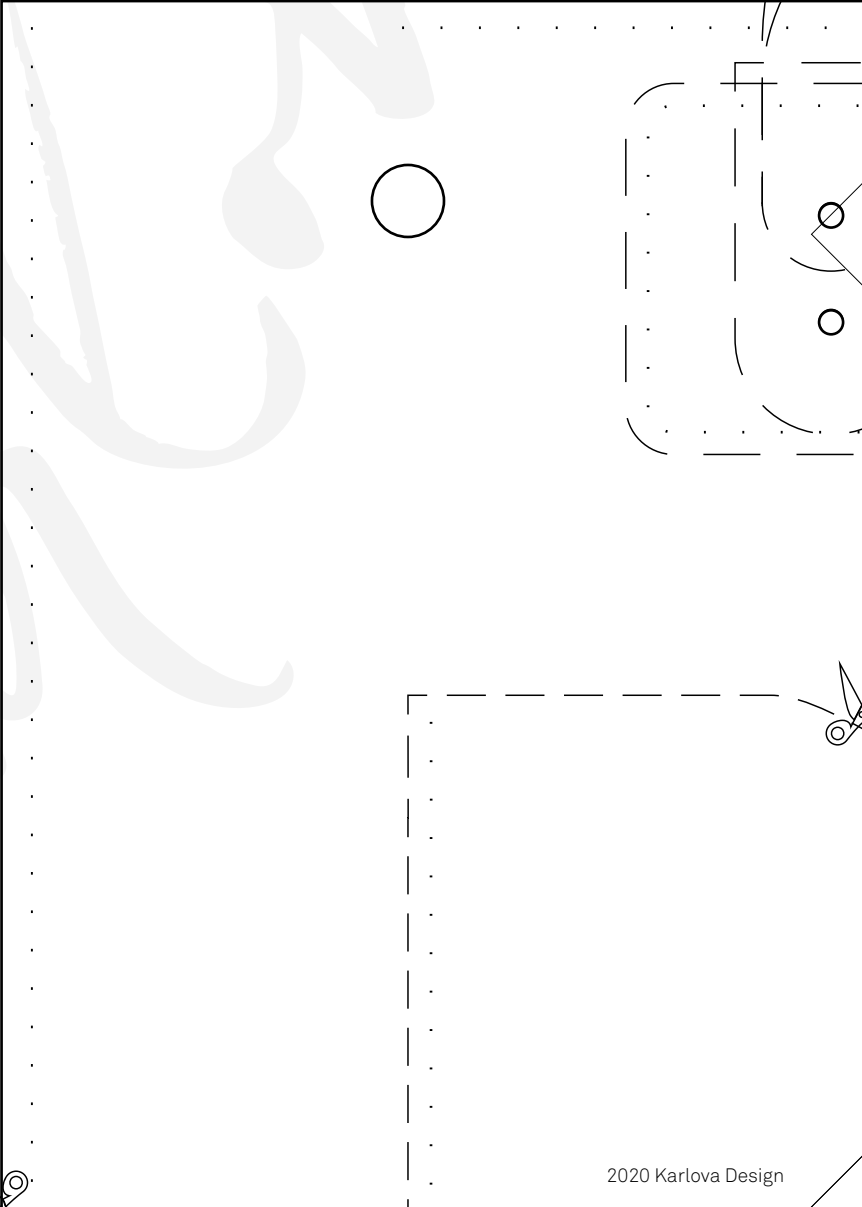
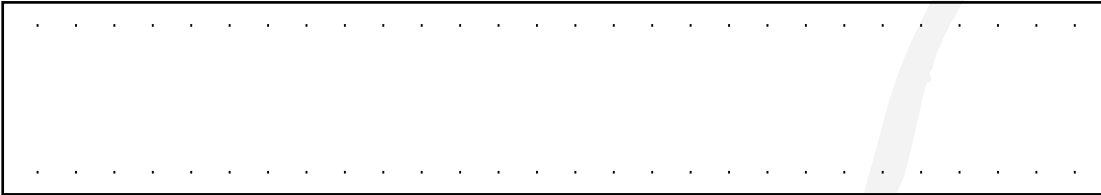

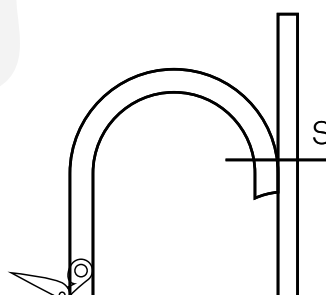


BACKPACK BODY / FRONT PANEL

The main body is sewn inside out (turned), but you can use the pattern as is.

The pockets' front is sewn together with pocket gussets in the center.

The pockets' flaps are sewn on upside down so you will hide the seam.

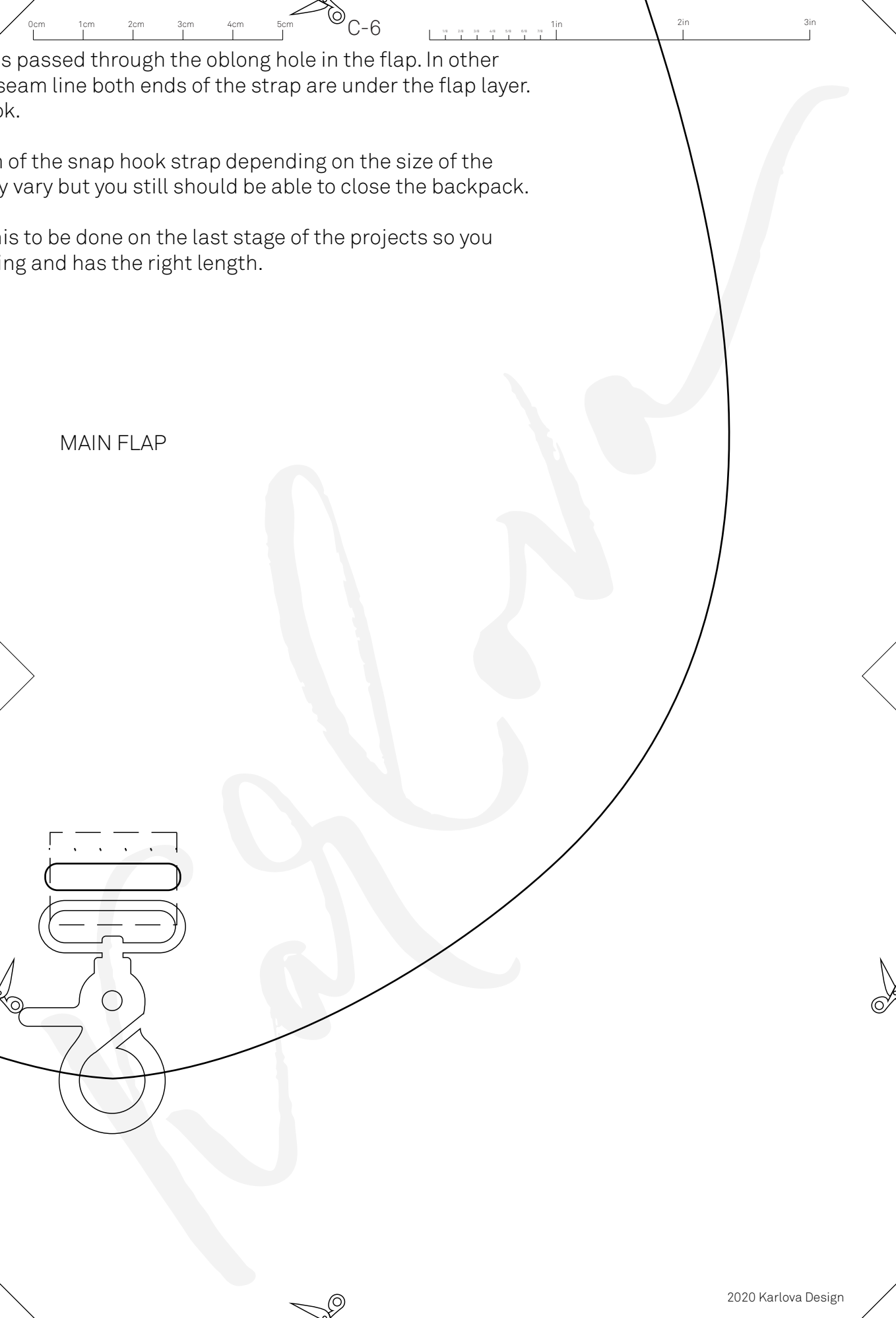


The little strap for the snap hook is made of the same fabric as the words, when you sew it in, on the same side as the words. Don't forget to insert the snap hook in the strap.

You may need to adjust the length of the strap to fit the snap hook you are using. They may vary in size.

This is the reason I recommend that you make a prototype first. You can make sure everything is working before you make the final version.
