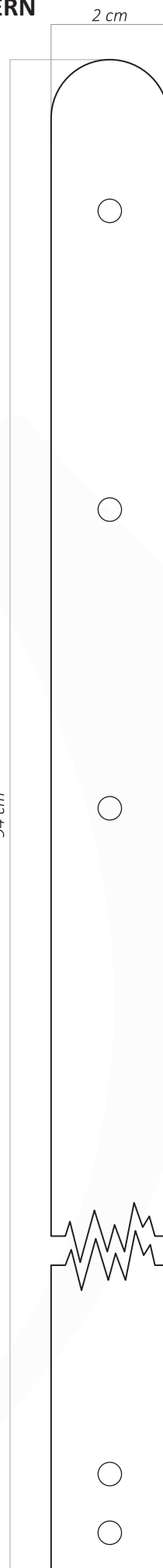
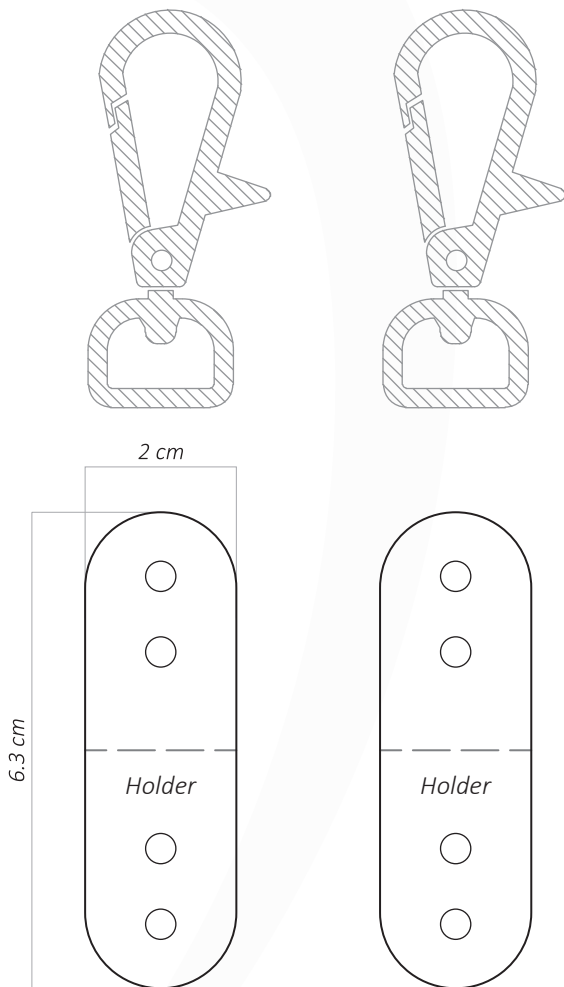
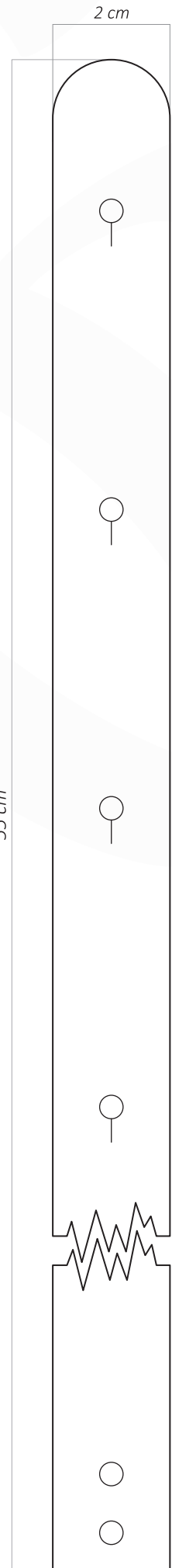


LEATHER SHOULDER STRAP PATTERN

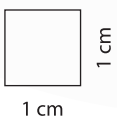
Print setting: A4 "actual size"

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Difficulty level: Easy

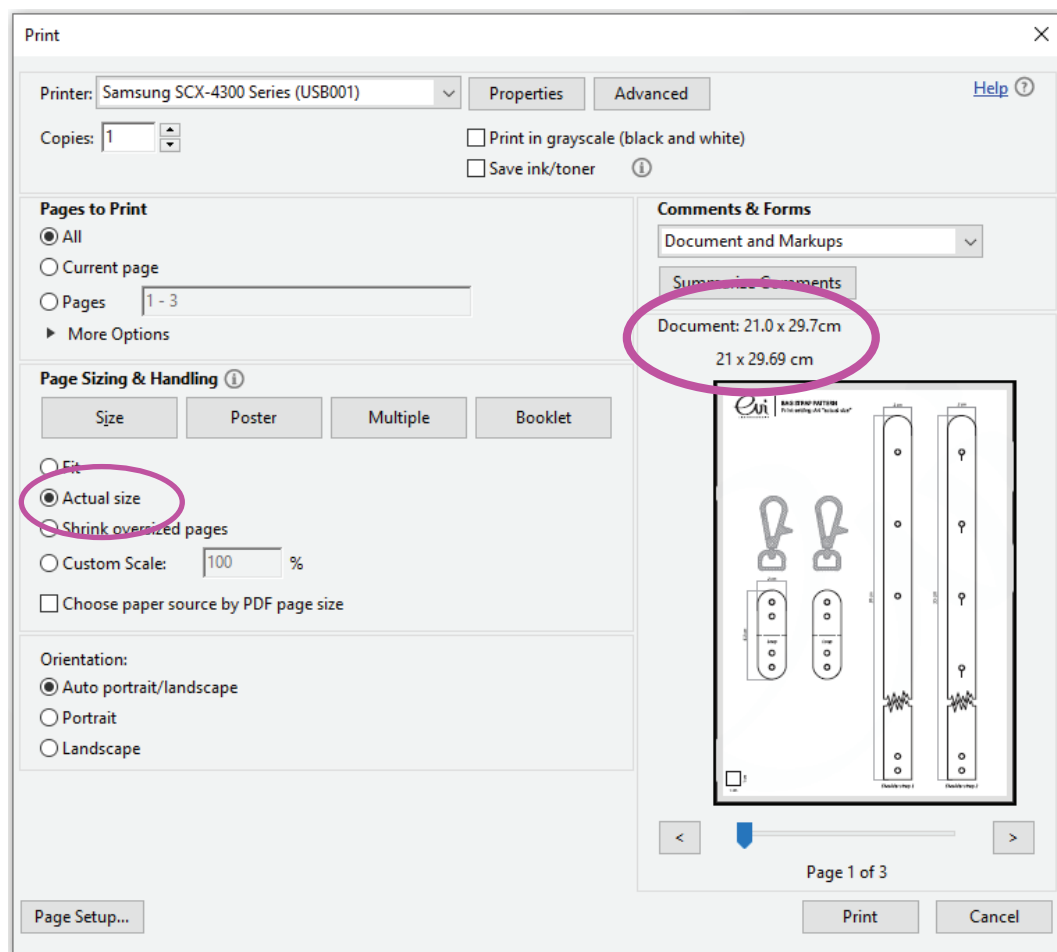
Completion time: 30 - 60 min

NECESSARY TOOLS

- B&W Printer,
- Scissors or a cutter,
- Hole puncher,
- Leather strap and a few scraps,
- 3pcs stud closures,
- 4pcs double-cap rivets,
- 2pcs 20mm metal swivel hooks.

PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your paper size to A4 and choose actual size in the printer settings.

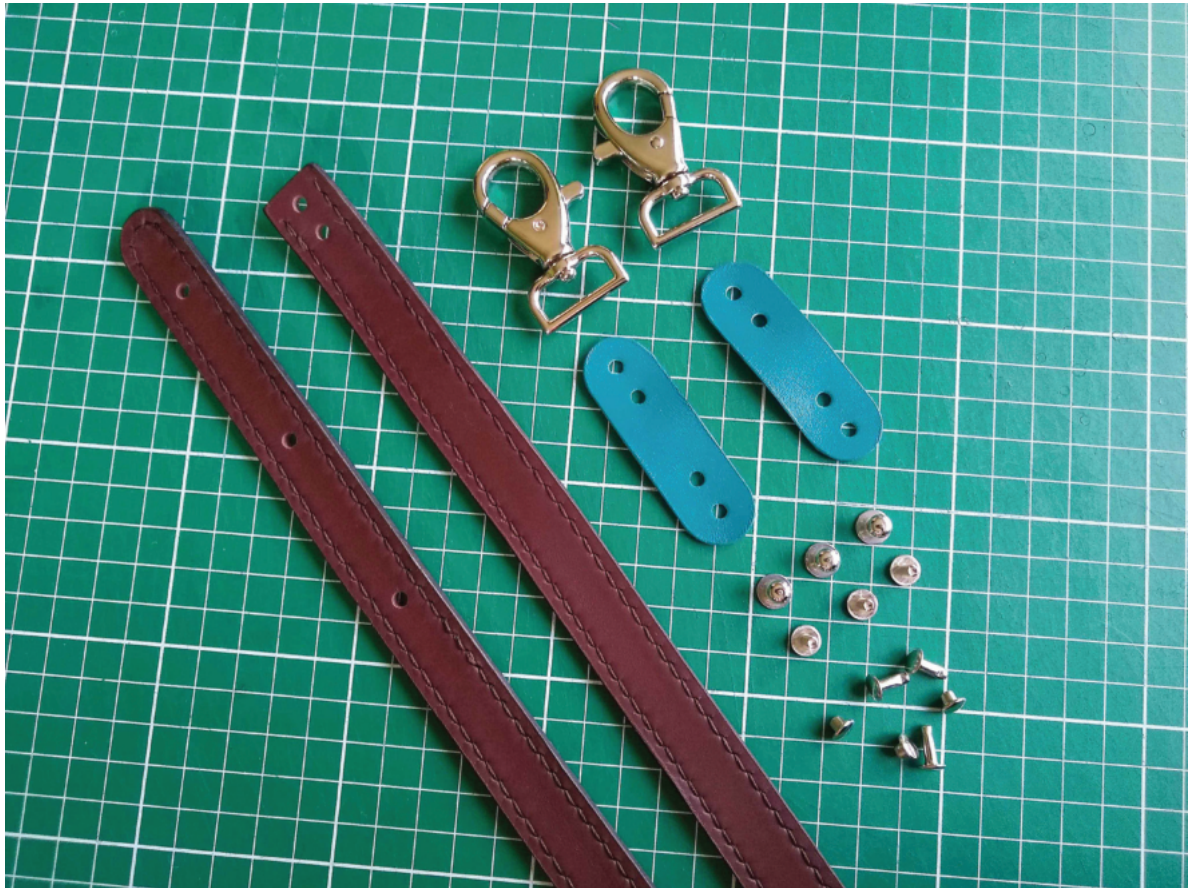

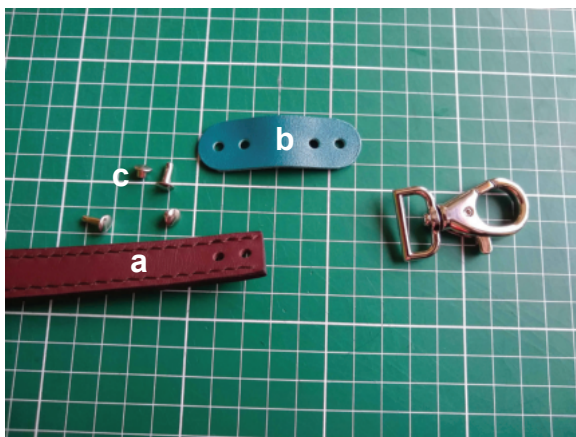
LET'S BEGIN.

STEP 1. Print the paper patterns and use them to cut the leather parts. After you are done cutting you should have everything as shown below.

If you want to glue the leather parts, then you should also stitch shoulder straps.



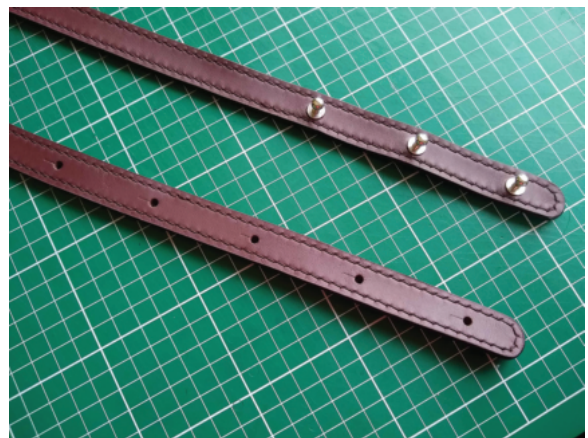
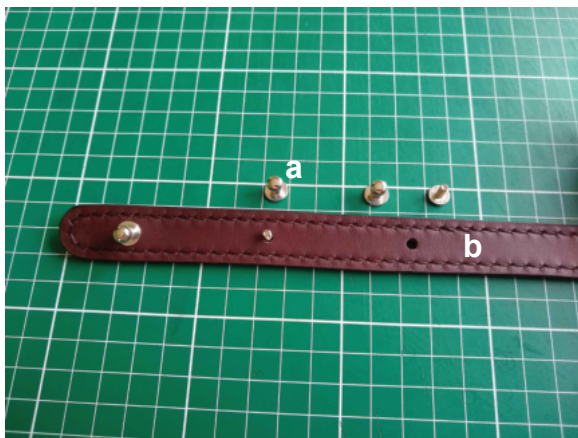
STEP 2. Start by attaching the metal swivel hooks for the straps.



Shoulder strap(a) is attached to the swivel hook holder(b) by using double-cap rivets(c). Do the same with the other strap.



STEP 3. Stud closures(a) should be attached to the shoulder strap1(b).



STEP 4. Finally, join the shoulder straps together.

Your strap is done and can be attached to your bag.
