- preferable about 5 oz (2 mm))around 5.4 sqft (0.5 sqm), we used Pueblo Cognac and Nero Maya (available in our shop)
- Waxed thread (preferable 0,8-1 mm)
- 2 x 25mm d-rings

# TOOLS

- sharp knife
- 1.2 - 1.5 mm hole puncher / pricking irons or awl
- hammer
- 2 needles
- paper tape
- a home printer

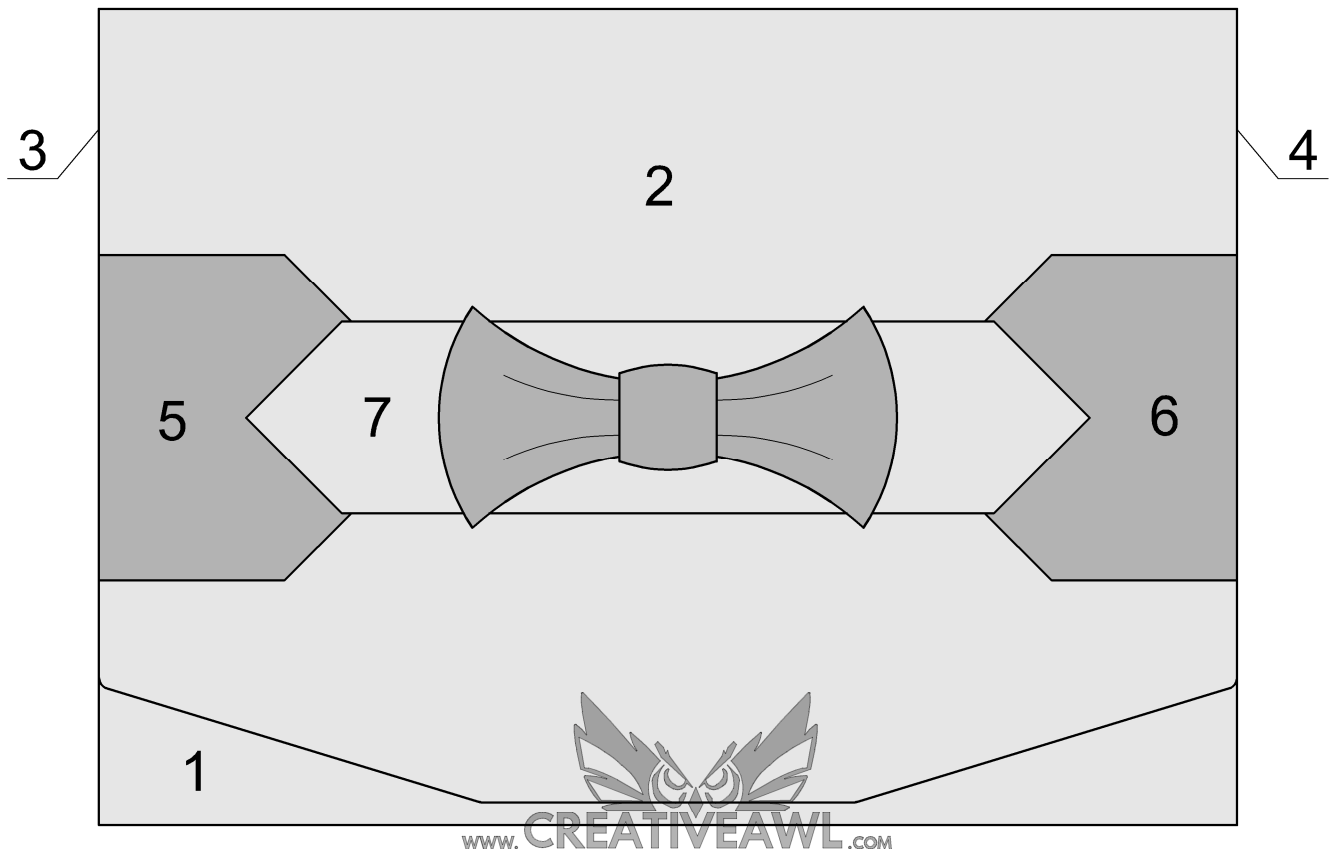

-The number in the circle shows which holes are to be connected. Example: ①

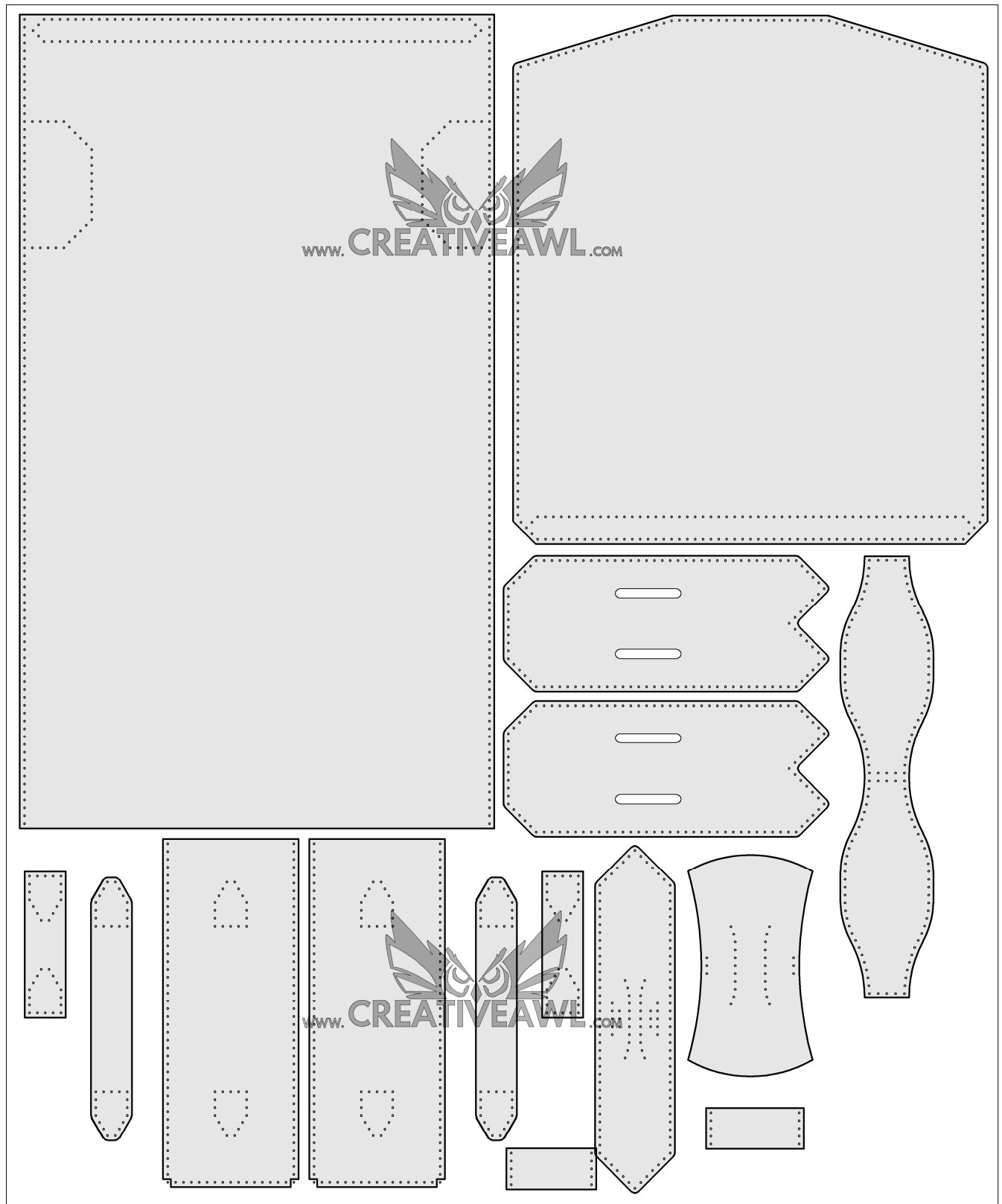
-Numbers 1, 2, 3 (...) without a circle indicate where the piece lies in the overview drawing.



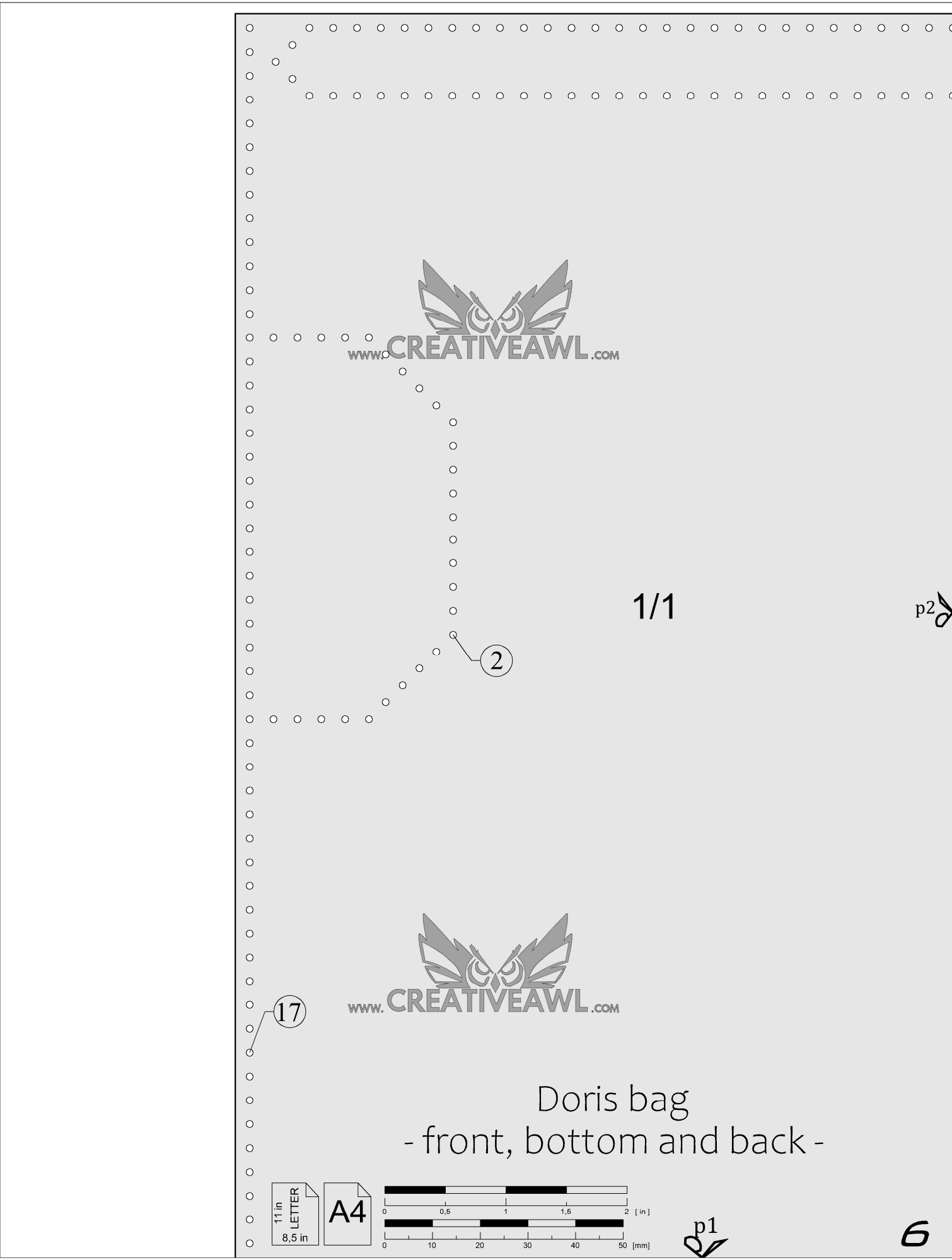
Leather needed for a Costa waist bag:    about 0.50 m2

- side and side components - **14**

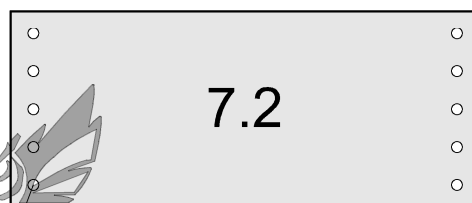
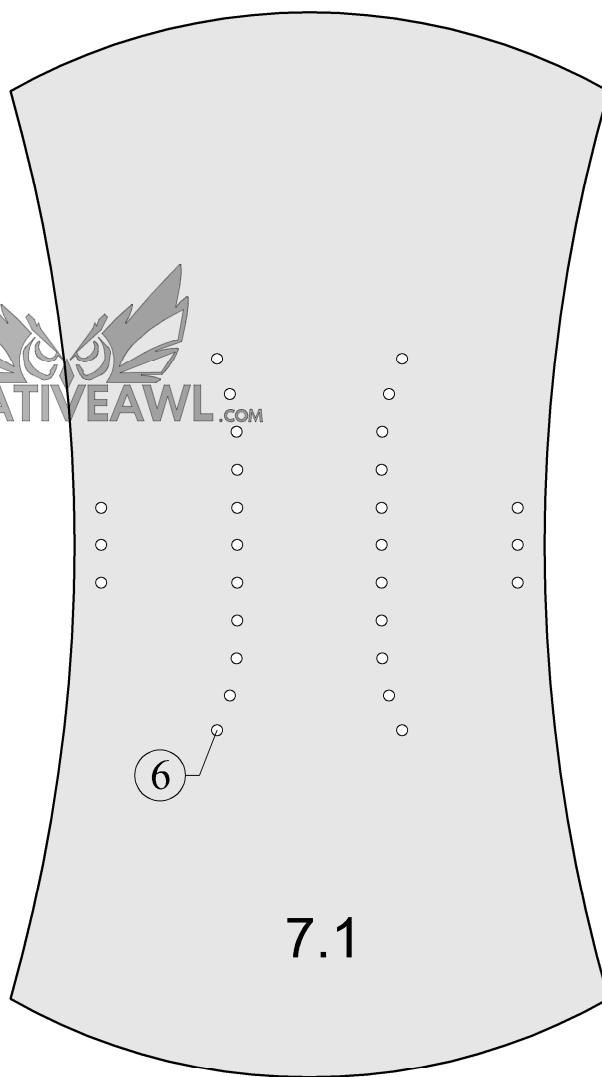






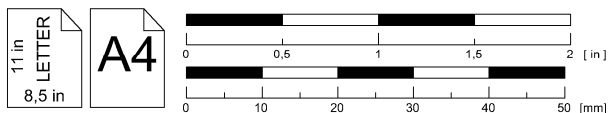


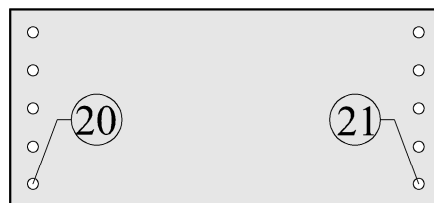
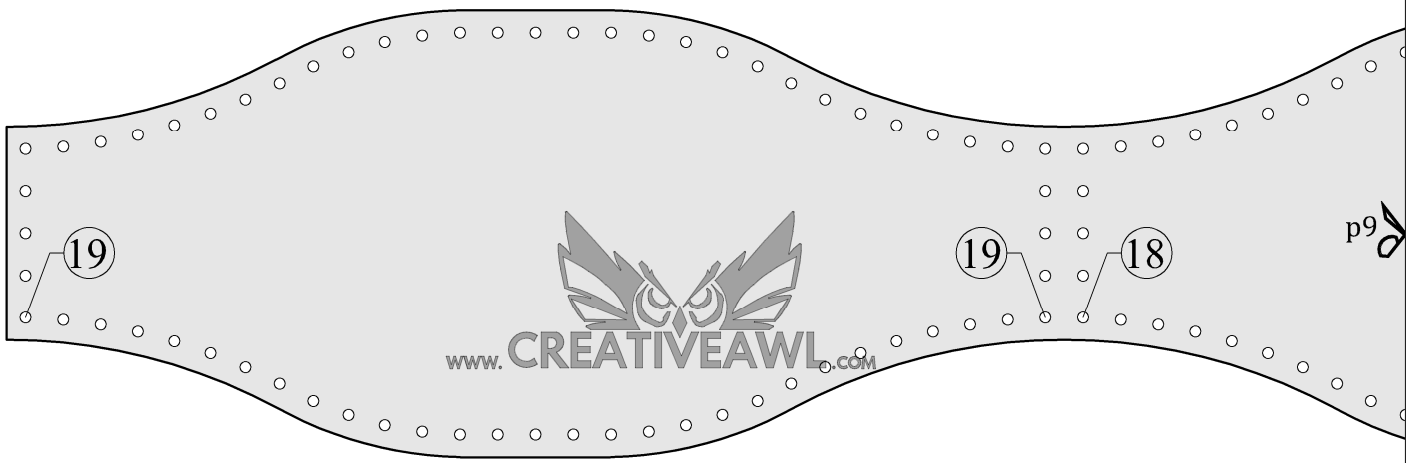
