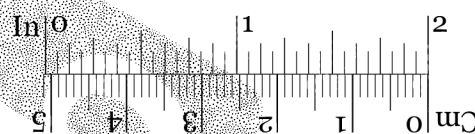


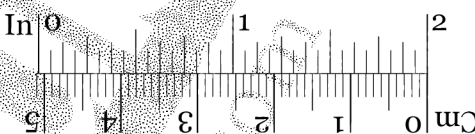
Please measure your head from the back to the forehead to get the size that you will require!

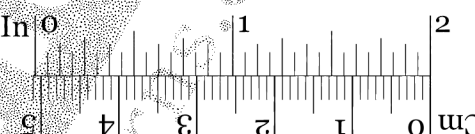
Print at **100%** scale for an approximately

and measure this ruler for accuracy



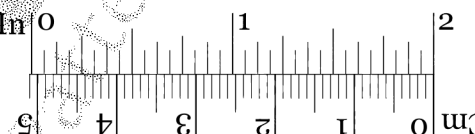
Print at **98.4%** scale for an approximately

and measure this ruler for accuracy



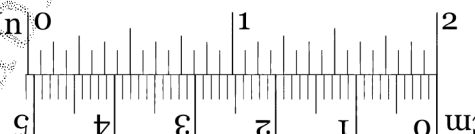
Print at **96.8%** scale for an approximately

and measure this ruler for accuracy



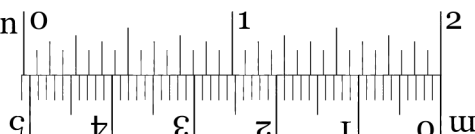
Print at **95.2%** scale for an approximately

and measure this ruler for accuracy



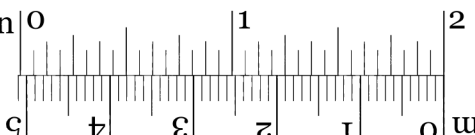
Print at **93.5%** scale for an approximately

and measure this ruler for accuracy



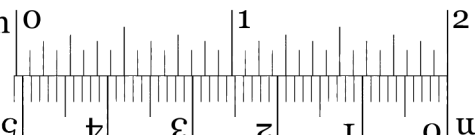
